<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BOOK YOUR WELLINGTON CUP PARTY TODAY (1600 Metres)</b>

**THELITEHEAVYWEIGHT** (R Hannam) – Slow away.

**FIFTYSHADESDARKER** (R Goldsbury) – Raced ungenerously for a short distance in the early stages.

**ROX** (L Allpress) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**L Allpress** (ROX) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) regarding her whip use prior to 100 metres.

**L Hemi** (CLOWNIN AROUND) – Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to 100 metres.

**Race 2** | **HIREMASTER PREMIER (2400 Metres)**

**CASINO EL JAY** (L Allpress) - Slow away.

**AIGNE** (T Taiaroa) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**MONDORANI** (R Myers) – Slow away. When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the gelding may not have appreciated today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination showed a delayed post-race recovery.

**Z Moki** (MASTER FIN) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

**Race 3** | **HAPPY 80<sup>TH</sup> SIR PATRICK AND LADY JUSTINE HOGAN 3YO (1200 Metres)**

**MASCARPONE** (R Hannam) – Reared as the start was made, settling back. Lay in near the 150 metres having to be straightened.

**LA JOYA** (R Myers) - Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 200 metres, having to be straightened.

**CURVE** (J Parkes) – When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the gelding had not handled today's track conditions.

**TRIFOLIUM** (L Allpress) – When questioned into performance rider was of the opinion the filly had not coped with today's track conditions described as holding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which was clear.

**Race 4** | **HANLEY FORMULA WELLESLEY STAKES (1000 Metres) Listed Race**

**DE LA TERRE** (D Bradley) – Late scratching at 2.04pm after refusing to enter its barrier. Connections were advised that the filly must trial prior to racing next.

**POWER 'N' GLORY** (M Singh) - Became awkwardly placed on the heels of ONLY WORDS near the 600 metres, having to shift ground.

**ONLY WORDS** (L Hemi) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**M Singh** (POWER 'N' GLORY) – Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to 100 metres.

**Race 5** | **TUI - BACKING A WINNER SINCE 1889 PREMIER (1200 Metres)**

**TECHNICIAN** (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**KING COUGAR** (J Parkes) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight. When questioned, J Parkes said the gelding was not entirely comfortable in the holding ground. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**MARS BARS** (L Allpress) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running near the 300 metres before angling outwards across heels to improve near the 200 metres.

**D Hirini** (SHADOW KING) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to 100 metres.

**Race 6** | **HARRISONS ENERGY SOLUTIONS PREMIER (2200 Metres)**

**EM KAY POPS** (L Hemi) – Slow away.

**MIZZENA** (R Myers) - Began awkwardly making contact with HYPATIA.

**HYPATIA** (D Hirini) – Contacted start.

**FULLY CHARGED** (J Bassett) – Raced keenly for a distance in the early and middle stages having to be restrained off the heels of LOVETOKEEPHIM near the 1400 metres and when doing so went back on to ASCOMANNI, which was steadied. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**SPEED CALL** (R Goldsbury) - Held up having to be restrained off heels near the 700 metres prior to being angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 400 metres. R Goldsbury was questioned into her ride, in particular her decision to urge her mount forward near the rail approaching the 600 metres where there was little room to improve into, when the preferred option would have been to angle off the rail into clear running when able to do so. R Goldsbury advised stewards her intention was to angle her mount outwards off the rail but when kicked up, the gelding improved forward rapidly resulting in her having to steady her mount abruptly off heels. Lost the off-side front plate during the running.

**DON'T KNOW JAKK** (L Allpress) - When questioned, L Allpress advised the gelding may have got its tongue over the bit.

**H Andrew** (LOVETOKEEPHIM) - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to 100 metres.

**Race 7** | **HARRISONS CURTAINS & BLINDS PREMIER (1400 Metres)**

**STORMY HABIT** (R Goldsbury) - Awkwardly away settling back.

**ZEEFA ZED** (L Allpress) - Tightened at the start settling back.

**CALL ME BOB** (R Myers) – A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer N Tiley reported the gelding had got its tongue over the bit and that he would be considering its future.

**LINCOLN DREAMER** (J Parkes) – When questioned rider was of the opinion the gelding had not handled today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

**MY FATHER'S GUN** (D Turner) - When questioned into performance rider reported the gelding was unsuited to the holding ground.

**Race 8** | **GEE & HICKTON FUNERAL DIRECTORS THOMPSON HANDICAP Group III (1600 Metres)**

**PLATINUM INVADOR** (R Hannam) – Slow away.

**JESSIEGEE** (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final turn then continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

**SECRET ALLURE** (R Myers) – When questioned rider advised the mare was unsuited to track conditions. A post-race

veterinary examination was clear.

**Race 9** | **HARRISONS CARPET PREMIER (1600 Metres)**

**RICKY BAKER** (R Kozaki) - Shifted out and away from KAHU ROCK simultaneously as AWESOME AL lay in passing the 200 metres, making contact with the hind quarters of AWESOME AL, which was briefly unbalanced.

**AWESOME AL** (D Bradley) – Briefly unbalanced 200 metres.
