Race 1 - Site Land Development 1200

RESURRECT (C Lammas) – Trainer P Gerard advised Stewards that the gelding has now been sent for a spell.

Hawke's Bay Racing Inc. - 31 August 2019

Race 9 - TARZINO TROPHY 1400

ENDLESS DRAMA (L Innes) – Trainer T Pike advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the entire and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

COMEBACK (M Cameron) – Trainers D and G Rogerson reported that COMEBACK was humanely euthanased on veterinary advice after suffering a significant injury to the near foreleg.

Whangarei Racing Club - 31 August 2019

Race 6 - Harcourts Whangarei (1200 metres)

TIME TO FLY (BR Jones) – Trainer A Tait advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 8 - Ruakaka Christmas at the Races - Book Now (2100 metres)

VAN BLANC (V Colgan) – Trainer N Tiley advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is now his intention to freshen the gelding prior to racing next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 CAL ISUZU 2100

ZEDCREST (A Goindasamy) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance Apprentice Rider A Goindasamy advised that the gelding would prefer more testing conditions.

CENTURY MISS (S Collett) – Travelled wide throughout.

BELLE TESTA (D Johnson) – Briefly contacted by SEEMAX passing the 500 metres and then raced in restricted room for a distance.

Race 2 WAIPA AT TE RAPA 1600

MIANJO (A Calder) – Slow away.

EQUATE (T Harris) – Raced wide throughout.

I'M NOT JOKING (T Yanagida) – Crowded 900 metres and restrained losing ground. Became awkwardly placed clipping a heel passing the 600 metres.

A Calder (MIANJO) – Issued with a warning after permitting MIANJO to shift out near the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of I'M NOT JOKING which was crowded losing ground.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

ONE MADISON (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider O Bosson could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 metres)

ARABIAN GIFT (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the early stages when wide without cover.

MY SUPERIOR GIRL (A Calder) – Made brief contact with the running rail near the 200 metres before being corrected by its rider.

JUST A PHOEBE (S Collett) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

Race 5 AMBER GARDEN CENTRE 1400

ST ANDRE (T Yanagida) - Jumped awkwardly inconveniencing VAN DIAMOND.

VAN DIAMOND (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced start. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

MOCCASIN (A Goindasamy) - Crowded after leaving the barriers.

SOKITOME (J Fawcett) - Eased down soon after entering the final straight by its rider. A post-race veterinary examination found SOKITOME to have suffered a left-fore digital flexor tendon tear. Connections were advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required if the gelding was to race again.

R Beemud (CAPELLANI) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively.

Race 6 MELBOURNE CUP AT TE RAPA 5 NOVEMBER (1200 metres)

GLORIOUS SIREN (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

RAGE (C Grylls) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barriers and was steadied.

BLITZABEEL (M McNab) – Briefly contacted approaching the 200 metres by LET ME TELL YA (C Lammas) which lay out and away from FLAUNT IT GIRL with both runners becoming unbalanced. Rider C Lammas was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

LET ME TELL YA (C Lammas) - Made brief contact approaching the 200 metres becoming unbalanced.

SWEET PAINTED LADY (A Goindasamy) - Underwent an endoscopic examination following the race which revealed no blood or mucus in the trachea but it was recommended that a video scope be performed to access any potential respiratory issues.

FOCUSING (S Spratt) - Received veterinary treatment following the race after having been found to be mildly lame in the near foreleg.

E McCall (SLEEPY GEEG) – Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 7 J F GRYLLS MEMORIAL (1600 metres)

WOODEN EDGE (D Danis) - Began awkwardly.

CRYSTALLIZE (M Hashizume) – The saddle shifted forward on CRYSTALLIZE passing the 1300 metres placing apprentice rider M Hashizume in difficulty for the remainder of the race.

SOUTHERN PRINCESS (M Kareem) - Restrained away from heels passing the 1000 metres.

EL COOLIO (R Smyth) - Rider dropper her whip approaching the 300 metres.

D Danis (WOODEN EDGE) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 8 VALACHI DOWNS 1200

QUEEN OF THE AIR (M McNab) – Reared as the start was effected and jumped away awkwardly losing ground as a result. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance Rider M McNab was unable to offer any excuse other than possibly not being comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to have delayed recovery.

WALKIN' BY (C Grylls) – Slow away.

SCARFI (S Collett) - Raced wide without cover.

Jockey of the 2nd placed horse **SCARFI** wished to view Stewards footage electing not to proceed with a protest.
