 FARMER DIPPING & O'MEARA CRUTCHING (1200m)

 HURRICANE AUBERT (K Chowdhoory) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being fractious in its barrier and was cleared to start. Raced wide without cover throughout and was under pressure passing the 400 metres, giving

BUSTER BOLT (J Laking) – Began awkwardly, losing ground.

RENOUNCE (L Callaway) – Lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.

BUSY (K Kwo) – Reported by its rider to have lay inwards throughout the running.

Race 2 TYRES N WHEELS & FLASH AGRI (1200m)

SUPER TAP (C Campbell) – Late scratching at 1.08pm when refusing to load into the barriers. Connections were advised the

filly must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

BELLE SOUTH (B Murray) – Bounded at the start losing some ground.

SUPERSTITION (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly losing some ground.

ICANTELLYA (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

KENTUCKY COUGAR (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early stages. Shifted out passing the 150 metres making contact with BELLE SOUTH then continued to lay out for the remainder of the race. Rider reported the filly had failed to handle todays Heavy track conditions.

FINAL LINE (R Beeharry) – Raced wide without cover throughout and gave ground from the 600 metres, finishing in a distant last placing. Rider reported in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle the Heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

TRICKLE TREAT (T Comignaghi) – Rider dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

Race 3 RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE OPEN SPRINT (1200m)

FRIAR TUCK (T Moseley) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

WHAT'S UP ALF (K Kwo) – Blundered free of interference passing the 950 metres losing some momentum.

C Barnes (THE BUMPER) was spoken to advisedly regarding her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING (1335m)

HAZELNUT (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly losing some ground. When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider K Kwo advised the mare had found the track too testing today.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (A Bohorun) – Slow through the early stages and tailed the field throughout despite the efforts of the rider. Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle the Heavy track conditions and would appreciate a step up in distance.

NESTA (J Laking) – Lay in throughout the home straight and passing the 250 metres made contact with SUPATWISTA with both these runners being momentarily unbalanced.

PROMISING (K Asano) - Rider briefly dropped his inside rein in the run home.

Race 5 CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT & COUNTRY JEWEL (1335m)

HE'S GOT POWER (K Kwo) – Upon leaving the birdcage, charged across the track and into the running rail, dislodging rider K Kwo and escaping riderless for some distance before being recaptured. Declared a late scratching at 2.46pm by order of the Stewards. Apprentice K Kwo was uninjured in this incident. HE'S GOT POWER underwent a veterinary examination and was found to be uninjured.

AZAREEL (L Callaway) – Shifted out abruptly at the start making contact with CITY SLICKER.

BOYSLIGHTUP (B Murray) – Began awkwardly. Rider reported the mare had failed to handle the Heavy track conditions.

DREAM RICH (C Campbell) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout.

HAYWOOD (C Johnson) – Over-raced through the early stages.

CITY SLICKER (K Asano) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 100 metres.

ABBEY KAY (Z Bholah) – Held up for a short distance passing the 100 metres.

 AQUA SALON & SPA & NIGHT N DAY WINTON (1200m)

 FREE AND EASY (T Moseley) – Late scratching at 3.26pm when refusing to load into the barriers. Connections were advised

the mare must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.

Co-trainers **K & A Tyler** (TOBILICIOUS) were issued a Minor Infringement Notice and fined \$50 when presenting this runner without the notified gear namely side winkers.

SO NATURAL (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. Crowded passing the 350 metres and had to steady when TOBILCIOUS lay inwards at his point.

VICE MARSHALL (K Chowdhoory) – Hampered shortly after the start losing some momentum, when TIMES TIME shifted out abruptly. Got its head up when over-racing in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 900 metres. Rider reported the gelding had failed to handle the Heavy track conditions.

KNUTQUACKER (S Wynne) – Rider dropped her whip near the 400 metres.

Race 7 SCULLYS TRANSPORT & MCGREGOR CONCRETE (1800m)

SHE'LL CAT CHOUX (B Murray) – Permission was granted for the mare to race without the notified tail chain due to being heavily in season. Steadied shortly after the start when MR INTELLIGENCE (L Callaway) shifted in marginally at this point. **L Callaway** was advised to exercise care.

TRAMWAY ROAD (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

GERRY JOYCE (K Mudhoo) – Over-raced racing into the first bend and had to be steadied away from the heels of the runner in front.

FEEL THE RUSH (K Asano) – Raced wide when improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1300 metres.

ROCK MASTER (T Moseley) – Crowded and had to steady passing the 1300 metres when placed in restricted room by FEEL THE RUSH (K Asano) which was improving forward. **K Asano** was advised to exercise care.

TRICKY MICKEY (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout. Weakened from the 400 metres.

RAY'S IN COMMAND (J Laking) – Had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the runner in front, then shifted inwards to find clear racing room passing the 600 metres and was held up by the tiring TRICKY MICKEY.

Race 8 AON INSURANCE & CLOVERTONE WINTON CUP (2000m)

THE STYLE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

OREPUKI LAD (J Lowry) – Over-raced into the first bend and had to be steadied outwards off heels.

COME FLY WITH ME (A Bohorun) – Raced wide throughout.

GALWAY GARRY (K Asano) – Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres. **K Asano** was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

CHOICE DU JEU (C Barnes) – Tailed the field throughout and finished in a distant last placing. Rider reported the mare had been making abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MADAM DE SOIR (C Barnes) – Very slow to begin.

SPECTRA (C Johnson) – Over-raced through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported the mare had traveled well throughout the running, however when placed under pressure had only battled fairly over the concluding stages .

MOLLY POLLY (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (R Mudhoo) – Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room passing the 275 metres.

B Murray (OLAF) was spoken to advisedly regarding his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.
