SUPPLEMENTARY:

The start of the program was put back by one race due to an incident in the stabling area where a person required attention by paramedics after being kicked and was transferred to Taranaki Base Hospital for observation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TIGER TOWN TREASURE TROVE 990m

GOOD LUCK CHARM (R Myers) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse.

MAISON ROXANNE (J Riddell) – Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres before being angled into a marginal run between SIMOGRAMOR and DESERT MAGIC, making contact with DESERT MAGIC, forcing that runner wider on the track entering the home straight.

TAVI MAC (H Schofer) – Held up rounding the turn and early in the home straight prior to being angled outwards across heels to gain clear running inside the final 200 metres.

TECHNICIAN (C O'Beirne) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance near the 150 metres bumping with SIMOGRAMOR which lay in.

SIMOGRAMOR – Lay in and bumped near the 150 metres.

Race 2 TARANAKI PINE 1300m

AKERRA (H Schofer) – Very slow away. Returned to the enclosure with a deep cut below the hock on the right hind leg which required veterinary attention.

RICKY BAKER (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly settling back.

MANHATTAN FLAME – Slow away.

TOTAL SASS (C Burdan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GAME OF LOVE (S Collett) – Held up for a distance near the 500 metres. Lay out rounding the final turn.

GOODNIGHT IRENE (C O'Beirne) – Shifted in when struck with the whip passing the 200 metres briefly inconveniencing RICKY BAKER which shifted in dictating GAME OF LOVE and NOTHINGLEFTOLOSE.

NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE (K Asano) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of BEFORE DAWN rounding the final turn having to be restrained. Inconvenienced near the 200 metres before being held up and going to the line without being fully tested.

H Andrew GOBUYIT – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regards to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL ESERIES RACE RTG 82 - 1200m

SECRET ALLURE (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly losing ground when restrained at the start. When questioned in the presence of the riding Master, apprentice jockey H Schofer advised that her riding instructions were to settle back from the wide draw but the mare over reacted when being steadied and got further back than intended.

BLANCO BELLE (C O'Beirne) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of AMASTAR which shifted in and away from SUGAR RUSH near the 1000 metres, with BLANCO BELLE having to be restrained. Continued to over race in the run along the back straight.

SWEEPSTAKE (H Schofer) – Briefly held up entering the home straight.

MARS BARS (S Collett) – Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres

SUGAR RUSH (Z Moki) – Tightened near the 200 metres when LADY KARTEL shifted in when struck with the whip simultaneously as LONDON EXPRESS improved quickly to its inside.

LADY KARTEL (H Andrew) – Lay in when struck with the whip near the 200 metres.

Race 4 SEATON PARK 1400m

TONADILLAS (R Myers) – When questioned into performance rider had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary

inspection was clear

SECRET SQUIRREL (C Burdan) – Shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

H Andrew (RED FOREST) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 HAROLD TUSON MEMORIAL GREYS OPN HCP 1400m

RUN LIKE BOO (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly settling back.

LILLY THUNDER (R Smyth) – When questioned into performance rider could off no excuse.

Race 6 NZB AIRFREIGHT ROAD TO THE JERICHO 3210m

ALFIE DEE (R Hannam) – Slow away then raced keenly in the early and middle stages with the rider allowing the gelding to slide forward to lead near the 1600 metres.

AZABEAT (S Collett) – Lay out near the 2800 metres dictating ARITE GURU and MAGNANIMOUS MAN wider on the track.

ARITE GURU (R Smyth) – Dictated outwards 2800 metres then raced keenly for a distance.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (C Burdan) – Inconvenienced 2800 metres.

Race 7 ZED @ GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1800m

THE POORMANZABEEL (J Riddell) — Was removed from the barriers and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after charging the front of its gate.

BECKIDBOO (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout. K Asano advised that his intention was to improve his position to sit outside the leader in the early stages if possible, but was unable to cross to a one-off position due to the rider to his inside B Ansell (MADAM MAKFI) being in difficulty for some distance due to the slipped saddle and not being able to restrain her mount.

MADAM MAKFI (B Ansell) – Saddle slipped forward in the early stages of the race placing the rider at a significant disadvantage so was retired from the race approaching the 1000 metres and when being pulled up shifted out hampering DA JIN SHAN which was forced wide on the track.

DA JIN SHAN (S Collett) – Hampered and forced wide on the track losing ground in the back straight.

FLORAL ART (C Johnson) – Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Race 8 EPSOM & ASCOT WITH WHEELS & GEORGE 2000 m

SIR RITCHIE (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages shifting out near the 1500 metres inconveniencing EM KAY POPS.

EM KAY POPS (M Hudson) – Inconvenienced 1500 metres then raced wide without cover for the remainder.

KATIEM MARIE (K Asano) – Steadied near the 800 metres.

H Schofer (PENELOPE CRUISE) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after angling her mount out near the 800 metres when not the required distance clear of KATIEM MARIE which had to be steadied.
