RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PALAMOUNTAIN DAIRY AD&E NUTRITION (1650 Metres)
FRIDAY – Apprentice jockey H Schofer was unable to make the carded weight for FRIDAY and due to the lack of a suitable replacement, trainer J Lupton was given permission to engage senior M Singh.	
H Schofer (FRIDAY) – Admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) in that she failed to make the carded weight for FRIDAY and was fined \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.	

CAPITAL GAINS (R Myers) – Clipped a heel and blundered shortly after the start.

FIFTYSHADESDARKER (R Goldsbury) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages with a tendency to get its head in the air. Held up rounding the final turn.

TUPAU (D Bradley) - Raced keenly for a distance in the middle stages.

Shortly after entering the home straight **FRIDAY** (M Singh) shifted in and away from **CAPITAL GAINS** (R Myers) and as a result tightened **PASSWORD** (R Elliot), **TUPAU** (D Bradley) and **EKSTREMEMISS** (S McKay), which had to be restrained. After questioning riders M Singh was advised to exercise greater care.

FRIDAY (M Singh) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of **TUPAU** near the 1000 metres, having to be steadied, then raced three wide without cover for the remainder.

LARRY'S LATE (L Hemi) – Held up rounding the final turn having to be angled across heels early in the home straight to gain clear running.

PASSWORD (R Elliot) – Tightened 300 metres.

TUPAU (D Bradley) – Tightened 300 metres.

EKSTREMEMISS (S McKay) – Restrained 300 metres.

HOGAN'S HERO (C O'Beirne) - Shifted in under hard riding near the 200 metres, bumping **CAPITAL GAINS**. C O'Beirne was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion and was issued with a warning under Rule 368(1)(d).

CAPITAL GAINS (R Myers) – Bumped 200 metres.

J Waddell (BRUNO KELLY) – Defended a charge under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not clear of **CAPITAL GAINS** (R Myers), which clipped the heels of **BRUNO KELLY** and blundered. Also hampered was **HOGAN'S HERO**. After deliberations the JCA found the charge proved and J Waddell had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 6 October up to and including racing on Friday, 18 October (8 days).

Race 2	SANDFORDS (1400 Metres)

G Hacche (POST GRADUATE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 534(1) in that he failed to scratch **POST GRADUATE** by the required time and was fined \$150.

The meeting was put back one race while a starting gate member was attended to by St John paramedics and transferred to hospital for observation after falling ill.

DARCINSKY PRINCE (M Singh) - Bounded at the start losing ground (4L).

BOSTON STRONG BOY (C Johnson) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages making the bend near the 1300 metres awkwardly.

CAROL'S CHEVAL (S McKay) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 400 metres finishing a distance behind the field. When questioned, rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

SMOOTH COGNAC (H Andrew) - Held up for a short distance approaching the 500 metres.

Race 3 | **WAVERLEY MOTORS (1200 Metres)**

YES I'M ROYAL (S McKay) - Began awkwardly settling back. When questioned into performance, rider advised the filly had raced greenly throughout.

VANCOOGA (C Johnson) – Slow away. Ran up on to heels near the 200 metres, having to be angled outwards to gain clear running.

Race 4 | **FOREST360/CHINA NATIONAL (1200 Metres)**

DEE KEEPA (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when three wide without cover.

SEMPER MAGICO (T Johnson) - Began awkwardly settling back.

ASTOUNDING (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

CAPELYN (S McKay) - Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

CLASSYAS (H Andrew) - Gave ground quickly approaching the 400 metres and was not persevered in the home straight when well out of contention. When questioned rider advised the mare may not have appreciated today's track conditions.

Race 5 | **MITAVITE (1200 Metres)**

NUBIAN SMILE (R Myers) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 | **LIQUORLAND (2200 Metres)**

KEEPIN HARMONEE (D Hirini) – Had to be restrained when over-racing near the 1700 metres and then continued to race keenly in the middle stages.

CLASSCLOWN (J Parkes) – Came together and bumped DEUCE COUPE near the 50 metres when both runners shifted ground.

DEUCE COUPE (R Myers) – Bumped 50 metres.

HANDYMAN (D Bradley) – When questioned in the run of HANDYMAN, rider reported that the gelding switched off after being in restricted room and had no excuse.

PERSWAYED (R Hannam) - Trainer B Lammas reported that **PERSWAYED**, which finished some distance last, would not be persevered with.

Race 7 | **GLORY DAYS/STANLEY PARK (2200 Metres)**

SCIMITAR (R Goldsbury) – Slow away.

MATARO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly settling back.

MASTER BLACK JACK (H Schofer) – Got its head in the air when being restrained near the 1500 metres making the bend awkwardly, bumping the hind quarters of TEAPOT which contacted MISS GIDGET briefly unbalancing that runner. TEAPOT then shifted in abruptly tightening MASTER BLACK JACK. Hung inwards in the home straight and had to be continuously straightened over the final stages.

TEAPOT (C O'Beirne) – Contacted 1500 metres, shifting in abruptly.

MISS GIDGET (J Fawcett) - Contacted and briefly unbalanced.

GREAT NORTH ROAD (C Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.
