Race 1	TOTAL TRANSPORT TAUPU 1800

VALHEXA (J Fawcett) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

GONE WEST (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

OH WHAT FUN (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. Had to be steadied and shift out when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of LUMINOUS then had to shift out to obtain clear running.

LUMINOUS (O Bosson) – Had to be briefly steadied passing the 500 metres when awkwardly placed on heels then shifted out to obtain clear running.

ACACIA (D Mansour) - Shifted out when placed under pressure with AMARED ROSE shifting away from that runner crowding GLOBAL DIAMOND which had to be steadied, also contributing was inward movement from MALIBU MAGIC near the 75 metres.

LEADERBOARD (O Bosson) - Slow to begin.

POINTSETTIA (J Waddell) - Slow to begin.

TROUBLE (C Grylls) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

FASTELLIE (L Satherley) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Raced keenly in the middle stages. Contacted and momentarily unbalanced passing the 100 metres.

FAMILIA (T Yanagida) –Held up passing the 300 metres shifting out inconveniencing TROUBLE which was improving forward. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight shifting in passing the 100 metres making firm contact with the hind quarters of FASTELLIE who was momentarily unbalanced.

T Yanagida (FAMILIA) Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for shifting ground passing the 300 metres.

FLYING TRAPEZE (T Thornton) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.

SCOTCH (M Coleman) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.

SOFT HEARTED (A Calder) – Lay out when making the junction onto the course proper hampering OUT OF THE PARK and BRIDGEWATER.

OUT OF THE PARK (C Grylls) - Hampered near the 1150 metres.

BRIDGEWATER (M Coleman) - Hampered near the 1150 metres. Made the bend awkwardly near the 750 metres forcing BABY FACE wider. Raced greenly for a distance passing the 650 metres when placed in restricted room and again when placed under pressure in the final straight.

BABY FACE (J Waddell) - Forced wider near the 750 metres.

FAMOUS BELLE (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TWO MADISON (S Spratt) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 150 metres to the inside of FLASHDANCE (T Yanagida) which shifted in. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care.

Race 4	CELEBRATING MELODY BELLE (1200 metres)
<p>SPIRITED (D Johnson) - Slow away. Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>GALLAGHER (S McKay) – Stood in its barrier stall and refused to jump away with the field losing considerable ground (15L). Trainer J McKay was advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>LILIKOI (M McNab) - Began awkwardly then shifted in crowding FURIOUS WALK and SPIRITED. Held up rounding the final bend having to shift out to obtain clear running.</p> <p>FURIOUS WALK (D Mansour) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>HIGHLIGHTER (T Yanagida) - Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly making firm contact with HIERARCHY which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>FINE LEG (H Andrew) - Had to be firmly restrained for a distance passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>SLEEPY GEEG (E McCall) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of FINE LEG (H Andrew), which shifted out passing the 300 metres, then was further hampered near the 250 metres when FINE LEG shifted out and away from LILIKOI which had improved to its inside.</p> <p>H Andrew (FINE LEG) issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift out near the 300 metres placing SLEEPY GEEG in restricted room.</p>	
Race 5	JUMP JOCKEY'S SEND IT (1300 metres)
<p>RED HUSSAR (T Thornton) - Had to be firmly restrained shortly after the start when becoming awkwardly placed on heels of SIG POSITANO which was taken out by WILD WEST which had been dictated outwards by EXCITONIC. Contributing was inward movement from MIRADELLO. Held up having to be firmly restrained passing the 200 metres then improved onto heels over the concluding stages having to be steadied.</p> <p>EXCITONIC (O Bosson) Did not obtain clear running throughout the final straight.</p> <p>SIG POSITANO (R Hannam) - Over raced in the early to middle stages. Held up entering the final straight then had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of MIRADELLO which shifted in near the 50 metres.</p> <p>EASYRIDER (R Elliot) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>PRINCESS CATHARINA (L Satherley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start.</p> <p>PLATINUM ROAD (J Riddell) – Checked passing the 200 metres when crowded by RED HUSSAR (T Thornton) which shifted into a marginal run to the outside of SIG POSITANO (R Hannam) which was being dictated out by NOTHING COMPARES which had shifted out when being corrected after making firm contact with WILD WEST. Contributing was inward movement from RIVER RISING which was forced inwards by MIRADELLO (L Innes). After viewing all the videos and talking to riders concerned riders R Hannam, L Innes and T Thornton were advised they need to exercise care when shifting ground.</p> <p>RIVER RISING (S Spratt) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 200 metres.</p>	

L Innes (MIRADELLO) Issued with a warning for allowing his mount MIRADELLO to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SIG POSITANO which had to be steadied.

<p>QUEEN OF THE AIR (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground. (6L).</p> <p>PAISLEY PARK (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>EN SOIE (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>J Kam OTTAVIO Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>O Bosson PRISE DE FER Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	GET SET EVENT HIRE 1300
<p>BLUE OCEAN (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up between the 250 and 150 metres.</p> <p>SEVEN SEAS (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>BLITZABEEL (M McNab) - Placed in restricted room having to steady shortly after the start.</p> <p>R James trainer of AMAL ROSE wished to view the videos as to lodging a protest against the winner SHOWBOAT but elected not to proceed.</p>	
Race 8	HOUSE OF TRAVEL TAUPO 1100
<p>OUR CREED (S Spratt) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Hampered 900 metres. Forced wider 350 metres.</p> <p>ACTING UP (D Johnson) – Became fractious in the barrier making contact with the front of the starting gates as they were released losing ground (1L) and was not preserved with over the final 150 metres with the filly undergoing a post race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>HE'S A GOLD DIGGER (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly then commenced to over race through the early stages. Made the bend awkwardly running wide passing the 350 metres forcing FOO AN SONGS and OUR CREED over extra ground.</p> <p>KING MIDAS (T Thornton) Commenced to over race when being steadied passing the 900 metres shifting out abruptly hampering OUR CREED, GIRLFROMTHENORTH, and WHISPERING WIND. Continued to race ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p>FOO AN SONGS (V Colgan) - Forced wider 350 metres.</p> <p>GIRLFROMTHENORTH (D Mansour) -Hampered 900 metres.</p> <p>WHISPERING WIND (M Coleman) - Hampered 900 metres.</p>	
Race 9	FARMLANDS TAUPO STAYERS 1800
<p>VAN DIAMOND (M Cameron) - Made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly when racing keenly and shifted out forcing BATTLE ROYAL over further ground. Then continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 1000 metres. Made the bend near the 750 metres awkwardly and shifted out</p> <p>BATTLE ROYAL (J Fawcett) -Forced wider when making the bend near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>DESERT STORM (S Collet) - Began awkwardly.</p>	

TE WAEWAE BAY (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

ZENNTARI (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

WAR OF WORDS (C Burdan) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EPAE ROAD (S Spratt) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight making contact with ALMO COSTA passing the 50 metres.
