RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 NZ CUP MEETING TICKETS ON SALE NOW MAIDEN 1200M

 CAPODANNO(AUS) (S Collett) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runners. Keen early and middle stages.

LEONARDO (J Laking) – Made contact with EXCLAIM passing the 300 metres shifting wider forcing ATHENE over extra ground. Returned to the birdcage with blood present to the nostril. A post race Veterinary Inspection revealed to be a bleeder with the Trainer reporting that its their intention to retire the gelding from their stable as a racing proposition.

ALWAYS (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly shifting out and making firm contact with ATHENE losing ground as a result.

EXCLAIM (T Moseley) – Contacted passing the 300 metres. Rider reported mare had raced keenly early and in his opinion would derive benefit from todays race.

ATHENE (L Callaway) - Contacted 300 metres, bumped and unbalanced 200 metres

MISS DAZZLER (L Hemi) - Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 100 metres.

CHUCK A LUCK (A Calder) – Held up on entering the home straight until inside the 200 metres.

CHARLIE AWESOME(S Wynne) - Shifted ground inwards under pressure throughout the run home.

LETHAL (M McNab) - Held up early in the run home. Lay outwards passing the 200 metres making firm contact with LEONARDO which was forced onto ATHENE which became unbalanced as a result.

M McNab was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

SANCTIFY (D Prastiyou) – Awkwardly placed on heels when laying inwards passing the 400 metres proving a difficult ride for a short distance. Was inclined to lay inwards throughout the straight.

GLORY CHANCE (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin and raced wide throughout.

Race 2 GROUP ONE RACEDAY PARTY MAIDEN 1600M

NERO (K Mudhoo) – Keen early stages having to be restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.

ROULLETTE (K Kwo) – Lay inwards passing the 300 metres.

FIVE PRINCES (L Callaway) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

MONASH (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly through the early stages and had to be restrained away from heels passing the 1000 metres.

TAKE THE DEEL (AUS) (J Laking) - Rider reported gelding to be indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Stewards will follow up with trainer in subsequent days.

FIGEAMEOUT (T Moseley) - Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres and raced ungenerously for a short distance thereafter.

VOWS YOU MADE (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

PER FORM (L Hemi) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when racing keenly through the early to middle stages.

MOLLY MAGUIRE (C Campbell) – Raced greenly throughout the running proving a difficult ride over the concluding stages. The connections were advised that a warning was placed on the racing manners of the mare.

SMART GARDEN (AUS) (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.

Race 3 CANTERBURY WESTLAND RACING OWNERS ASSOCIATION 2000M

IWO JIMA (L Callaway) – When questioned about the improved performance of the winner the trainer reported that the gelding had derived benefit from being given a brief freshen up after its previous start.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (J Laking) – Hampered and dictated outwards passing the 200 metres.

MAMBA (BB Hong) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.

MOLLY POLLY (AUS) (T Moseley) – Held up on entering the home straight, raced in restricted room when steadied passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

O'KIWI (B Murray) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

METASEQUOIA (K Asano) – Slow to begin. Shifted ground passing the 200 metres when under pressure dictating BEAM ME UP SCOTTY outwards.

K Asano was reminded of his obligations when METASEQUOIA lay outwards in the concluding stages.

Race 4 THE CRAIC IRISH BAR ON RICCARTON ROAD 1600M

RIVALDO (L Callaway) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

PUBLICIST (AUS) (M McNab) – When questioned about the disappointing performance the Rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post race Veterinary Inspection revealed that the gelding suffered from mild tie-up.

SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

AMOUR LA VIE (R Beeharry) – Stood flat footed on jumping losing considerable ground (6 lengths).

Race 5 JANET FRANCIS 2000M

LORD BEAVER (BB Hong) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards abruptly making contact with CINTO BAY.

FABULOUS FLIGHT (J Laking) - Steadied passing the 150 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

PICKUP (K Asano) – Slow to begin.

RIVIERA ROCK (L Hemi) – Placed in restricted room over the final 20 metres when KING OF THE DANCE lay outwards.

BOJANGLES (M McNab) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight. Rider could offer not tangible excuse. The Stewards will follow up with the trainer in the subsequent days.

I'LLAV BUBBLES (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Gave ground from the 800 metres and retired from the race. A post race Veterinary Inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities. Rider reported the mare was not suited to the firmer nature of todays track conditions.

KING OF THE DANCE (R Mudhoo) – Restrained to the rear on jumping. Held up on entering the home straight for a short distance shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

R Mudhoo was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Race 6 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO NEW ZEALAND CUP TRIAL 1800M

DEE AND GEE (S Toolooa) – When spoken to about the performance the Rider reported that the gelding was left flat footed at the 600 metres when placed under pressure and in his opinion would derive benefit from todays outing. A post race Veterinary Inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

OREPUKI LAD (L Hemi) – When spoken to about the performance the Rider reported the gelding had peaked on its run passing the 200 metres and in her opinion the firm nature of todays track conditions played a part in the performance.

OWEN PATRICK (D Prastiyou) – Raced keenly early stages and got its head up when being restrained. Steadied momentarily passing the 150 metres when DIORISSIMO lay inwards.

PAMIR (R Mudhoo) – When spoken to about the performance the Rider could not offer no tangible excuse.

DIORISSIMO (W Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 7 FLAIR OPEN SPRINT 1200M

HE KIN FLY (BB Hong) – Placed in restricted room and hampered at the 1100 metres. Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ROCANTO when laying outwards near the 100 metres.

JOHNNY JONES (K Asano) - Raced wide throughout.

KIWI IDA (Aus) (R Beeharry) – Held up when entering the home straight shifting outwards 250 metres and made firm contact with KILLARNEY

R Beeharry warned for manner in which he shifted ground near the 250 metres.

DARCI MAC (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

KILLARNEY (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room and checked passing the 1100 metres when TURNCOAT was taken inwards by SABER(A Calder). Hampered in this incident were HE KIN FLY and SELFIE which jostled for a distance. Firmly contacted and shifted wider 250 metres.

A Calder (SABER) – Admitted a breach of careless riding near the 1100 metres after hearing submissions and viewing video evidence his licence to ride in races was suspended from 29th September to 9th October inclusive .6 national riding days.

XCUSES XCUSES (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly, shifting outwards abruptly, shifting very wide on the track before being corrected by its rider. A warning was placed on the racing manners.

SELFIE (R Mudhoo) – Crowded and had to be restrained passing the 1000 metres when placed in restricted room.

TURNCOAT (M McNab) – Began awkwardly and blundered.Placed in restricted room when racing keenly near the 1100 metres Trainer reported that the gelding had been galloped on during the running. A subsequent Veterinary Inspection revealed the gelding to have superficial abrasions to the right hock and was treated by the on course Veterinary.

Race 8 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK CANTERBURY BELLE STAKES 1200M

WOODCOTE LASS (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

HOT TAP (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. Steadied when awkwardly on heels passing the 400 metres shifting outwards making contact with FAIRWAY FLIGHT which was buffeted.

INTIMIDATE (T Comignaghi) – The rider reported in her opinion the filly was less than comfortable in the prevailing track conditions Stewards will follow up with Trainer in coming days

SORCERESS (K Assano) - Began awkwardly. Lay inwards passing the 300 metres shifting in making firm contact with FAIRWAY FLIGHT who was buffeted and unbalanced.

K Assano warned for manner in which he shifted ground.

BRONTE BEACH (S Wynne) – Knuckled after the start and got back. Held up on entering the home straight when attempting a marginal run inside heels.

FAIRWAY FLIGHT (C Barnes) –Buffeted 300 metres when placed in restricted room.

LAST HOORAH (B Murray) – Tailed the field throughout the running.

B Murray - Warned for an excessive use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

SUPER TAP (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

Race 9 PRYDE'S EASIFEED 1200M

EXPRESS RIP (K Kwo) – Contacted near the 300 metres being badly unbalanced.

SUMMER MONSOON (M McNab) – Shifted ground inwards passing the 300 metres crowding DREAMTESTA, SENTITO, SUPATWISTA and EXPRESS RIP which was badly unbalanced.

M McNab – Admitted a breach of careless riding near the 300 metres. After hearing all submissions the JCA suspended his licence to ride in races from 26th September until the 4th October .6 national riding days.

DREAMTESTA (BB Hong) – Bumped 350 metres.

CLOONEY (T Moseley) – Slow to begin. Held up entering the home straight gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metre then hampered approaching the 100 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS RICKY BOBBY .

FINAL SAVINGS (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly.

SAINTED PEARL (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SUPATWISTA (R Beeharry) - Contacted near the 300 metres.

RED CHOIS (IRE) (S Collett) - Over raced in the early stages. Lay out over the concluding stages having to be continually straightened.

SENTITO (B Murray) - Bumped 350 metres.

SHE'S GALLANT (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 10 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1400M

SAVAPAK (J Laking) – Wide throughout. Checked passing the 500 metres when GRAND RIO was shifted wider by MISS SCANDINAVIA. Further hampered passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on heels having to steady momentarily.

ISHINKTAATLEDO (BB Hong) – Slow to begin. Held up entering the home straight.

BELLE FASCINO (K Asano) – Raced wide early stages. Hampered near the 500 metres and forced wider on the track.

FIRE LILY (T Moseley) – Held up early in the run home.

TRYFAN (S Collett) – Steadied momentarily passing the 120 metres when in restricted room shifting ground outwards

MISS SCANDINAVIA (M McNab) – Got its head up when being restrained off heels shortly after the start. Shifted ground outwards near the 500 metres dictating GRAND RIO outwards into the running of SAVAPAK which was checked

M McNab - Admitted a breach of careless riding near the 500 metres with the JCA suspending his licence to ride in races from 5th October up to and including 16th October.8 national days.

TANTALISING (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 450 metres. Lay inwards passing the 250 metres and had to be straightened.

UPSCALE (B Murray) – Slow to begin then raced keenly in the early stages.

Stipendiary Stewards report as posted is provisional and subject to further review and amendment.
