Race 3 - Fasttrack Insurance 2200 metres Rating 82

PICKUP - Trainer K James advised that after a disappointing performance blood tests were taken during the week which produced clear results. He added that PICKUP had been working well in recent days and would continue with its current campaign.

Race 8 - Barneswood Farm Stakes 3YO 1400 metres

OKAY PAL - Co-trainer M Pitman advised that the gelding had recovered well and after galloping this morning would be continuing on with its preparation.

LIVE DRAMA - Trainer L Robinson advised that the filly had recovered well and would be continuing on with its preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 COMMODORE AIRPORT HOTEL MAIDEN (1600m)

OUR ROYAL (K Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

BI YING (S Wynne) - Jumped away awkwardly.

ALWAYS (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

PER FORM (B Murray) - Got its head up when being restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.

RED LIGHT DISTRICT (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.

L Callaway (THE SAINTLY ONE) and **T Comignaghi** (MONASH) were spoken to regarding their whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 CANTERBURY LANDSCAPE SUPPLIES RATING 72 (1800m)

SMILING ASSASSIN (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly.

AHYUM (J Fawcett) - Bounded at the start.

UPSCALE (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

TRUE ELEGANCE (R Beeharry) - Crowded between THE GROWLER and UPSCALE rounding the bend passing the 500 metres.

CINTO BAY (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the bend and in the early stages of the run home.

POP 'N' ROCK (K Williams) - Inclined to shift ground in the final straight ducking outwards passing the 200 metres before again shifting outwards over the concluding stages being relegated from 1^{st} equal placing to 2^{nd} .

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) - Promoted to 1st placing after suffering interference passing the 200 metres.

RIVIERA ROCK (J Lowry) - Hampered passing the 200 metres and again over the concluding stages.

Following this race Stewards lodged two protests alleging interference passing the 200 metres by **POP 'N' ROCK** which had dead heated for 1st placing, to the 4th placed horse **RIVIERA ROCK** and **FRANKIE THE FOX** the other dead heated horse for 1st placing, with further interference to **RIVIERA ROCK** over the concluding stages. After viewing films and

hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the protest by **FRANKIE THE FOX** against **POP 'N' ROCK**, relegating **POP 'N' ROCK** to 2nd placing, but dismissed the protest by **RIVIERA ROCK** against **POP 'N' ROCK**.

Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (800m)

The start was delayed three minutes due to the protest in the previous race.

QUEEN OF THE PROM (L Callaway) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start crowding INDEPENDENT LADY which lost ground.

LACED WITH GOLD (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LA ROMANEE (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start when LACED WITH GOLD shifted inwards abruptly.

OHIO SHOWGIRL (K Chowdhoory) - Bumped and crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

FOLLOW YOUR HEART (K Williams) - Had to be steadied passing the 550 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of QUEEN OF THE PROM.

SILENT ZONE (T Moseley) - Had to be steadied away from heels near the 500 metres and again had to be steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 450 metres.

Race 4 HELSTON & ASSOCIATES MAIDEN (1200m)

BUNGAY (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly after being very fractious in the barriers.

DAL LAD (R Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

LACHIE'S MATE (C Barnes) - Hampered at the start losing ground when CLUBCARD shifted out.

THE BUFFER (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly.

SHE'S FOXY (K Mudhoo) - Had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of THE BUFFER which shifted inwards abruptly after making contact with EXALTATION near the 300 metres.

BELLA EVE (K Williams) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had never hit out freely. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 NZB READY TO RUN SALE RATING 65 (1200m)

PARVINA (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly.

SEDUTTORE (B Murray) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

MIDSUMMER MAGIC (K Asano) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

HAPPY HITTER (J Fawcett) - Hampered when crowded shortly after the start.

DOCKET (R Beeharry) - Hampered when crowded shortly after the start, hampered passing the 200 metres.

FLY TO THE SKY (L Callaway) - Hampered shortly after the start, hampered when crowded passing the 200 metres.

C Johnson (CAN'T SAY ENOUGH) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear dictating FLY TO THE SKY inwards causing crowding to DOCKET and HAPPY HITTER.

PERFIDIA (M Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MAGNIFY (T Harris) - Had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home.

S Weatherley (MISTER MOCHA) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards crowding FLY TO THE SKY passing the 200 metres, with FLY TO THE SKY making contact with DOCKET which was forced across the heels of PERFIDIA (M Mudhoo) which was simultaneously shifting inwards. Apprentice M Mudhoo was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 6 JACK THOMPSON RATING 72 (1200m)

HEE'S OUR SECRET (C Campbell) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly.

VENDIMA (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly shifting outwards making contact with QUATTRO KATIE, hampered when crowded shortly after the start, crowded and had to be restrained passing the 1000 metres when QUATTRO KATIE shifted in.

MEDITERRANEAN STAR (S Wynne) - Crowded shortly after the start, held up early in the run home gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.

J Laking (QUATTRO KATIE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards after the start when not fully clear of VENDIMA which had to be steadied and shift inwards crowding MEDITERRANEAN STAR.

PIPIANA (S Weatherley) - Gave ground over the concluding stages with the rider advising that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

BOUNDTOBEHONORED (T Harris) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 WAR DECREE STAKES (1600m)

FAR SITE (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHERWOOD FOREST (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

WOODCOTE LASS (T Moseley) - Over raced in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained to take a trailing position then continuing to over race into the middle stages.

AOTEA LAD (J Laking) - Raced three wide without cover, unbalanced when bumped passing the 450 metres. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

THE TAILORS NIECE (K Williams) - Hampered when commencing to give ground near the 500 metres and was not persevered with from the 200 metres. On return to the enclosure THE TAILORS NIECE was found to have bled from both nostrils and is now subject to the mandatory stand down periods.

ALL ABOUT MAGIC (S Weatherley) - Held up early in the run home and could not obtain clear running until the 250 metres.

C Campbell (LIGHTNING JACK) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards passing the 450 metres crowding BRONTE BEACH onto AOTEA LAD.

BRONTE BEACH (T Comignaghi) - Made contact with AOTEA LAD near the 450 metres when taken out by LIGHTNING JACK, with BRONTE BEACH then racing in restricted room for a short distance.

HOT TAP (J Fawcett) - Held up until near the 200 metres.

J Fawcett (HOT TAP) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 COUPLAND'S BAKERIES MILE TRIAL (1400m)

SHEEZALLMINE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground, crowded and forced wider on the track passing the 400 metres when DARCI MAC lay out at this point.

XCUSES XCUSES (J Fawcett) - Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover.

MONZA CIRCUITO (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DARCI MAC (K Chowdhoory) - Raced four wide without cover throughout, lay out for a distance passing the 400 metres.

TICKET TO RIDE (K Williams) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area which upon veterinary inspection was found to be from a superficial abrasion in the right nostril.

Race 9 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO SPRING CLASSIC (2000m)

CHIEF SEQUOYAH (S Weatherley) - Permission was granted to ride 1kg overweight.

LOCHAN ORA (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

SITARIST (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

SAVAPAK (K Chowdhoory) - Over raced in the early stages shifting out to avoid heels near the 1400 metres and racing three wide without cover from that point.

ZENTESSA (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home before obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.

KAHARAU (J Fawcett) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 10 PRYDE'S EASIFEED RATING 65 (1600m)

DEVIOUS (B Murray) - Began awkwardly, raced fiercely in the early and middle stages making the bend awkwardly.

SHE'S GALLANT (R Mudhoo) - Bounded and lost ground at the start.

LEADERBOARD (T Harris) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

I AM A ROCK (J Fawcett) - Lay out badly over the concluding stages shifting wider on the track and could not be ridden to full advantage over the last 50 metres.

SPLENDIOR (C Campbell) - Inconvenienced passing the 50 metres when I AM A ROCK shifted outwards.

R Mudhoo (SHE'S GALLANT) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
