GENERAL:

T Johnson did not attend today's meeting after he was unable to obtain a medical clearance.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

Waikato Racing Club – 25 September 2019 Race 7 – Fairview Motors 1600 **BLEW BY YOU** – Trainer N Bishara reported that BLEW BY YOU had undergone blood tests subsequent to racing which found the gelding to have an infection. N Bishara further reported that it is now his intention to carry on with the current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 KNOTTINGLY FARM STEEPLECHASE (3500 Metres)

BIG 'N' RICH (B Lammas) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres on the final occasion. Was pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found a minor cut to the top lip, abrasions and bruising to the near foreleg knee.

STARBRO (H McNeill) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

SHE SAID YES (S Phelan) – Knuckled after jumping the final fence.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (R Cole) – Inconvenienced shifting in after jumping the final fence to avoid heels.

Race 2 EPIC JOURNEYS HURDLE (3100 Metres)

LIZ'S GIFT (M Roustoby) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence. Ran down its fences throughout.

FREEWHEELER (G Walsh) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

COUNTRY BUMPKIN (B Thomas-Rantall) – Steadied off the heels of LIZ'S GIFT (M Roustoby) which shifted in when making the bend near the 850 metres on the first occasion. M Roustoby was advised to exercise care.

WAGNER (E Nicholas) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Ran down the third to last fence and shifted out inconveniencing JOCHEN RINDT.

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (B Lammas) – Contacted on landing after jumping the fence near the 1100 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

JOCHEN RINDT (S Phelan) – Lay out rounding the final bend shifting wider on the track. Inconvenienced after jumping the third to last fence.

EACH WAY (S Fannin) – Hit the second to last fence.

TYCOON ZED (R Cole) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

Race 3 WEE BISKIT HURDLE (3100 Metres)

WHOPPER'S (B Thomas-Rantall) – Slow away.

TE WAEWAE BAY (B Lammas) – Slow away. Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence. Shied approaching the fence near the 1300 metres running wide. Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. The connections were advised that the gelding would be required to complete a jumping trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing in a jumping race next. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

DONARDO (S Fannin) – Slow away. Hit the third to last fence.

BATTLE ROYAL (E Nicholas) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence. Misjudged the third fence. Hit the fence near the 1300 metres and knuckled on landing dislodging its rider who was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed bilateral epistaxis – with the endoscopic examination showing no blood in the trachea.

BLANCO BAY (S Phelan) – Hit the fence near the 1300 metres and knuckled on landing. Misjudged the second to last fence and fell dislodging its rider hampering ALI BABA. Rider S Phelan was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed bilateral mucosal lacerations inside the nostrils.

ALI BABA (R Cole) – Hampered after jumping the second to last fence.

BAK DA MASTER (M Roustoby) – Was inclined to run down its fences. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

B Thomas-Rantall (WHOPPER'S) – Issued with a warning for his whip use on a runner that had no reasonable prospect of improving or losing its position.

Race 4PAUL BIBBY MEMORIAL MARAMARUA HUNT HURDLE (3100 Metres)JUST GOT HOME (B Lammas) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres.

MAGIC CANNON (R Cole) – Misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres. Rider R Cole was questioned regarding his ride in the final straight, in particular why he had relaxed his ride after jumping the second to last fence prior to jumping the final fence. R Cole explained that MAGIC CANNON had been hanging and raced keenly during the running, and after jumping the second to last fence he had considered retiring MAGIC CANNON from the race. R Cole was reminded of his obligations that he must not ride his mounts in a manner that is left open to query.

HE'S DAN (E Nicholas) – Misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres.

TRISHA LEA (C Studd) – Misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres.

FLYINGWITHOUTWINGS (S Phelan) – Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.

Race 5 CAPISTRANO LODGE 2200

IZYMYDAAD (H McNeill) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

GINGEE (E Nicholas) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away.

ALFRED GEORGE (S Phelan) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away.

CANZAC (I Fraser-Hayes) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout. I Fraser-Hayes was spoken to regarding the extra ground that he allowed the gelding to cover during the early and middle stages. I Fraser-Hayes explained that it was his intention not to allow CANZAC to get boxed in by other runners as the gelding had a tendency to over-race so elected to improve forward wider on the track. I Fraser-Hayes was advised by Stewards that he would be expected to show better judgement in the future and not allow his mounts to cover unnecessary ground.

S Phelan (ALFRED GEORGE) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 MIKE FRASER-JONES 2200

BARBARA (D Parker) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

ASCOMANNI (M Northcott) – Began awkwardly.

CARNABY (S Fannin) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PIGGY MALONE (O Helagi) – Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

Race 7 BAYLEYS WAIKATO HUNT CUP (4200 Metres)

PYTHAGORAS (R Cole) – Slow away.

HENRY TUDOR (S Phelan) – Slow away.

KINGS KITE (B Thomas-Rantall) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 600 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

NAPOLEON (E Nicholas) – Knuckled after jumping the second to last fence dislodging its rider. Rider E Nicholas was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a wound on lateral proximal left hind cannon.

DOCTOR HOOK (H McNeill) – Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres on the first occasion. Disqualified from 3rd placing after rider weight in 0.7kg under the handicapped weight.

OLD COUNTESS (M Roustoby) – Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 600 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

RAISAFUASHO (S Fannin) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt lame on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed slight bruising on both foreleg knees.

EION (B Lammas) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt lame on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a right fore flexor tendon injury. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Following the running of this race the Stewards filed a request for a ruling under Rule 648(3) when H McNeill the rider of DOCTOR HOOK was unable to draw the proper weight when weighing in. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee disqualified DOCTOR HOOK from third placing with the new placings being 10, 5, 1, 7, 9.

H McNeill (DOCTOR HOOK) – Admitted a charge under Rule 649(3) in that he weighed in 0.7 kg under the handicapped weight for DOCTOR HOOK. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$1200.

Race 8 MAKE-A-WISH NEW ZEALAND 1600

PIERIAN SPRING (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

HOYT AXTON (C Dell) – Slow to begin.

HUMBLE PIE (H McNeill) – Slow to begin. Shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

E Nicholas (HORSEY HORSE HORSE) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

H McNeill (HUMBLE PIE) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 GEOFF BRINDLEY MEMORIAL 1600

SIR ZACK (L Petersen) – Slow to begin.

THE FOT (F Lazet) – Slow to begin.

ZION HILL (C Isdale) – Slow to begin.

EAGLE FIFTY (S Fannin) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PARISIAN (B Rogerson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

INVIGORATE (M Northcott) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

IMA WONDER (O Helagi) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

DIOGENES (D Parker) – Raced in restricted room to the outside of ABU DHABI which shifted out for a distance approaching the 100 metres.

SHAHANA (S Wenn) – Inconvenienced over the concluding stages by DIOGENES which shifted out when struck with the whip.

B Harrison (MEANT TO BE) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres when riding MEANT TO BE with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$650.
