RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Michael Pereira supporting North Haven Hospice (2100 metres)
<p>PACORUS (D Danis) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>LOCALLY SAUCED (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>HE’S CAVALIER (M Hashizume) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After undergoing a veterinary examination HE’S CAVALIER was confirmed a bleeder with Trainer J Hatton being advised that the entire is now subject to a two month stand down from track work and a three month stand down from racing or trialing along with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.</p> <p>C Burdan (KAHARAU) – Reminded of her obligations with regard to her whip use.</p> <p>D Danis (PACORUS) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>M Hashizume (HE’S CAVALIER) – Admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively when riding HE’S CAVALIER with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$500.</p>	
Race 2	Harcourts Bream Bay (1600 metres)
<p>DON’T DOUBT ME (D Danis) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1500 metres and steadied.</p> <p>I SEE RED (E McCall) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 1400 metres having to be restrained losing ground, and then commenced to over-race and improve forward to lead approaching the 800 metres.</p> <p>SYMBIO (S Weatherley) – Crowded approaching the 1300 metres by SUPER GEE which lay in despite the efforts of its rider and then was further hampered when SUPER GEE shifted in and away from BADEA which had shifted in abruptly with SYMBIO then over-racing for a distance.</p> <p>M Hashizume (BADEA) – Issued with a warning after permitting BADEA to shift in abruptly approaching the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of SUPER GEE which shifted away from that runner crowding RED DYNAMO which was hampered with Stewards taking into consideration the contribution by SUPER GEE which had placed BADEA in restricted room when laying in.</p> <p>BADEA (M Hashizume) – Shifted out under pressure approaching the 200 metres inconveniencing RED DYNAMO and SUPER GEE. M Hashizume was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>RED DYNAMO (D Johnson) – Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>SUPER GEE (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 3	North Haven Hospice – Living Every Moment (1400 metres)
<p>LADY SEQUOYAH (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Unable to find clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>BAYEUX (C Dell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MR INCREDIBULL (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>DELUXE (A Calder) – Began awkwardly and then was placed in restricted room shortly after having to be steadied. Had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 150 metres.</p>	

HAVANA HEAT (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover throughout when being inclined to lay out.

MAGNIFY (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the middle stages and was restrained when placed in restricted room near the 900 metres.

SHESONFIRE (D Johnson) – Improved on to heels approaching the 200 metres and then was held up for the remainder of the race.

MOET MOLLY (E McCall) – Inconvenienced when dictated out slightly by ANNEOFPAISLEY over the concluding stages.

Race 4	Cambridge Stud Northland Breeders Stakes – Sat Sep 14 (1000 metres)
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ANNA CECELIA (S Spratt) – Slow to begin. Inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting in making contact and then being straightened by its rider for a distance from near the 150 metres.

ANNIE'S SONG (C Lammas) – Slow to begin. Denied clear racing room and was steadied when attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of ANNA CECELIA which shifted in slightly approaching the 150 metres.

MINNALLINES (D Danis) – Raced four wide when challenging for the lead in the early to middle stages. Crowded when weakening near the 150 metres between FAMILIA which was dictated outwards by LOVE STRUCK (BR Jones) which shifted out when struck with the whip and ANNA CECELIA (S Spratt) which shifted in slightly with MINNALLINES then being steadied and losing ground. Riders B Jones and S Spratt were advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

FAMILIA (T Yanagida) – Steadied passing the 250 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of MINNALLINES which shifted in slightly.

EASYRIDER (S Johnson) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

Race 5	Harcourts Just Rentals (1400 metres)
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S Ralph – Issued with a warning after BLUETWENTYTWO was presented to race without notified gear (blinkers).

BLUETWENTYTWO (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin. Held up when attempting to improve into a marginal run approaching the 300 metres before shifting out approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BRAAVOS (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SPIDER (V Colgan) – Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and was confirmed to have bled after undergoing a veterinary examination. Trainer K Knight was advised that the gelding is now subject to a two month stand down from track work and a three month stand down from racing or trialing along with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

IN A TWINKLING (C Burdan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GO NICHOLAS (T Yanagida) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 900 metres.

Race 6	Harcourts Whangarei (1200 metres)
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WILLIAM WALLACE (A Calder) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out passing the 150 metres.

AVANTAGE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.	
MAGNUM (S Spratt) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.	
TIME TO FLY (BR Jones) – Underwent a veterinary examination after returning to the enclosure with a cough which could find no clinical abnormalities.	
Race 7	Bear Morgan @ Harcourts Bream Bay (1200 metres)
O’GUY (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.	
SUPREME HEIGHTS (A Calder) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
STAND TALL (A Goindasamy) – Lay in passing the 850 metres making contact with the hind quarters of BYZANTINE which then shifted out when making the bend forcing STAND TALL wider on the track. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
BYZANTINE (C Lammas) – Contacted passing the 850 metres before making the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly. A veterinary examination following the race found the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia as well as a minor laceration in the right nostril. The connections were advised that a suitable veterinary clearance is required for BYZANTINE prior to racing next.	
ORAKEI OVERLORD (E Leighton) – Restrained off heels approaching the 800 metres. Held up rounding the final bend then had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
SCARFI (BR Jones) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.	
Race 8	Ruakaka Christmas at the Races – Book Now (2100 metres)
MISHA’S STAR (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground then raced wide for the majority of the race.	
EACH WAY (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.	
NOTHING TRIVIAL (S Weatherley) – Held up when improving on to heels of weakening runners passing the 500 metres.	
VAN BLANC (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider V Colgan advised that the gelding had been under pressure from near the 800 metres and had not responded to his riding. VAN BLANC underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.	
TIPPING POINT (A Calder) – Returned to the enclosure with blood in the right nostril which was found to be consistent with a minor laceration.	
SMEDLEY (D Danis) – Trainer C Stevenson was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding and would be expected to be more competitive.
