RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SSANGYONG 800
BELLE FOLIE (A Go	oindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOT AN OPTION (L Innes) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight making brief contact with LADY TELENA passing the 350 metres.

LADY TELENA (S Weatherley) – Crowded start. Briefly contacted 350 metres.

SWEY MY WAY (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

CHILLI CHOUX (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

EDGE OF WONDER (R Elliot) – Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight.

Race 2 COLLIERS INTERNATIONAL 2200

TIPPING POINT (A Calder) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground.

I WALK ALONE (L Satherley) – Was under pressure passing the 350 metres and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be a bleeder, and as such is subject to a 3 month stand down from racing and a 2 month stand down from training, with a veterinary certificate of fitness required prior to racing or trialing.

UABASSO (R Smyth) – Steadied over the concluding stages when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

M Cameron (AZABEAT) – Issued with a warning for using the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Linnes (DOUBLE HAPPY) – Issued with a warning for using the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 COLLETT RACING STABLES 1200

GO NICHOLAS (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres to the inside of IRISH MIST (M Hashizume) which lay in under pressure. Apprentice M Hashizume was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

Race 4 YOUNG FAMILY 1200

TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously approaching the 900 metres.

MOUNT MIDORIYAMA (T Yanagida) – Steadied 1000 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of AUTUMN FLASH (C Grylls) which had improved to inside the heels of BULLYBROOK which was shifting in. C Grylls was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

BULLYBROOK (R Smyth) – Steadied 500 metres when improving on to heels. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.

BEWITCHED (A Goindasamy) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

GALWAY BRO (M Hashizume) – Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 100 metres when attempting to improve into a marginal run.

Race 5 VETERINARY ASSOCIATES 1400

CHERRY LANE (R Smyth) – Required farrier attention after arriving on course with the left front plate having to be reapplied after having cast the plate when being transported to the course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection being passed suitable to race.

PRINCE HAREEM (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages when improving on to heels. Held up early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

PEACEFUL (J Riddell) – Crowded and steadied approaching the 300 metres to the inside of CHERRY LANE (R Smyth) which shifted in under pressure. R Smyth was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance with Stewards taking into account that CHERRY LANE had shifted away from COME BACK TIGER.

BLUETWENTYTWO (C Burdan) – Steadied over the concluding stages when laying in across heels.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 Metres)

DON'T DOUBT ME (L Innes) – Slow away. Held up until passing the 350 metres.

ONE MADISON (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

YATIMA (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight.

GARNET (R Elliot) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

PEARLESCENCE (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out approaching the 200 metres, and then was again held up passing the 100 metres for a distance.

EVANA RAHMA (M Coleman) – Had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight crowding KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO over the concluding stages.

KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO (C Grylls) – Crowded over the concluding stages.

FROZEN (O Bosson) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present near the mouth which was found to be consistent with a minor laceration.

Race 7 HAUNUI FARM KARAKA CLASSIC (1600 Metres)

FISCAL FANTASY (L Innes) – Slow away. Held up until near the 300 metres, and shifted in approaching the 100 metres when improving on to heels.

VERRY FLASH (R Smyth) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages, and then had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

HINERANGI (J Riddell) – Held up and steadied approaching the 400 metres, then raced in restricted room for a distance, and was again held up passing the 200 metres and had difficulty obtaining clear running. Had to be steadied approaching the 100 metres.

SMART AS YOU THINK (M Coleman) – Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

TE TORO PEARL (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced when weakening passing the 75 metres.

Race 8 CLOTWORTHY RACING 1600

WHEAO (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly losing ground (6L). Co-trainer M Carter was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

DEPENDSONSITUATION (C Lammas) – Raced ungenerously approaching the 1500 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of RISING RANSOM (C Grylls) which shifted in when only marginally clear. Raced wide for the majority of the race. Inconvenienced 200 metres.

ANATOW (O Bosson) – Commenced to hang out when making the bend near the 900 metres, and continued to hang out for the remainder of the bend running wide passing the 500 metres hampering RISING RANSOM and MR INCREDIBULL which were both forced wide on the track. ANATOW continued to hang out finishing wide on the track. Co-trainer M Rogers was advised that the gelding would be required to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

RISING RANSOM (C Grylls) – Hampered 500 metres and forced wide. When questioned regarding performance C Grylls advised that he had not been helped when he had been hampered and forced wide passing the 500 metres, further advising the gelding had then failed to respond once placed under pressure.

MR INCREDIBULL (M Cameron) – Hampered 500 metres and forced wide.

EL COOLIO (T Thornton) – Held up until shifting in across heels to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

ANSWER BACK (A Goindasamy) – Held up entering the final straight. Crowded passing the 300 metres before steadying and shifting out to obtain clear running inconveniencing DEPENDSONSITUATION. A Goindasamy was advised that he must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

C Grylls (RISING RANSOM) – Issued with a warning after permitting RISING RANSOM to shift in approaching the 1500 metres when not fully clear of DEPENDSONSITUATION which was hampered with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of DEPENDSONSITUATION.
