Race 1 TARANAKI-WANGANUI THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS 800

SWEY MY WAY (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly settling back.

LIT'L ROCK (L Satherley) - Raced greenly crossing the junction onto the course proper.

Race 2 WANGANUI CHRONICLE MAIDEN 1200

THEWAYYOUMADEME (M Cameron) – Made contact with **KUSUDA** at the start shifting out making heavy contact with the hind quarters of **SHOWSHANELLE** which was unbalanced for a short distance.

SHOWSHANELLE (H Andrew) – Contacted and unbalanced at the start.

KUSUDA (R Hannam) - Tightened at the start settling back. Rider reported mount unsuited to H10

HERMES (B Ansell) – Slow away.

THATZ DAISY (C McLean) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

BELLE PLAISIR (D Johnson) - Steadied near the end of the back straight when **GO JAMES** (L Allpress) shifted in prior to being straightened. After questioning riders L Allpress was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).

CARDINAL O'CEIRIN (M Hudson) - Rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.

MAGNESS (S Spratt) - Lay out entering the home straight briefly inconveniencing BELLE PLAISIR.

C O'BEIRNE (OUR WAY) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

STEVO'S DISTRIBUTORS 1200

GOBUYIT (H Andrew) - Tightened at the start and settled back.

BEFORE DAWN (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly. Finished some distance last and was not persevered with. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer M Breslin undertook to report the filly's progress in the coming days should anything arise.

DRATINI (R Elliot) - Hung rounding the final turn.

VIVA LILLI (C Grylls) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

FULL SWING (D Turner) - Trainer C Gibson attributed the mare's improved performance to having being freshened since last start and more so to the application of blinkers.

THE O'LEARYS FILLIES STAKES 1200

FLAUNTING (S Spratt) – Slow away. When questioned into the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SWEET CLEMENTINE (A Calder) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres, running wider on the track.

DUBAI'S MOKO (L Satherley) - Raced greenly throughout.

C Grylls (RIVA CAPRI) - Was spoken to regarding his usage of the whip prior to the 100 metres when marginally outside the guideline.

SORRENTINA (D Johnson) - Lost the off-hind plate during the running.

TAKE IT EASY TOURS 2040

DONARDO (D Johnson) – Slow away. Got its head in the air when being restrained near the 1,700 metres.

HARD TO BE HUMBLE (M Hudson) – Slow away.

ZARTAN (D Turner) - Tightened near the 1,000 metres when JOHNNY LINCOLN shifted in.

OUR BANDIT (C O'Beirne) - Inclined to lug outwards under pressure in the home straight.

LIQUORLAND OPEN HANDICAP 2040

HAMILTONIAN (L Allpress) - Slow away – 5L.

DR WATSON (B Ansell) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

SWEET TREAT (R Elliot) – Rider had no excuse for disappointing run. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

D TURNER (Charlie Horse) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (2) after making a celebratory gesture immediately prior to the winning post.

Race 7 DAVE HOSKIN CARRIERS OPEN HANDICAP 1200

KING COUGAR (T Harris) - Began awkwardly contracting YIN DRAGON with both runners settling back.

YIN DRAGON (R Hannam) - Contacted at the start settling back. When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate a longer distance.

BROTHER ONE (L Allpress) - Held up for a short distance early in the home straight before angling across heels to the inside passing the 200 metres to gain clear running.

Race 8 HS DYKE WANGANUI GUINEAS 1340

WORLD TOUR (D Turner) – Began awkwardly. Hung rounding the turn.

THISTLE DO (C O'Beirne) - Slow away. Restrained off the heels of the tiring WORLD TOUR passing the 600 metres.

COOGA DOON (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained before being able to improve forward to lead near the 800 metres.

CHECKERS (M Cameron) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

RISING RANSOM (C Grylls) –Tightened near the 900 metres when **BLUE RATA ELIGIUS** (R Myers) made the corner awkwardly and rolled in. After questioning riders it was established that **WORLD TOUR** shifted out which contributed to the tightening nevertheless R Myers was advised to exercise more care.

Race 9 ST JOHN'S CLUB 1600

LORD VALENTINE (T Harris) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

KATIEM MARIE (C McLean) - Slow away.

PENELOPE CRUISE (D Turner) – Slow away.

KARIMA (M Singh) – Steadied off the heels of the tiring PENNY ROYAL which rolled out near the 450 metres.

KIRKLAND (M Hudson) - Lay inwards early in the home straight bumping KEEP IT SAVVY.

KEEP IT SAVVY (R Hannam) - Bumped 350 metres.
