RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	JOHN WHEELER RACING STABLES HURDLE (3100 Metres)
GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (B Lammas) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence losing ground. Hit the third to last fence and landed awkwardly. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.	
POROTENE MAGNUM (A Kuru) – Was inclined to run its fences down. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a tendon injury to the left foreleg. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to the gelding racing next. The owners indicated the gelding will be retired from racing.	

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Hit the fence near the 1000 metres.

TITTLETATTLE (E Farr) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

HENRY TUDOR (R Cole) – Hit the third to last fence and second to last fence.

IN A MINUTE (S Phelan) – Misjudged the final fence landing awkwardly.

Race 2	PAUL NELSON & CORRINA MCDOUGAL RACING (2200 Metres)
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NUNCHUCKS (B Thomas-Rantall) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found increased respiratory sounds and respiratory rate during recovery. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance, including endoscopic examination, would be required prior to racing next.

INFOXICATED (R Cole) – Began awkwardly then crowded. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been out-paced and it is now the connections intention to revert back to steeplechase races.

BABOONSKI (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (S Phelan) – Began awkwardly.

KEEPELLA HEIGHTS (S Fannin) – Held up rounding the final bend until shifting out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 3	CRAIG & SHAUN PHELAN RACING (1000 Metres)
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HAPPY EGO (M Kareem) – Slow to begin.

FAST MOVER (D Danis) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4	STEPHEN RALPH RACING 1000
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DIVINE DIVE (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced. Steadied off heels passing the 700 metres. Raced in restricted room briefly passing the 100 metres.

IMAKEEPA (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly.

SHOW THE LOVE (E McCall) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres when IMAKEEPA (M Kareem) shifted in forcing DIVINE DIVE (T Yanagida) inwards. Also contributing to this incident was slight outward movement from GREYVEE (J Fawcett). Riders M Kareem, T Yanagida and J Fawcett were all advised to exercise care.

M Kareem (IMAKEEPA) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount IMAKEEPA to shift in dictating DIVINE DIVE inwards on to GREYVEE which was inconvenienced and dictated inwards passing the 100 metres.

GREYVEE (J Fawcett) – Contacted and dictated inwards passing the 100 metres.

KING MIDAS (D Danis) – Lay out passing the 800 metres shifting wider on the track hampering POWER OF HOPE.

POWER OF HOPE (C Burdan) – Hampered passing the 800 metres.

Following the running of this race the connections of the second placed GREYVEE (J Fawcett) lodged a protest against the first placed IMAKEEPA with the connections withdrawing the protest prior to the hearing commencing.

Race 5	ANN BROWNE RACING STEEPLECHASE (4200 Metres)
<p>PYTHAGORAS (B Lamma) – Reared as the barriers were released and was very slow to begin (7L). Trainers P and J Brosnan were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding’s barrier manners. Hampered after jumping the fence near the 400 metres on the first occasion.</p> <p>STAR BRO (L Douglas) – Ran the first fence down hampering CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF.</p> <p>DO THE TWIST (S Fannin) – Knuckled on landing after jumping the fourth fence. Knuckled after jumping the fence near the 400 metres on the first occasion hampering PYTHAGORAS.</p> <p>SHE SAID YES (A Kuru) – Lay out for a distance approaching the 500 metres when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 6	EPIC JOURNEYS OPEN STEEPLECHASE (4200 Metres)
<p>CRASH BANDICOOT (M Gillies) – Blundered leaving the barriers.</p> <p>GAGARIN (B Thomas-Rantall) – Jumped indifferently in the early stages. Misjudged the fence near the 600 metres.</p> <p>EL CORBY (A Kuru) – Jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p>KINGS KITE (M Cropp) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1600 metres losing ground. Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>DOCTOR HOOK (S Fannin) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a poor recovery with an elevated respiratory rate.</p> <p>CHOCOLATE FISH (S Phelan) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) – Misjudged the final fence.</p>	
Race 7	KEVIN MYERS RACING 1400
<p>BUDDY PERFECT (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly losing ground then was crowded shortly after when QUINTANA (R Beemud) shifted in forcing HAERE UP inwards. R Beemud was advised to exercise care. Improved on to heels near the 900 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>HAERE UP (R Scott) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier and was steadied.</p>
