The Stewards made inquiry in regard to the inconsistent times during the day.

DEZ (C Johnson) – Trainer S Wilson advised Stewards that the gelding has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

ALAGANT ANGEL (C Dell) – Began awkwardly.

ONEIROLOGY (D Mansour) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

HURON (R Scott) – Slow to begin.

SHOTGUN SALLY (M Cameron) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied, shifting in slightly placing SIRACUSA in restricted room which had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres. Held up for clear running until shifting out passing the 275 metres to obtain clear running.

SIRACUSA (S Collett) – Steadied 1000 metres when over-racing for a distance.

LINCOLN SPRINGS (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

GHOSTBUSTER (R Smyth) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

POWER'S THAT BE (C Lammas) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

SHANGHAR (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

ON THE NIGHTTRAIN (J Riddell) – Slow to begin.

IHU (K Chowdhury) – Raced wide in the early stages. Lay out making the final bend.

FRAAJ DE LUCA (C Lammas) – Hung throughout and could not be fully ridden out to the finish. A warning will be placed against the gelding for its racing manners. A post race veterinary examination revealed a large bumper rub to the right fore fetlock.

JUST CHICKY (M Cameron) – Held up rounding the final bend and then raced ungenerously for the remainder of the race and was unable to be fully ridden out due to its tendency to lay inwards. When questioned regarding the performance M Cameron advised that the filly had proved difficult in its racing manners. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormality.

WILD LIKE (V Colgan) – Held up until shifting ground inwards to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.

ETCH (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

PEERLESS WARRIOR (T Yanagida) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 4	NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1600 metres)

LUDUS (O Bosson) – Underwent a pre race veterinary examination after being fractious in its barrier stall and was passed fit to race.

LIVVY LASS (D Mansour) – Began awkwardly. Held up until passing the 300 metres.

ANGELICA (M McNab) – Slow to begin then crowded shortly after losing ground.

ZION HILL (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied losing ground.

POWER OF HOPE (R Scott) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OUR STAR (T Yanagida) – Inconvenienced early in the final straight.

HEY SOUL SISTER (S Spratt) – Briefly steadied passing the 200 metres when LIVVY LASS (D Mansour) shifted in when not fully clear. Rider D Mansour was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

BLEW BY YOU (R Smyth) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection which revealed blood out of both nostrils after becoming fractious and making contact with the front of the starting stall and was declared a late scratching at 2.14pm.

JOLLY ZAM (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin.

DIAMONDS GALORE (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly and then was restrained to settle back from its wide barrier.

LOUIS FOURTEEN (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FREDEFENDER (D Mansour) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HUMBUCKER (M Coleman) – The breast plate became undone during the running.

MEGHAN (L Innes) – Held up until near the 300 metres.

L Innes (MEGHAN) – Issued with a warning for using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

M Cameron (DIAMONDS GALORE) – Issued with a warning when shifting out to obtain clear running making contact with RAPIDZ dictating that runner wider on the track near the 350 metres.

RAPIDZ (C Dell) – Forced wider 350 metres.

GRAVITELLE (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

LEITRIM LAD (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

FORTUNE WINGS (M Cameron) – Rider M Cameron reported that he would be recommending to connections that the colt be gelded due to its racing manners.

C Lammas – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed GRAVITELLE to shift out when not clear of SURF 'N' TURF which had to be checked losing ground. The Judicial Control Authority suspended C Lammas' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 19 October 2019 up to and including racing on 28 October 2019, 5 national riding days.

BABICHE (M Coleman) – Slow to begin.

Race 8	AJC.Co.NZ 2100

SMEDLEY (L Satherley) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection and was passed fit to race with no apparent abnormalities detected. Commenced to give ground from near the 800 metres and was not persevered with finishing

a distant last. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection which could detect no obvious abnormality. Trainer C Stevenson was advised that SMEDLEY would be expected to be more competitive and is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

DOUBLE HAPPY (L Innes) – Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after becoming fractious in its barrier stall and was passed fit to start.

ROCKING GOOD TIME (A Goindasamy) – Slow away. Obligated to race wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

WINDY HEIGHT (A Jones) – Raced wide around the first bend until improving forward to obtain cover passing the 1400 metres.

T Harris (TIPICAL) – Issued with a warning over his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9	Next Avondale Trials 29 October 1200

WAY ABOVE (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) – Commenced to run off passing the 800 metres finishing wide on the track passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. The trainer was advised that the gelding will be required to barrier trial prior to racing again.

BOOGIE EASY (A Goindasamy) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight having to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 100 metres and was unable to be fully ridden out to the finish.

Race 10	Tulloch Café 1600

ANATOW (V Colgan) – Steadied from its wide barrier draw shortly after the start. Hampered 600 metres.

CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) – Slow away. Stumbled badly approaching the 600 metres and hampered as a result was ANATOW.

BULLNOSE (BR Jones) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SPLENDIDO (L Innes) – Was under pressure passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned Rider L Innes advised that the gelding had raced keenly in the early stages and was unable to offer any other reason. The gelding underwent a post race veterinary inspection which revealed no obvious abnormality.

TROUBLE (T Yanagida) – Had to be steadied passing the 350 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

LINCOLN KING (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.
