WHISKEY IN THE JAR (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for a distance near the 1000 metres.

AUGUSTACE (J Laking) – Over raced in the early stages getting its head up passing the 1300 metres on a number of occasions.

BAKELA (B Murray) – Improved wide from the 800 metres.

PICKUP (K Williams) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.

B Murray (BAKELA) was reminded of his obligations regarding whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 2 NZ CUP MEETING TICKETS ON SALE NOW MAIDEN (1400m)

NERO (K Mudhoo) – Came together with RUMOUR HAS IT after jumping making firm contact and getting back as a result.

BIG WINK (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

RUMOUR HAS IT (K Williams) – Came together with NERO after jumping making firm contact and getting back as a result.

TOO PRECIOUS (L Callaway) – Lay inwards and got its head up passing the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously for some distance.

MISS OAKS (K Asano) – Placed in restricted room near the 900 metres touching the rail and badly unbalancing the rider for a short distance, held up in the early stages of the run home, was not afforded clear running throughout the final straight. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FAUX PAS (T Moseley) – Held up for a distance passing the 500 metres.

BRUCE BANNER (T Jonker) – Rider dropped her whip passing the 200 metres.

S Weatherley (DR PEPPER) was warned for whip use on a runner out of contention.

ATHENE (S Collett) – Rider reported that the mare would not have appreciated the testing track conditions after being trapped wide throughout.

WALK WITH KINGS (D Prastiyou) – Rider reported that the mare had over raced in the early stages.

Race 3 GROUP 1 RACEDAY PARTY 21 SEPTEMBER RATING 82 (1400m)

DIORISSIMO (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

GRAND RIO (C Johnson) – Over raced in the middle stages.

MISS BRAHMOS (S Collett) – Held up on entering the home straight. When questioned regarding performance the rider reported that in her opinion the mare may not have been suited to today's testing track conditions.

Race 4 SPEIGHT'S RATING 65 (1000m)

MEARA MARY – S Toolooa replaced T Jonker who was unable to make the contracted weight. **T Jonker** admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) and was fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee.

MIROSLAVA (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back as a result.

MEARA MARY (S Toolooa) – Bounded as the start was effected, steadied passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels when QUATTRO KATIE lay inwards crossing the junction.

ADMIRAL ROUS (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards, shifted inwards near the 300 metres bumping with MIROSLAVA.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5 NZ BLOODSTOCK THREE-YEAR-OLD (1000m)

The start was delayed when several runners proved difficult to load.

MISS FEDERER (K Asano) – The connections were advised that a barrier manners warning would be placed against the filly's racing record and that the filly will be loaded early in future races.

EASY ON THE EYE (D Prastiyou) – Began awkwardly getting back.

SAKURA BELLE (BB Hong) – Slow to begin and further hampered when awkwardly placed between runners.

BRONTE BEACH (C Johnson) – Steadied passing the 700 metres, placed in restricted room near the 500 metres making contact with ALL ABOUT MAGIC which was buffeted and PAPAGENA which lay in under pressure being unbalanced for a short distance.

GINNY (C Barnes) – Inclined to lay inwards in the early stages of the home straight. Rider was reminded of her obligations regarding whip use on a runner out of contention.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (S Weatherley) – Contacted and buffeted near the 500 metres.

PAPAGENA (S Toolooa) – Contacted and unbalanced near the 500 metres, lay outwards passing the 400 metres having to be straightened, lay inwards under pressure near the 200 metres.

CROP (K Kwo) – Inclined to lay in under pressure through the final 150 metres.

INTIMIDATE (C Campbell) – Lay inwards passing the 250 metres having to be straightened and was inclined to lay inwards through the concluding stages.

D Prastiyou (EASY ON THE EYE) was warned for his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 6 GAVELHOUSE.COM OPEN HANDICAP (1000m)

EMILY MARGARET (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

IRISH EXCUSE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and shifted inwards across heels.

The track was upgraded to Heavy (10) retrospective to this race.

Race 7 PRYDE'S EASIFEED RATING 72 (1200m)

ISHINKTAATLEDO (BB Hong) – Slow to begin.

KHIMAR WAR (J Lowry) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

EXPRESS RIP (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MIDDAGURD (J Laking) – Hampered between runners after the start and got back, over raced in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

MISS SCANDINAVIA (M McNab) – Hampered between runners after the start and got back. When questioned regarding performance, rider reported in his opinion the mare would benefit from further distance and better track conditions.

TURNCOAT (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.

NELLIE BLY (S Weatherley) – Raced in restricted room in the shadows of the post.

Race 8 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO OPEN HANDICAP (1600m)

RAISE YOU TEN (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

SHEZATOUCHA (S Collett) – Raced keenly through the early stages. After finishing a distant last a post race veterinary inspection was undertaken which revealed the mare to be sore behind which will be followed up.

OWEN PATRICK (D Prastiyou) – Inclined to lay inwards throughout the final straight having to be steadied off heels approaching the 100 metres.

T Moseley (NOMEN LUDI) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at national race meetings for 7 days effective from the conclusion of racing on 7 September up to and including 20 September.

Race 9 US NAVY FLAG AT VALACHI DOWNS RATING 65 (1400m)

TRUE ELEGANCE – L Callaway replaced T Jonker (overweight) when no suitable rider was available.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

DANGEROUS PONY (S Toolooa) – Hampered when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (C Campbell) – Steadied when in restricted room shortly after the start.

QUEEN JETSUN (K Williams) – Made firm contact with RAFF shortly after the start with RAFF becoming unbalanced momentarily.

RAFF (BB Hong) – Contacted shortly after the start becoming momentarily unbalanced, raced wide in the early stages.

ARNAGE (K Asano) – Raced keenly when in the lead through the early and middle stages.

HIGHLY XCITED (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout.

THOM BROWN (C Johnson) – Held up on entering the straight having to shift ground across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

K Williams (QUEEN JETSUN) made a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post and after hearing submissions was fined \$150 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 10 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1800m)

RELIABLE GLOW (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

AMOUR LA VIE (T Moseley) – Tightened shortly after the start and got back. When questioned regarding performance the rider stated that the mare after getting back early had been disadvantaged by the slow tempo and failed to run on.

AHYUM (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

HEAVEN KNOWS (R Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Firmly contacted 300 metres.

RAISE YOU FIVE (J Lowry) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SPECTRA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages, held up on entering the home straight for a short distance.

GLOSS (M McNab) - Raced wide throughout.

MAMBA (BB Hong) – Held up on entering the home straight, lay inwards under pressure passing the 300 metres and made firm contact with HEAVEN KNOWS.

C Campbell (BRIDGET TOWN) admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at national race meetings for 6 days effective from the conclusion of racing on 7 September up to and including 19 September.
