Race 5 - EL CHEAPO CARS 1400 (1400 Metres)

SHOWSHANELLE (H Andrew) – Trainer M Eales advised Stewards that the mare underwent blood tests in the days following this race which revealed an elevated white blood cell count. Mr Eales further advised that SHOWSHANELLE has received treatment for this and it is his intention to freshen the mare prior to racing next.

Auckland Racing Club - 28 September 2019

Race 5 - Otakiri Reserve 1200

MOLTO VELOCE (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 BUPA FOXBRIDGE VILLAGE NOW SELLING 2100

DESERT STORM (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

ZENNTARI (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

UABASSO (R Smyth) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

TED WILLDOIT (C Burdan) - Contacted on jumping away becoming briefly unbalanced.

HUNUA HANK (S Spratt) - Crowded and checked 1800 metres.

V Colgan (SINGLE MOMENT) – Issued with a warning after permitting SINGLE MOMENT to shift in near the 1800 metres when insufficiently clear of HUNUA HANK which was checked. Contributing was outward movement from ALMO COSTA (J Riddell) which simultaneously shifted out to avoid the heels of TIPPING POINT (T Harris) which steadied. Rider T Harris was reminded of his obligation in that he must not steady the pace to a degree that places riders in difficulty behind him.

SINGLE MOMENT (V Colgan) - Crowded passing the 400 metres and then raced in restricted room and steadied.

T Harris (TIPPING POINT) - Issued with a warning after permitting TIPPING POINT to shift out passing the 400 metres crowding SINGLE MOMENT which raced in restricted or a distance then steadied.

PEARLESCENCE (M Cameron) - Held up until shifting out to obtain clear running approaching the 250 metres.

HERMANITO (C Grylls) – Went amiss passing the 1300 metres and was eased down by its rider. After being attended to by the veterinary, HERMANITO was humanely euthanased after being found to have fractured the left front humorous.

Race 2 US NAVY FLAG @ VALACHI DOWNS 1600

PELOTON (J Waddell) - Slow away. Crowded 150 metres then steadied.

EMPRESS TZU HSI (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DELUXE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TROUBLE (T Yanagida) - Steadied passing the 1300 metres when improving to the inside of SYMBIO (J Riddell) which shifted in. J Riddell was advised to exercise greater care when in a similar circumstance.

JUSTA BOY BULLSEYE (E McCall) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced when weakening 375 metres.

C Burdan (TRANSFORMER) - Issued with a warning after permitting TRANSFORMER to shift out passing the 150 metres crowding PELOTON which was steadied. Contributing was slight inward movement from NOMOATHAJ.

IN THE ZONE (V Colgan) - Trainer G Brick undertook to advise Stewards of any findings of a veterinary examination on return to the stables.

HOYT AXTON (J Fawcett) – Tailed off in the final straight. Issued with a warning after being uncompetitive.

Race 3 NZB READY TO RUN NOV 20 – 21 1200

QUIZ KID (J Waddell) - Began awkwardly shifting out and contacting CHIARETTA which become unbalance losing ground. Raced ungenerously passing the 900 metres when being steadied.

CHIARETTA (D Johnson) - Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

TAPPY'S ONE (T Thornton) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. Raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres when being steadied.

FAMILIA (L Innes) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied.

GREYVEE (J Fawcett) – Over-raced in the early stages.

RAINBOW DASH (S Spratt) – Rider S Spratt advised that she had been concerned after RAINBOW DASH had hung out over the concluding stages and had felt indifferent. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer J Mahoney advised the filly would undergo blood tests on return to the stable.

Race 4 MELBOURNE CUP @ TE RAPA 1200

MAGIC RULER (T Yanagida) – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice after dislodged its rider during the preliminary and galloping a distance. Apprentice Rider T Yanagida was uninjured. Received veterinary treatment for a small laceration to the right knee.

BOTHERED (S Weatherley) - Crowded and hampered 1100 metres. When questioned regarding performance Rider S Weatherley could offer no tangible excuse.

D Mansour (IT'S DOABLE) - Issued with a warning for permitting IT'S DOABLE to shift in approaching the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of BOTHERED which was placed in restricted room and hampered losing ground with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of IT'S DOABLE which was hanging at the time.

TUMBLEWEED (C Burdan) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

STRAIGHT SETS (R Elliot) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until the 200 metres.

GORGEOUS GEISHA (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding performance rider S Spratt advised that the mare would prefer a more rain affected footing.

DANCE CARD (L Innes) - When questioned regarding performance Rider L Innes advised the mare would be better suited to more ground.

Race 5 WEBSITE ANGELS 1400

T & M Carter (GUILLOCHARM) - Issued with a warning after presenting the gelding to race without gear that had been notified (side winkers).

AILEEN GRACE (C O'Beirne) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Inconvenienced 300 metres when briefly steadied away from the heels of CHURCH ROAD which shifted out to obtain clear running.

CHURCH ROAD (D Mansour) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground. Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres.

HOLY LOCH (V Colgan) - Contacted leaving the barrier with the Rider becoming briefly unbalanced. Restrained off heels approaching the 900 metres.

MILITARY STEP (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages. Hampered 250 meters when improving on to heels.

WILLIAM TELL (T Yanagida) - Restrained from a wide barrier.

SCOTTISH STAR (O Bosson) – Hampered 250 metres when contacted on its hind quarters by MILITARY STEP (J Kamaruddin) which shifted out under pressure. J Kamaruddin was spoken to in the presence of Riding Master N Harris and advised that he must exercise greater care. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 6 HAMILTON WANDERERS FOOTBALL 1400

TIPTRONIC (M Coleman) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground.

SAINT EMILION (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly.

DOUGIE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ORAKEI OVERLORD (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

STRATOCASTER (C O'Beirne) – Raced ungenerously being steadied in the early stages.

CONTESSA VANESSA (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

VON TUNZELMAN (L Innes) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until the final 100 metres.

Race 7 VE VETERINARY SERVICES TE AWAMUTU CUP (1600 metres)

MIGHTY CONNOR (D Johnson) - Slow away.

FRANCIS DRAKE (J Kam) - Crowded and steadied shortly after the start losing ground.

ESTEFANIA (J Bassett) – Over-raced in the early stages.

WHENHARRYMETSADDLE (O Bosson) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Crowded approaching the 100 metres and steadied. When questioned regarding performance rider O Bosson could offer no tangible excuse other than been caught wide throughout.

D Danis (FARM BOY) - Issued with a warning after allowing FARM BOY to shift out near the 150 when not sufficiently clear of WHENHARRYMETSADDLE which was hampered.

J Kam (FRANCIS DRAKE) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use on a horse out of contention.

SUNNY ROSE (S Collett) – A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities after Rider S Collet advised the mare had felt indifferent.

Race 8 LODGE CHRISTMAS RACEDAY – DEC 21 1200

RAPOSA RAPIDA (C Burdan) – Slow away.

WILD SEAS (C Grylls) - Steadied for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

MONACO (V Colgan) - Commenced to race ungenerously near the 900 metres then becoming awkwardly placed and shifting out and making contact with SECRET SQUIRREL which became unbalanced.

SECRET SQUIRREL (H Schofer) - Contacted becoming unbalanced 900 metres.

WEAPONRY (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final turn before shifting out passing the 400 to obtain clear running.

IMBLAZE (C O'Beirne) – Crowded 400 metres and checked.

J Kamaruddin (WEAPONRY) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted WEAPONRY to shift out passing the 400 metres when insufficiently clear of IMBLAZE which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, 4 October up to an including racing on Sunday, 13 October, 5 national riding days.

OTTAVIO (J Kam) – Ran wide entering the final straight. Apprentice J Kam was spoken to in the presence of the National Riding mentor N Harris and was advised that he would be expected to show better judgement and not allow his mounts to cover unnecessary ground.

SCARFI (S Collet) – Crowded over the final 50 metres and steadied.

J Fawcett (MONEY TRAIL) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted MONEY TRAIL to shift out over the final 50 metres when insufficiently clear of SCARFI which was crowded and steadied. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday, 11 October up to an including racing on Friday, 18 October, 5 national riding days.
