GENERAL:

Racing Tauranga was questioned regarding the times which were inconsistent.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	THE FAT MAN'S CUP 1600
SHOCKING PENNY (J Fawcett) – Became fractious before escaping under the front of its barrier stall. Underwent a veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching at 2:12 pm. The connections were advised that the filly would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.	

NOT USUAL DREAM (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Bumped just short of the winning post by GINGER TOO which shifted out slightly.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (J Kam) – Shifted in and away from GERI passing the 1100 metres making contact with the running rail then reacted poorly resulting in BEAU ARCHERS ROSE displacing the rail paneling and going through the rail with the rider being dislodged. Hampered was the trailing DRAKE BAY. Apprentice J Kam was cleared to fulfil his remaining rides by on course ambulance personnel. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer B Pomare was advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next.

KAYTURE (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

DRAKE BAY (V Colgan) – Hampered passing the 1100 metres. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

TEEN TITAN (M McNab) – Shifted out slightly near the 350 metres making contact with the hind quarters of NOTHING COMPARES which became momentarily unbalanced.

NOTHING COMPARES (M Coleman) – Contacted and unbalanced near the 350 metres.

JUTANUGARN (S Weatherley) – Held up until near the 250 metres.

MONGOLIAN HEAVEN (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no excuse.

V Colgan (DRAKE BAY) – Issued with a warning for using his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 1400**

OCEANIC (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

AMBITIOUS SHOWGIRL (T Yanagida) – Slow to begin. Held up until near the 100 metres.

SCOMADI (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground. Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres.

ALFA ROSSO (J Riddell) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

UNCLE ERN (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 3 | **JEREMY PRYOR SOTHEBY'S 2100**

REFLECTION (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.

CANZAC (A Jones) – Slow to begin (5L). A warning was placed on the gelding's barrier manners. Inconvenienced when weakening after shifting out and away from AMARED ROSE (S Spratt) near the 250 metres. S Spratt was advised to exercise care. Rider was questioned regarding her riding tactics, in particular why she had allowed her mount to improve forward from near the 1500 metres after it had been slow to begin. A Jones explained that CANZAC is one paced and in her opinion, it had been to her advantage to allow the gelding to improve forward through the middle stages when the pace had been moderate. A Jones' explanation was noted.

ALFRED GEORGE (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

TOUCH THE CLOUDS (C Burdan) – Held up rounding the final bend, then held up again passing the 200 metres before shifting out approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 4 | **OCEAN EMPEROR AT WEOWNA PARK 1200**

ANJARDEN (S Weatherley) – Slow away (5L). Trainer S Marsh was advised that a warning would be placed on the filly's barrier manners.

WHISPERING WIND (J Waddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HARDOUT (C Burdan) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 700 metres.

Race 5 | **NOONS RETURNS NORTH 1200**

ONLY IN JAKARTA (S Spratt) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after slipping over in the birdcage and was passed fit to race.

FIRE SCOUT (J Kam) – Contacted shortly after the start then was steadied losing ground.

PATSY LAD (R Smyth) – Slow to begin.

YOU WISH (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TRADITION (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the inside of LIGHTNING FIELD (M McNab) which shifted in. M McNab was advised to exercise care.

STAVROS (C Burdan) – Lay out rounding the final bend forcing ROSA FIORE wider.

ROSA FIORE (C Grylls) – Forced wider rounding the final bend.

R Smyth (PATSY LAD) – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **AZTECH SIGNS 1200**

JAKAMA KRYSTAL (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground.

LUM REEK (A Goindasamy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EARL OF ORKNEY (J Waddell) – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of RECENSION (B R Jones) which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 850 metres.

B R Jones (RECENSION) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of EARL OF ORKNEY which was placed in restricted room having to steady passing the 850 metres.

MOVINONBYE (R Scott) – Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages inconveniencing MARBUZET.

MARBUZET (R Elliot) – Inconvenienced over the concluding stages.

INCONCEIVABLE (T Yanagida) – When questioned regarding performance rider T Yanagida could offer no excuse other than the gelding may prefer more ground.

S McKay (IRON EAGLE) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

<p>MATUZALEM (R Kozaki) – Slow away.</p> <p>MAISON ROXANNE (J Riddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>GOOD LUCK CHARM (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Lay out making the bend near the 400 metres.</p> <p>MAKABAR (J Kam) – Improved on to heels approaching the 200 metres having to be restrained, then improved on to heels passing the 100 metres having to be firmly restrained by its rider and shift out.</p> <p>M McNab (GOOD LUCK CHARM) – Admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.</p>

<p>PENTEVEREST (M Coleman) – Contacted and placed in restricted room having to be steadied losing ground shortly after the start.</p> <p>SAVETTE (J Riddell) – Crowded and steadied losing ground shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>PASABAHCE (J Kam) – Contacted and forced wider shortly after the start.</p> <p>FORTUNE PATCH (R Kozaki) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>BYZANTINE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly then inconvenienced shortly after.</p>	
Race 9	FOOD 101 CATERING 1400
<p>FELIX FAURE (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly shifting out.</p> <p>THE MIDNIGHT SHIFT (L Satherley) – Contacted and unbalanced at the start.</p> <p>DEELS DONE (M Coleman) – Slow away.</p> <p>ALBERATION (K Chowdhoo) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied when placed in restricted room when weakening passing the 350 metres. Had to be firmly restrained when crowded near the 300 metres to the outside of GAME OF LOVE which shifted out and away from DEELS DONE (M Coleman). M Coleman was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>GAME OF LOVE (S Collett) – Dictated outward near the 300 metres, then improved on to heels passing the 150 metres having to be steadied for a distance before shifting out to obtain clear running.</p> <p>RASPBERRY SWEET (T Yanagida) – Improved on to heels passing the 100 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.</p>
