## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME MAIDEN SPRINT 1200m</b>
<b>LET'S GO BERNIE</b> (T Moseley) – Proved very difficult to load with the connections advised that the gelding would be placed	

on a barrier manners warning. Made the first bend awkwardly and when being restrained hampered the trailing LOUIE LOUIE which also had to be restrained.

**BOGATYR** (J Lowry) – Crowded and steadied on jumping away losing ground.

**DECEPTIO VISUS** (J Laking) – Slow to begin, raced wide in the early stages.

**KANDHU** (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**I’VE GOTTAGO** (R Mudhoo) – Over raced in the early stages and made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, and over reacted when briefly crowded for room by BOGATYR (J Lowry) shifting out wider on the track crowding KANDHU which had to steady at that point. J Lowry was advised to exercise care. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**HIGHLY CHARGED** (S Collett) – Got its head up when racing keenly into the first bend and had to be steadied away from the heels of RESUSCITATE, obliged to improve wide rounding the final bend.

**RESUSCITATE** (S Wynne) – Raced greenly into the first bend and lay outwards and then shifted inwards abruptly shortly after when continuing to race greenly.

**ROSSO CAVALLA** (J Fawcett) – Held up rounding the final bend and for the majority of the run home going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

**LOUIE LOUIE** (C Johnson) – Briefly held up passing the 200 metres and when shifting out to find clear racing room bumped with VAN HALEN.

**VAN HALEN** (C Barnes) – Bumped near the 200 metres.

**J Lowry** (BOGATYR) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MORE FM MAIDEN 1200m</b>

**BUNGAY** was a late scratching at 12.25 pm on veterinary advice after dislodging its rider during the preliminary and galloping for some distance. The start was delayed 5 minutes as a result.

**METEORA** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**ITSONLYMONEY** (S Shinde) – Began awkwardly losing ground, raced wide without cover throughout.

**SAVVY LAD** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

**ARTIC WARRIOR** (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout and was reported by its rider to have raced greenly throughout.

**TOO FERLAXED** (S Collett) – Held up early in the run home.

**CAN’T SAY ENOUGH** (C Johnson) – Held up early in the run home shifting in near the 250 metres.

**KRISTOFFERSON** (K Asano) – Held up for the majority of the run home and went to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

St John Paramedics attended to K Kwo (METEORA) and S Weatherley (SAVVY LAD) who were dislodged on return to the birdcage, with both riders cleared to continue with their riding engagements.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN DASH 1200m</b>

**BRIGHT FLASH** (K Chowdhoo) – Stumbled on jumping away making firm contact with RUSSIAN FABLE and becoming unbalanced losing ground, held up rounding the bend into the final straight.

**SOMBRA DEAMOR** (T Comignaghi) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

**SAKURA BELLE** (K Williams ) – Raced greenly in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly and was

unable to be fully ridden out in the final straight being inclined to lay inwards under pressure.

**BUCK SHELLFISH** (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had had a nice run in the mid field but when placed under pressure had only battled and had been disappointing.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MICHAEL DALY RACING STABLES SPRINT 1200m</b>

**DEVIOUS** (B Murray) – Slow to begin, lay outwards passing the 600 metres for a distance.

**PREDICTION** (T Moseley) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

**LIAM** (S Weatherley) – Bumped and unbalanced at the start losing some ground.

**FROSTED** (K Kwo) – Raced wide throughout.

**RED CHOIS** (S Collett) – Hung outwards rounding the final bend.

**STELLA DAZE** (R Mudhoo) – Steadied off heels passing the 500 metres when racing keenly, crowded and had to be steadied passing the 200 metres.

**T Comignaghi** (CAMPO) – was issued with a warning when allowing her mount to shift outwards passing the 200 metres crowding STELLA DAZE which had to steady and shift ground.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>HARDGRAVE &amp; ALL ASPECTS DECORATING HANDICAP 1200m</b>

**SABER** (K Chowdhoo) – Stumbled on jumping away.

**GRAND RIO** (J Fawcett) – Crowded and steadied at the start losing ground.

**CLARA** (C Johnson) – Began awkwardly, raced wide without cover through the early stages.

**ZABAY** (C Campbell) – Held up in the early stages of the straight having to shift out to obtain clear running.

**AMBITIOUS WINNER** (B Murray) – Rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary inspection revealed mild lameness in the off foreleg, with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MURRAY GROUNDWATER @ LJ HOOKER GROUP TIMARU 1200 1200m</b>

**FINE BOUQUET** (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**MEDITERRANEAN STAR** (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.

**DEVINE LOVE** (S Collett) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground, raced greenly in the run home and shifted in and away from outside runners passing the 100 metres.

**TITANIUM JACK** (D Prastiyou) – Slow to begin.

**MEARA MARY** (S Weatherley) – Clipped a heel and blundered losing momentum passing the 950 metres.

**S Wynne** (MEDITERRANEAN STAR) admitted a breach of the careless riding rule in that she allowed her mount to shift in passing the 950 metres crowding and checking MEARA MARY which clipped a heel and lost momentum. After hearing evidence and viewing replays the Judicial Committee suspended S Wynne's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 13 October up to and including 24 October.

**EXPRESS RIP** (K Kwo) – Lay inwards when making the first bend and raced wide for the majority of the race. Rider reported that the gelding had hung throughout.

**EL GLADIADOR** (C Johnson) – Made the bend by the 900 metres awkwardly and had to be steadied resulting in the trailing ADMIRAL ROUS also having to be steadied at that point.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>NIGHT 'N DAY PARK STORE MILE 1600m</b>

**QUEEN JETSUN** (K Williams) – Slow to begin.

**SITARIST** (T Comignaghi) – Steadied shortly after the start when placed in restricted room.

**TICKET TO RIDE** (K Asano) – Over raced in the early stages when disputing the pace.

**B Murray** (ZENTESSA) was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>GERALDINE VILLAGE INN SPORTS BAR 1600 1600m</b>

Trainer **S Autridge** (BLUE VALLEY) was issued with a warning for presenting this runner without notified gear (blinkers).

**BRIDGET TOWN** (J Fawcett) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

**POP 'N' ROCK** (K Williams) – Began awkwardly losing ground as a result.

**THE GROWLER** (J Laking) – Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

**CHIEF SEQUOYAH** (D Johnson) – Raced wide for the majority of the race and when spoken to regarding the performance the rider advised she had been trapped wide throughout and had only battled over the concluding stages.

**J Fawcett** (BRIDGET TOWN) was spoken to advisedly regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>COPPER CAFÉ &amp; BAR MAIDEN 1600m</b>

**BROTHER WILL** (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin, allowed to stride forward mid race to lead.

**DIVINEXCUSE** (K Chowdhoo) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start losing ground, made the first bend awkwardly shifting outwards and having to be steadied away from heels, attempted to improve wide from the 800 metres and lay out on the final bend shifting wider on the track.

**MAH GIRL** (S Wynne) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start having to steady losing ground.

**STRATTON** (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early stages.

**RUMOUR HAS IT** (K Williams) – Held up for a distance passing the 125 metres and had to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>ESTHER DALY MEMORIAL 2200m</b>

**FABULOUS FLIGHT** (D Johnson) – When spoken to regarding performance, the rider reported that the gelding had been less than genuine in its efforts today. Stable representative P Richards advised it was their intention to return the gelding to the home stable.

<b>Race 11</b>	<b>NEXT MEETING SATURDAY, 28 DECEMBER 2019 MAIDEN 2200m</b>

**STAR WATERS PRINCESS** – **C Barnes** replaced J Laking who was unable to make the contracted weight. **J Laking** was fined \$100 by the Judicial Committee in accordance with the Minor Infringement Schedule.

**WHISPER ROCK** (R Mudhoo) – Was fractious in its barrier. Began awkwardly losing ground, raced greenly throughout the run home.

**VERSES** (K Asano) – Began awkwardly shifting in crowding HERMONTY.

**HERMONTY** (C Campbell) – Crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

**OUR ROYAL** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.

**STAR WARS PRINCESS** (C Barnes) - Raced greenly through the early stages.

**FIGEAMEOUT** (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages and had to be restrained off heels racing into the first bend. Lay out under pressure passing the 100 metres.

**BRUCE BANNER** (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**VERSES** (K Asano) – Crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres when FIGEAMEOUT (T Moseley) shifted out marginally at this point. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Following the running of this event **K Asano**, the rider of 2<sup>nd</sup> placed VERSES, lodged a protest against 1<sup>st</sup> placed FIGEAMEOUT alleging interference over the concluding stages. After hearing evidence and viewing replays the Judicial Committee upheld the protest with the placings now reading VERSES (1<sup>st</sup>), FIGEAMEOUT (2<sup>nd</sup>), FIVE PRINCES (3<sup>rd</sup>), BAHHGGOOFY (4<sup>th</sup>).
