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### RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	KIWIKONTRACTORS (1300 Metres)
<b>PARKVIEW</b> (D Johnson) – Slow away.	
<b>CAPTIVE</b> (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced leaving the barriers. Lay out rounding the final turn running wide. Lost the right front plate during the running.	
<b>FALTONIUS</b> (T Harris) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.	

<b>DAWNTING</b> (M Cameron) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.	
<b>MOTLEY CRUE</b> (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover.	
<b>D Johnson</b> (PARKVIEW) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ASCOT FARM (1300 Metres)</b>
<b>EASYRIDER</b> (R Elliot) – Knuckled leaving the barriers.	
<b>LAUREATE</b> (O Bosson) – Raced three wide without cover and was inclined to lay outwards throughout making the final turn awkwardly and running wide.	
<b>CINZENTO</b> (D Mansour) – Forced over extra ground by LAUREATE rounding the final turn.	
<b>WHISPERING WIND</b> (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance rider M Coleman could offer no excuse.	
<b>L Innes</b> (WILD WEST) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
<b>POKURU GRACE</b> (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which reveal an elevated heart rate, a high temperature and a weak gait. Trainer M Brooks was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the filly racing next.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1300 Metres)</b>
<b>RIP EM UP</b> (D Johnson) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied. Held up rounding the final bend, then had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.	
<b>RECENSION</b> (D Mansour) – Raced keen in the early and middle stages.	
<b>SOFT HEARTED</b> (V Colgan) – Raced keen in the early and middle stages.	
<b>SIMONA</b> (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>T Harris</b> (LET ME TELL YA) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	
<b>AALAALUNE</b> (T Thornton) – The connections advised that they were intending to apply visor blinkers to the filly for its next start.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>PITCH SPORTS BAR &amp; LUCKY LIZARD (1200 Metres)</b>
<b>WAR PATH</b> (V Colgan) – Slow away. Forced wider entering the final straight. Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres by THUNDER (C Burdan) which shifted outwards. C Burdan was advised to exercise care.	
<b>HUGH GLASS</b> (L Innes) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.	
<b>ROCKLEY BEACH</b> (A Goindasamy) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.	
<b>TRADITION</b> (M Coleman) – Over-raced when being restrained passing the 1000 metres, continuing to do so in the middle stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly making contact with ROCKLEY BEACH.	
<b>THUNDER</b> (C Burdan) – Lay out entering the final straight forcing WAR PATH over extra ground.	

<b>MONTANA MIST</b> (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>STARLIGHT CINEMA CENTRE (1200 Metres)</b>
<p><b>ENSEMBLE</b> (R Elliot) – Slow away (3L).</p> <p><b>THE FUGITIVE</b> (S Spratt) – Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages making the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MISS VALENCIA</b> (T Harris) – Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>MAKABAR</b> (S Johnson) – Made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly and shifted out contacting the hind quarters of CHARLIE ZULU which became unbalanced.</p> <p><b>CHARLIE ZULU</b> (S Collett) – Contacted making the bend passing the 800 metres becoming unbalanced. Raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>PONT ALMA</b> (V Colgan) – Steadied to avoid heels over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>L Satherley</b> (LADY LIRA) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>GENERATION HOMES TAUPO (1100 Metres)</b>
<p><b>DOUBLE EXPRESSO</b> (D Mansour) – After becoming fractious was removed from the barriers to undergo a veterinary inspection being passed fit to race. Hampered leaving the barriers when BURGUNDY ROSE jumped outwards.</p> <p><b>KIRRA LAD</b> (S Weatherley) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>PATCH PRINCE</b> (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the 900 metres, continuing to over-race through the middle stages. Held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running in the final straight going to the line untested.</p> <p><b>SHADOW RUNNER</b> (L Innes) – Momentarily went off stride passing the 250 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider L Innes advised that after going off stride early in the final straight the gelding had failed to respond to his urging for the remainder of the straight. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>P McKay</b> – Defended a charge under Rule 340 in that he misconducted himself by striking WITHOUT FLAW with the lead rope when the filly was reluctant to commence its preliminary. After hearing submissions and viewing video footage of the incident the charge was upheld with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$1,000.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>PLACEMAKERS TAUPO (1100 Metres)</b>
<p><b>CARILLION</b> (S Weatherley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after contacting the running rail in its preliminary and was passed fit to race. Jumped away awkwardly. Inconvenienced near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>WALKIN' BY</b> (A Goindasamy) – Jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced when being restrained going into the bend passing the 800 metres having to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed near heels.</p> <p><b>BLOOD WARRIOR</b> (V Colgan) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>OTTAVIO</b> (R Beemud) – Ran wide entering the final straight, then shifted out further inconveniencing CARILLION near the 250 metres. Apprentice Beemud was advised to exercise greater care.</p>	

**K Chowdhoo**ry (SAN SIRO) – Issued with a warning after failing to claim down to his declared riding weight.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>HIGGINS TAUP</b> O (1800 Metres)
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**BORDER LEICESTER** (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**FIERY DRAGON** (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**MAN POWER** (V Colgan) – Lay out throughout the running. Hampered when weakening near the 250 metres when VERBIER shifted out when not sufficiently clear.

**CAPTAIN REG** (T Thornton) – Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

**S Weatherley** (VERBIER) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of MAN POWER which was hampered near the 250 metres.

**C Burdan** (VALHEXA) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
