<b>Auckland Racing Club Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> September 2019</b> <u>Race 2 - BARFOOT &amp; THOMPSON 1200</u> <b>SPEEDY MEADY</b> - Trainer S Ralph was questioned regarding comments he made on Trackside Television regarding the performance. S Ralph advised that he had been satisfied with the gelding's condition leading into the race and SPEEDY MEADY had not missed any work. S Ralph's explanation was noted and was further advised of his obligation to report to Stewards anything that may affect a horse's performance.

## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ULTIMATE MAZDA 1600</b>
<b>FOURCHOUX</b> (A Calder) – Crowded leaving the barrier.	
<b>CAPTAIN REG</b> (S Spratt) - Knuckled leaving the barrier.	

**BLADE RUNNER** (A Goindasamy) - Hampered passing the 500 metres when crowded between GLAD ALL OVER (T Yanagida) which was attempting to maintain his position one off the fence and FOURCHOUX (A Calder) which lay in. Riders T Yanagida and A Calder were both advised to exercise care when in a similar position.

**Race 2** | **PANUI LODGE JIM PENDER 1200**

**S Ralph** - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Scheduled after WAR PATH was presented to race without notified gear (ear covers).

**WAR PATH** (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly. Held up rounding the final bend until shifting out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

**RAZOR** (J Fawcett) - Crowded and hampered 900 metres.

**M Hashizume** (WAR PATH) - Issued with a warning after allowing WAR PATH to improve inside the heels of VOLTAIRE'S SECRET passing the 900 metres shifting in and crowding RAZOR which was hampered losing ground.

**TRIPLE HEART** (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider S Weatherley advised the filly failed to handle the existing track conditions.

**Race 3** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 metres)**

**GREYVEE** (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**Race 4** | **GARTSHORE FIT OUTS 1400**

**BURTON** (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

**Race 5** | **TRITON PACIFIC 1400**

**TE WAEWAE BAY** (A Calder) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**TIPICAL** (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**OUR SHAMAN** (C Lammas) - Over raced in the early stages having to be steadied away from heels.

**NASHA RIVA** (T Thornton) - Made the 900 metre bend awkwardly. When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer J Pender advised that the mare raced closer to the speed than he would have liked fresh up at Te Rapa 3<sup>rd</sup> August and that NASHA RIVA was suited today when ridden off the speed further advising that the mare had a good course and distance record.

**Race 6** | **WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 2100**

**CASSIO** (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

**CANZAC** (L Satherley) - Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels shortly after the start losing ground.

**SHAHANA** (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with REFLECTION which became briefly unbalanced.

**GINGEE** (J Fawcett) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

**COMPULSIVE** (M Coleman) - When questioned regarding performance rider M Coleman could offer no tangible excuses. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

**ROCKWITHATTITUDE** (D Danis) - Rider D Danis was questioned as to why had appeared to relax his ride early in the final straight. D Danis explained that he had become concerned after ROCKWITHATTITUDE felt indifferent however when a runner had improved to his outside the gelding had corrected itself.
