GENERAL:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR (2200 METRES)
CASINO EL JAY (L Allpress) - Slow away, held up entering the home straight continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.	
ZAC BROWN (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly, Raced in restricted room in the home straight.	

TO LOVE YOU (C Johnson) - Made the first turn awkwardly after being placed in restricted room to the inside of WHATSUP. H Andrew was advised to exercise more care. Held up entering the home straight before being angled outwards across heels, then continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the 100 metres.

SHEZ EKSTRA (L Innes) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After a veterinary inspection was confirmed to have bled and is now subject to the mandatory stand down periods.

J PARKES (SOLESEIFEI) - Fined \$500 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

T THORNTON (SWEET TREAT) - Admitted a charge in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres being suspended by the Judicial Committee from the close of racing on Saturday 12th October up to and including racing on Wednesday 23rd October (7 national riding days).

Race 2	MARDIGRAS EVENTS 1200 (1200 METRES)

SATU LAGI (D Hirini) - Slow away.

MR UNIVERSE (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly, had a tendency to lay in under pressure in the home straight.

C O'BEIRNE (RESURRECT) - Defended a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount RESURRECT to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SANTA CATARINA which was forced inwards crowding JAKKALBOMB onto VINNIE'S VOLLEY passing the 1100 metres. After viewing films and hearing evidence the Judicial Committee found the charge to be proven suspending Miss O'Beirne's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Saturday 12th October up to and including Wednesday 23rd October (7 national riding days).

JAKKALBOMB (M Coleman) - Crowded and checked passing the 1100 metres.

VINNIE'S VOLLEY (C Johnson) - Crowded and unbalanced when contacted near the 1100 metres, over-raced in the middle stages shifting outwards to avoid the heels of POP STAR PRINCESS near the 900 metres hampering ST CATARINA.

SANTA CATARINA (D Johnson) - Hampered when forced inwards passing 1100 metres, hampered near the 900 metres, went off stride when struck over the head by the whip of S McKay (CAVALLO VELOCE) passing the 150 metres then was not persevered for the remainder of the race. S McKay was advised to exercise care. When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the mare had felt a beaten runner early in the home straight and after going off stride near the 150 metres had felt something may have been amiss not being aware that the mare had been struck over the head. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3	TUMU ITM 1200 (1200 METRES)

HEART OF STONE (C Johnson) - Proved reluctant to load, jumped away awkwardly contacting TIMES TICKING, commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres continuing to do so through the middle stages when wide without cover before improving to the lead near the 500 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had commenced to race erratically shortly after the start and after working hard through the middle stages had been a beaten runner shortly after entering the final straight. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

TIMES TICKING (J Riddell) - Bumped at the start, raced ungenerously when being restrained making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly hampering VICKEZZMOET, hampered having to avoid the heels of RAINBOW DUNDEE near the 250 metres.

VICKEZZMOET (C Grylls) - Hampered passing the 900 metres.

MASQUE (T Thornton) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 900 metres.

TALENTI (C Burdan) - Slow away, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight before being angled inwards near the 75 metres to gain clear running over the final stages.

NO FINER PINS (M Coleman) - Held up behind the weakening HEART OF STONE passing the 200 metres.

MEHRTENS (T Harris) - Held up near the 300 metres having to shift inwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

C O'BEIRNE (RAINBOW DUNDEE) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she angled her mount RAINBOW DUNDEE outwards when not sufficiently clear of TIMES TICKING which was hampered near the 250 metres having to avoid that runner's heels. After viewing films and hearing evidence the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of Miss O'Beirne's licence to ride in races from the close of racing on Wednesday 23rd October up to and including Saturday 2nd November (8 national riding days).

Race 4	HASTINGS-HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY 1400 (1400 METRES)

PENNY ROYAL (V Colgan) - Was declared a late scratching at 2.03pm on veterinary advice after rearing over backwards and striking its head in the parade ring.

HE CAN SING (C Grylls) - Slow away, hung outwards under pressure in the home straight.

OVERSTAYER (C Johnson) - Slow away, held up entering the final straight and did not obtain clearing running until near the 200 metres.

COLORADO STAR (L Hemi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

CHOSEN PEAK (L Allpress) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight when inclined to race greenly, then having to be steadied when disappointed for a run passing the 75 metres.

Race 5	SACRED FALLS HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS (1400 METRES)

SHERWOOD FOREST (L Innes) - Was removed from the barriers to undergo a pre-race veterinary inspection after becoming fractious being cleared to start, lay in making contact with AOTEA LAD and becoming unbalanced near the 75 metres when that runner was taken out slightly by RIVA CAPRI.

RED HUSSAR (T Thornton) - Awkwardly away settling back, had to be steadied near the 700 metres, held up passing the 300 metres, again having to be steadied when improving onto heels near the 150 metres.

RIVA CAPRI (D Mansour) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

BLUE RATA ELIGUS (R Myers) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EXUBERANT (D Johnson) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly when placed in restricted room to the inside of CATALYST. T Harris was advised to exercise more care.

CHECKERS (M Cameron) Had to be firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of EXUBERANT near the 700 metres going back onto RED HUSSAR.

SERENA (C Johnson) - Held up over the final 100 metres.

AOTEA LAD (O Bosson) - Contacted near the 75 metres.

Race 6 | **STELLA ARTOIS MILE (1600 METRES)**

ZAMAX (O Bosson) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages, required post race veterinary attention after collapsing on the way back to the tie up stalls suffering from an elevated heart rate possibly due to heat stress.

LINCOLN STAR (R Hannam) - Inconvenienced approaching the 250 metres when ZAMAX lay in, prior to the authorisation of dividend connections viewed footage before electing to not proceed with a protest.

GERMANICUS (T Harris) - Raced greenly being inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

ROCK WITH CHOUX (M Singh) - Lay in under pressure early in the home straight having to be corrected.

TUIGIRL (R Myers) - Held up passing the 300 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 100 metres.

MOTIVATION (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the gelding had been disappointing. A postrace veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer J Bary advised that the gelding was now likely to be spelled.

Race 7 | **DAN D'ESPOSITO MEMORIAL (1400 METRES)**

DANGER DEE (D Johnson) - Slow away.

BRUNO STARS (C O'Beirne) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

HARLEM 'N' GO (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover.

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (M Singh) - Restrained to avoid heels rounding the turn near the 500 metres, then being held up until near the 200 metres.

SAIGNON (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

Race 8 | **LIVAMOL CLASSIS (2040 METRES)**

SENTIMENTAL MISS (L Allpress) - Tightened at the start and settled back, when questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the mare may be better suited to more rain affected conditions. Trainer L Latta advised that the mare was now likely to be freshened.

JACKSSTAR (C Johnson) - Slow away.

MELODY BELLE (O Bosson) - Shifted outwards across the heels of MONGOLIAN MARSHAL when that runner was being steadied near the 1500 metres making contact with DOLCETTO with those two runners then continuing to come together for a distance. O Bosson was advised to exercise care when riding in similar circumstances.

DOLCETTO (J Waddell) - Contacted near the 1500 metres then continued to jostle with MELODY BELLE for a distance.

FISCAL FANTASY (L Innes) - Raced three wide without cover, inconvenienced passing the 600 metres.

MORE WONDER (T Thornton) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 600 metres inconveniencing FISCAL FANTASY.

Race 9 | **RED BADGE SPRING SPRINT (1400 METRES)**

HUNTA PENCE (D Hirini) - Jumped away awkwardly.

STRADIVARIUS (M Singh) - Jumped away awkwardly, had to be firmly restrained when improving onto the heels of DAWN PATROL near the 900 metres.

HENI (R Myers) - Slow away, raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 200 metres.

DEERFIELD (R Hannam) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages being caught three wide without cover.

DAWN PATROL (M Cameron) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres.

S MCKAY (THE MITIGATOR) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.

Race 10

BOSTOCK NEW ZALAND SPRING CARNIVAL FAREWELL (1600 METRES)

ARTISTE (C Burdan) - Jumped away awkwardly.

TOMS (L Allpress) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

STARRYBEEL (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding would now be better suited over more ground and with the addition of blinkers.

FELAAR (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding his ride, in particular his lack of vigour between the 300 and 100 metres, O Bosson advised that the gelding had travelled only moderately and had been running on fairly only early in the straight but had also felt to be doing his best work, adding that he had been conscious that the runner to his inside, RICHIE MCHORSE, had been shifting outwards. The explanation of O Bosson was noted and he was advised that he would be expected to ride his mounts in a manner which is not left open to query in future.
