Race 1	SSANGYONG 2100
CASSIO (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced. Commenced to over-race when being steadied in the early to middle stages.	
SUPERLEGGERA (C Grylls) - Slow away.	

PLUSHENKO (D Mansour) – Began awkwardly and then steadied shortly after when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when AMASECOYA (D Johnson) shifted out when placed under pressure. D Johnson was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

HUNUA HANK (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

AMASECOYA (D Johnson) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied in the early stages for a distance.

ZENNTARI (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly, and then steadied off heels shortly after losing ground.

DESERT STORM (S Collett) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

DARE TO COMPARE (A Goindasamy) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels shortly after jumping away.

CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) – Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres.

DALMAR (E McCall) – Inconvenienced near the 250 metres.

ANATOW (O Bosson) – Raced in restricted room briefly entering the final straight.

HE CAN SING (S Collett) – Began very awkwardly losing ground after being fractious in its barrier.

DIOGENES (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHARWING (T Thornton) – Crowded and checked passing the 1200 metres.

LAKE SUPERIOR (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

S Collett (HE CAN SING) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

B R Jones (BREAK THE RULES) – Admitted a charge in that he permitted his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SHARWING which was crowded and checked passing the 1200 metres. The Judicial Committee suspended B R Jones' license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 11 September up to and including racing on 19 September, 5 national riding days.

F Ritchie (SINGOURSONG) – Issued with a warning for presenting SINGOURSONG to race without notified gear (side winkers).

ANTIGUA (S Spratt) – Slow away. Blundered passing the 300 metres and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FIRED (L Satherley) – Slow away.

EGO FAST (M Hashizume) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

<p>BORDER LEICESTER (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>SHOCKING PENNY (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Commenced to over-race when being steadied for a distance near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>MANCHU (L Innes) – Lost the left front plate during the running.</p>	
Race 7	FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1200
<p>RETALICK (R Jones) – Slow away.</p> <p>IRISH MIST (M Hashizume) – Lay in shortly after the start making firm contact with WHEAO which was placed in restricted room for a short distance, then over-raced for a distance.</p> <p>TROUBLE (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had over-raced in a fresh state and failed to run on when placed under pressure.</p>
