RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HOKONUI CONTRACTING (1335m)
<p>SHE'LL CAT CHOUX (K Kwo) – The notified tail chain applied to the mare was lost on the way to barriers and could not be located. Raced wide without cover throughout. When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner, rider could offer no tangible explanation.</p> <p>SHAKER (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>BELLE SOUTH (B Murray) – Blundered as the start was effected almost dislodging rider B Murray, losing considerable ground and effectively its chance in the race.</p> <p>TRAMWAY ROAD (T Moseley) – Crowded shortly after the start, having to steady when inside runners shifted out.</p> <p>ROCK MASTER (T Comignaghi) – Rider dropped her whip passing the 650 metres.</p> <p>GAS CRAIC (R Beeharry) – Lay outwards throughout the event proving a difficult ride. Connections were advised the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p>	

Race 2	LIVESTOCK SUPPLIES HANDICAP (1335m)
<p>BAKELA (B Murray) – Fractious in its barrier prior to the start and was slow to begin. Steadied when denied a marginal run to the inside of NESTA passing the 50 metres.</p> <p>NOPELE (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ELEGIDO (C Johnson) – Raced keenly and wide in the early stages.</p> <p>OPIO ROSE (A Bohorun) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>SON OF SURF (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>THE STYLE (C Campbell) – Steadied and shifted ground inwards passing the 150 metres when improving on to the heels of the runner in front.</p> <p>REGENT STREET (L Callaway) – When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner, rider advised the mare was not entirely comfortable in the prevailing Heavy 11 track conditions.</p>	
Race 3	LONGFORD TAVERN / FALLS HOTEL (1335m)
<p>TACHIBANA (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>MORRELLMAC (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>HAYWOOD (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance of the favoured runner, rider advised the gelding had travelled well however had had stopped quickly over the concluding stages and was disappointing. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>GARMENT (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>HE'S GOT POWER (R Beeharry) – Held up by a tiring runner rounding the final bend.</p>	
Race 4	BOEHRINGER INGELHEIM (1200m)
<p>JUST HENRI (C Barnes) – Bounded as the start was effected and then made firm contact with LOVE TO DREAM which shifted out at the start. Had to be restrained and steadied passing the 950 metres to avoid the heels of the runner in front and lost ground at this point.</p> <p>ICANTELLYA (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Raced greenly throughout. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.</p> <p>BUSY (K Kwo) – Shifted in shortly after the start making contact with SHOW PARK. Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>GINNY (C Johnson) – Crowded and dictated inwards passing the 950 metres.</p> <p>TO SIR WITH LOVE (A Bohorun) – Checked and had to be restrained passing the 950 metres.</p> <p>RENOUNCE (L Callaway) – Held up by a tiring runner rounding the final bend.</p> <p>L Callaway defended a charge of the Careless Riding Rule in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards passing the 950 metres dictating GINNY inwards on to TO SIR WITH LOVE who was crowded and checked with the trailing JUST HENRI being hampered and having to be restrained. After viewing the replays and hearing evidence from all parties the JCA upheld the charge and suspended Mr Callaway's licence to ride from the 28th September up to and including the 10th October (7 national days)</p>	
Race 5	CROYDEN CONTRACTING HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>DREAMING EASY (T Moseley) – Knuckled at the start and was slow to begin.</p> <p>ALWAYS ON CALL (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	

IRISH EXCUSE (C Campbell) – Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres.

MOSS JAZZ (A Bohorun) – Placed in restricted room and had to steady passing the 200 metres when IRISH EXCUSE lay inwards under pressure. C Campbell was advised to exercise care and ensure in future he straightens his mount sooner than he did so on this occasion.

WHAT'S UP ALF (K Kwo) – Held up for several strides passing the 200 metres. Had to steady in the shadows of the post when ALWAYS ON CALL shifted out under pressure.

BLACK LABEL (K Williams) – When spoken to regarding the performance rider K Williams advised in her opinion the mare may have been feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6	ADVANCE AGRICULTURE HANDICAP (1200m)

VICE MARSHALL (S Toolooa) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

TOUCH THE SKY (B Murray) – Raced wide throughout.

PARK RANGER (K Williams) – Lay outwards throughout and made the bend by the 600 metres awkwardly, losing ground from this point. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have an elevated heart rate however had recovered well after a period of time. Stewards will follow up with the trainer in the coming days.

KNUTQUACKER (K Kwo) – Held up by a tiring runner rounding the final bend.

TIMES TIME (K Asano) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages, shifting wider on the track.

Race 7	AON INSURANCE BROKERS HANDICAP (1800m)

CHOICE DU JEU (C Barnes) – Lost its footing briefly when making the crossing by the 1500 metres.

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) – Made the bend by the 1400 metres awkwardly, shifting out and making contact with NOMEN LUDI.

NOMEN LUDI (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly. Bumped from the inside rounding the bend by the 1400 metres.

PABLEAU (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

MIDNITE KAOS (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

BET YA WOOD (B Murray) – Raced wide in the early stages.

SUN GENES (K Asano) – Raced wide into the first bend. Disputed the lead throughout the back straight.

Stewards questioned Apprentice rider K Asano in the presence of Mr D Walsh regarding the tactics he adopted in the early to middle stages of the race, in particular from the 1400 metres to the 900 metres when he disputed the lead. Mr Asano advised he been instructed not to hurry the horse early but to try and be in the lead by the back straight and then attempt to put some distance between his mount and the remainder of the field. He further advised that after attempting to take the lead he had been unable to cross FLY WITHOUT WINGS and eventually attempted to give his mount some respite but was soon under pressure and had been disappointing. Stewards advised Mr Asano that in their opinion he had erred in his decision not to restrain his mount earlier.

OLAF (T Moseley) – Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 450 metres when KARM 'N' EASY shifted out when looking for clear racing room. K Kwo was advised to exercise care.

PUSHYALUCK (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised the mare had raced keenly in the early stages and in his opinion did not see out the distance of today's race in the prevailing Heavy 11 track conditions.
