RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS 1600m
OUR BOY BAZ (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.	

SUN GENES (K Asano) – Raced wide early.

ELEGIDO (C Johnson) – Raced keenly early stages. Was placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no tangible excuses other than the mare had not been entirely comfortable with the very holding nature of the track. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

R Beeharry (BLUEY'S CHANCE) – Was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out crowding ELEGIDO passing the 250 metres.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (R Beeharry) – Raced keenly when leading through the early to middle stages. Lay out early in the run home and shifted out passing the 250 metres having to be straightened. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that his mount had over raced when challenged for the lead in the early to middle stages and had very little left over the concluding stages. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

TUILANA (J Fawcett) – Lost a near fore racing plate during the running.

Race 2 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1200m**

SUPERSTITION (L Callaway) – Late scratched on vet's advice at 12.46 pm after arriving at the barrier and found to have aggravated an old injury on the off hind leg with an amount of blood present on the leg.

SUPER TAP (K Williams) – Late scratched at 12.48 pm for refusing to load. The connections were advised the filly must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing again.

FEEL THE RUSH (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

HOT TAP (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the lead through the early and middle stages.

MISS OAKS (K Asano) – Held up on entering the home straight when attempting a marginal run to the inside of HOT TAP having to steady and shift ground across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

J Lowry (SADLER'S LASS) – Issued with a warning after weighing in 0.6 kgs above his weighed out weight.

Race 3 | **SPEIGHTS 1200m**

MOSS JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Late scratched at 1.15 pm by order of the Stewards after escaping riderless and slipping over on the crossing. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed nothing significant other than minor lacerations.

TICKETS ON HER (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

MIDDAGURD (K Asano) – Raced wide early stages.

REGENT STREET (R Beeharry) – Attempted to improve wide from the 450 metres. When questioned about the performance of favoured runner rider reported that the mare had not let down in the holding track conditions.

Race 4 | **PGG WRIGHTSON REAL ESTATE SOUTH OTAGO CUP 1400m**

DREAMING EASY (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

IRISH EXCUSE (BB Hong) – Steadied momentarily when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.

K Asano (LOCHAN ORA) – Issued with a warning for careless riding after allowing his mount to shift out passing the 400 metres crowding IRISH EXCUSE who had to be steadied. Stewards took into consideration there was some inward movement from RAISE YOU TEN at this point as well.

Race 5 | **HARCOURTS DUNEDIN MELBOURNE CUP DAY MAIDEN 1600m**

MY CASHIER (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

GERRY JOYCE (K Mudhoo) – Placed in restricted room for some distance passing the 900 metres having to be steadied.

WALK WITH KINGS (R Beeharry) – Crowded and placed in restricted room for a distance passing the 900 metres having to be steadied.

C Johnson (PUSHYALUCK) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in at the 900 metres crowding GERRY JOYCE and WALK WITH KINGS which both had to be steadied. After hearing evidence and viewing the films the JCA imposed a suspension from the end of racing on Saturday 14 September up to and including 26 September (7 days).

MAH GIRL (K Williams) – Held up by tiring runner rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room inside the final 300 metres.

PUSHYALUCK (C Johnson) – When spoken to in regard to the improved performance Trainer S Woodsford advised the mare had benefited from a wet track and a positive ride.

Race 6 | **WHITE ROBE LODGE MAIDEN 1200m**

GAS CRAIC (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres having to be heavily restrained when awkwardly placed on heels shifting inwards abruptly crowding TRAMWAY ROAD who was hampered passing the 900 metres. The connections were advised the mare was on a racing manners warning.

HERMANO ROSE (K Asano) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TRAMWAY ROAD (J Fawcett) – Hampered passing the 900 metres.

RAY'S IN COMMAND (J Laking) – Raced wide throughout. Bumped passing the 250 metres.

HIGHLY CHARGED (B Murray) – Lay inwards passing the 250 metres making contact with RAY'S IN COMMAND.

Race 7 | **WINGATUI EVENT CENTRE 1200m**

MIROSLAVA (R Beeharry) – Reared at the start losing ground. Had to be restrained when improving quickly onto heels at the 700 metres.

TACHIBANA (R Mudhoo) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runners.

DON'T BE CHEEKY (A Bohorun) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

FINE BOUQUET (BB Hong) – Attempted to buck shortly after the start and was retired from the event. The connections were advised that the mare will have to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing again.

DEVIIOUS (B Murray) – Lay out over the concluding stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the gelding had not handled today's holding track conditions.

Race 8 | **CONGRATULATIONS JACKFROST 1600m**

DOWRY DUTY (BB Hong) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with a rail in the Birdcage and was cleared to start.

BRIDGET TOWN (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

SOUTHERN JAZZ (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

EAGER BEAVER (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout. Lay inwards passing the 200 metres.

ODYSSEUS (K Mudhoo) – Began to over race passing the 1200 metres and shifted out forcing SMOKEM UP wider on the track. Continued to over race and had to be heavily restrained passing the 900 metres when improving quickly onto heels shifting ground outwards and hampering DREAM RICH who was forced wider on the track.

SMOKEM UP (J Fawcett) – Forced wider on the track passing the 1200 metres. Placed in restricted room having to steady passing the 250 metres when weakening.

GOLDEN VALKYRIE (R Mudhoo) – Over raced in the early stages.

BET YA WOOD (B Murray) – Over raced through the early stages and had to be heavily restrained away from heels passing

the 900 metres. Hampered passing the 200 metres when EAGER BEAVER lay inwards and dictated it across heels having to be steadied as a result.

DREAM RICH (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Hampered and forced wider on the track passing the 900 metres.

J Fawcett (SMOKEM UP) – Issued with a warning under the careless riding rule when allowing her mount to shift in passing the 900 metres when only marginally clear BET YA WOOD who was over racing and had to be restrained resulting in the trailing ODYSSEUS having to be heavily restrained and shifted outwards to avoid heels hampering DREAM RICH.

S Toolooa (SOUTHERN JAZZ) – Was issued with a warning for his whip use on a runner out of contention.
