DIVINE DUKE (T Yanagida) – Slow away.	
FRANCIS DRAKE (S Spratt) – Over-raced through the early stages.	
RODMAR (A Jones) - Rider A Jones was questioned regarding her riding tactics and why she had allowed RODMAR to improve forward to dispute the pace from near the 1000 metres in a three wide position. A Jones explained that she had been given riding instructions to allow the gelding to improve in the middle stages as the gelding had lacked a turn of foot. A Jones's explanation was noted.

<p>GO BOBBY (R Elliot) - Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground. When questioned regarding performance Rider R Elliot could offer no tangible excuses.</p> <p>RAGE (S Collett) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p>CURVE (T Thornton) - Contacted soon after leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced and then steadied. Over-raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>TWO ILLICIT (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LOVE STRUCK (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>KEANO REEVES (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover.</p>	
Race 3	WANDERERS FUNDRAISING LUNCH 4 OCTOBER 1200
<p>ITSY BITSY (L Innes) - Began awkwardly then crowded.</p> <p>PONTIAC (J Waddell) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>SLY BALJO (A Jones) - Tailed off in the early stages becoming detached from the body of the field. Trainer A Meikle was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for being uncompetitive.</p> <p>OCEANS EIGHT (R Elliot) - Held up entering the final straight before shifting out near the 350 meters to obtain clear running.</p> <p>MAJOR BILLY LISTER (S Weatherley) – Briefly steadied when crowded passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>C Lammas (LET ME TELL YA) - Issued with a warning after permitting LET ME TELL YA to shift out near the 150 metres when insufficiently clear of MAJOR BILLY LISTER which was crowded and briefly steadied.</p>	
Race 4	AMBER GARDEN CENTRE 1200
<p>VAMOS BEBE (M McNab) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>THE GREEN DRAGON (D Mansour) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier.</p> <p>ROCINTHEMYST (S Weatherley) - Contacted soon after leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>GREEN HERO (A Calder) - Commenced to hang out soon after leaving the barriers making the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres running wide and forcing IMAREADY and PEARL BODINE wider on the track. Continued to hang out for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>IMAREADY (C Grylls) – Forced wider 900 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final 50 metres between GREEN HERO (A Calder) which continued to lay out and VAMOS BEBE which shifted in slightly. Rider A Calder was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>PEARL BODINE (E McCall) - Forced wider 900 metres.</p> <p>SAM’S SONG (L Satherley) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>REMARKABLE RILEY (V Colgan) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.</p>	

SHY GIRL (L Innes) - Contacted 400 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.	
THREADTHENEEDLE (D Johnson) - Improved onto heels approaching the 300 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running.	
Race 5	SVS 1200
TINY TERROR (C Lammas) - Slow to begin. TINY TERROR returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. TINY TERROR underwent an endoscopic examination and no blood in trachea and blood was from nasal passage/sinus from a possible knock.	
DEELS DONE (D Johnson) - Crowded leaving the barrier.	
TIA CELESTE (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly.	
RISTRETTO (M McNab) - Raced keenly when leading.	
CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (S Collett) – Steadied 800 metres when awkwardly placed.	
TAMMIE WYNETTE (T Yanagida) - Inconvenienced 150 metres when dictated out onto heels by CHIQUITITA (S Spratt) S Spratt was advised to exercise care when in a similar circumstance.	
Race 6	DUNSTAN FEEDS 1400
SCARLET EMERALD (T Yanagida) - Crowded shortly after the start. Crowded and steadied losing ground passing the 1200 metres.	
MAN OH MAN (T Harris) - Crowded becoming unbalanced 1200 metres.	
GIRL OF STEEL (C Burdan) - Lay out approaching the 1200 metres when briefly contacted, crowding SCARLET EMERALD onto MAN OH MAN with SCARLET EMERALD being steadied and losing ground.	
Race 7	FAIRVIEW MOTORS 1600
The start of Race 7 was delayed approximately 10 minutes due to the incidence of lightning.	
ROCKWITHATTITUDE (D Danis) – Stumbled leaving the barrier losing ground.	
PLUSHENKO (D Mansour) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.	
WAY SOUTH (A Calder) - Steadied away from heels near the 1400 metres of BLEW BY YOU which shifted in.	
DRAKE BAY (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.	
BLEW BY YOU (R Smyth) – When question regarding performance Rider R Smyth advised the mare had never travelled well throughout. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality with connections advising that BLEW BY YOU was now likely to be spelled.	
S Ralph (MAN POWER) - Issued with a warning after it was found that he had added a neck strap to the gear of the Jockey after he had weighed out.
