Race 8 - Barneswood Farm Soliloquy Stakes

LOIRE - Trainer T Pike advised that the filly had an elevated heart rate following the race, further advising that bloods had been taken from LOIRE on return to his stable which were clear. T Pike further advised that it his intention to carry on with the filly's preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LEDGENDS DAY 8TH FEB ON SALE NOW 2100
<p>MAZZURO (M McNab) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>DESERT STORM (S Collett) - Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>MOOD (M Coleman) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>HELIBERRY (S Spratt) - Attempted to run off near the 1600 metres badly hampering THOUSAND STARS which was forced wide. When questioned rider S Spratt advised that the mare had appeared to shy at the crossing adding that it had pulled up sore. A post race veterinary examination revealed 2/5 lameness with a flexor tendon injury to the right foreleg now requiring a veterinary certificate of fitness prior to racing again. Trainer M Forbes was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its racing manners with Mr Forbes indicating that he would be giving consideration to a gear change.</p> <p>THOUSAND STARS (J Fawcett) - Raced wide in the early stages before being badly hampered near the 1600 metres and forced wide. Rider J Fawcett reported that the mare had felt sore on pulling up but a post race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>UABASSO (R Smyth) - Had a tendency to over race in the lead in the early to middle stages.</p>	
Race 2	FASTTRACK INSURNACE \$5K STAKE TOP UP 1600
<p>SOUTHERN VOGUE (T Yanagida) - Dislodged apprentice rider T Yanagida on route to the barriers galloping a short distance before being recaptured. Underwent a veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers being declared fit to race with rider T Yanagida also cleared fit to ride.</p> <p>RIO BELLE (J Fawcett) - Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>PLUSHENKO (D Mansour) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>PEARL BODINE (S Spratt) - Steadied to avoid the heels of TAKEITEASY (M Cameron) which shifted inwards near the 1200 metres when not fully clear. M Cameron was advised to exercise care. Gave ground from the 600 metres dropping out to finish a distant last. Trainer P Coutts was advised that the mare is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing again. A post race veterinary inspection found the mare to have a muscle injury to the right hind.</p> <p>RUSALKA (T Thornton) - Held up rounding the final turn continuing to be badly held up in the final straight before shifting outwards across heels passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>MAN POWER (J Waddell) - Commenced to hang out when making the bend near the 900 metres and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.</p>

L Innes - Fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule after failing to make the weight for MIRADELLO being replaced by S Collett.

DEEP BEAUTY (D Mansour) - Slow to begin.

LET ME TELL YA (R Kozaki) - Slow to begin.

SCORPZ (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly then restrained from a wide barrier.

DAWNTING (M Cameron) - Over raced when being restrained passing the 1200 metres.

AQUEDUCT (V Colgan) - Raced three wide without cover.

VALMUR (R Smyth) - Held up over the final 100 metres.

DRAGON LEAP (C Grylls) Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.

LONDON BANKER (R Elliot) - Held up early in the final straight.

Race 4 | **NRB READY TO RUN SALE NOV 21-22 2100**

ELLE EYE ARE (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly.

OBSESSIVE (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.

SWEET TREAT (M Burdan) - Began awkwardly.

RIPCORD (R Myers) - Restrained from a wide barrier. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that after getting well back after jumping from a wide barrier, in a race that was run at a moderate tempo, it had been difficult to make up ground but she had been satisfied with the manner in which RIPCORD had finished the race off.

PEP TORQUE (T Thornton) - Raced wide in the early stages.

KATIE PERRIE (R Jones) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

IN A TWINKLING (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding the improved performance, trainer J Richards advised that after a fair effort two starts back the gelding had been disappointing in its most recent run when in his opinion it had not been suited once runners had improved around it but had been better suited today racing on the pace outside the leader in the clear, also adding that he had experimented with a change of gear today adding a cross over noseband.

FELAAR (L Innes) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back, the gelding had found it difficult to make up ground under its big weight, adding that it also had not felt entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 5 | **DISTINCTION HOTEL 1600**

LADY SEQUOYAH (C Grylls) - Knuckled leaving the barriers shifting out crowding KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO. Raced three wide without cover. Was eased down from the 200 metres and on return to the enclosure was found to have blood present in both nostrils. A post race veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination confirmed LADY SEQUOYAH to have bled now being subject to the mandatory stand down periods. Trainer S Marsh indicated LADY SEQUOYAH would now be retired.

KYA KHOOB LAGTI HO (S Weatherley) - Hampered when crowded leaving the barriers.

BILLY MAV (R Myers) - Began awkwardly.

BEAU JEU (J Riddell) - Knuckled leaving the barriers. Briefly held up early in the final straight, steadied when improving onto heels over the concluding stages.

DANCE CARD (L Innes) - Slow to begin.

PARISIAN (R Elliot) - Placed in restricted room making contact with DANCE CARD near the 350 metres when PONT ALMA lay out.

Race 6 | **FOSTER CONSTRUCTION 1200**

MADURO (J Riddell) - Dislodged the rider when commencing the preliminary and galloped for a distance before being recaptured being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice.

NO FINER PINS (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly.

WALKIN' BY (S Collett) - Began awkwardly. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth which upon veterinary inspection was found to be from a tongue laceration.

HEART OF STONE (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

VIRTUOSO LAD (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

RISTRETTO (M McNab) - Had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres after being placed in restricted room to the inside of STRAIGHT SETS (R Beemud) which was being ridden forward to improve to the inside of PIMMS 'N' PEARLS (A Goindasamy) when that runner was shifting inwards. Apprentices R Beemud and A Goindasamy were advised to exercise care when riding in similar circumstances. Held up rounding the final turn and in the straight until near the 250 metres.

PIMMS 'N' PEARLS (A Goindasamy) - Commenced to over race when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres continuing to do so into the middle stages. Held up early in the final straight.

EXUBERANT (C Burdan) - Bumped leaving the barriers then getting its head up when being steadied away from heels. Raced ungenerously through the middle stages when wide without cover getting its head up.

SHOW DOWN (V Colgan) Steadied when awkwardly placed inside heels entering the straight near the 400 metres.

Race 7 | **JAMES AND ANNIE SARTEN MEMORIAL STAKES (1400 metres)**

PIMLICO (J Waddell) - Underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers and was declared fit to race after the gelding lost its footing and slipped over in the parade ring. Began awkwardly then raced in restricted room.

RUBY NEGRONI (A Jones) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

CINZENTO (D Mansour) - Crowded leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced. Over raced in the early to middle stages then raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

DOUBLE IMPACT (S Weatherley) - Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight having to be steadied when disappointed for a run to the inside of SHE'S A LADY near the 100 metres.

RUN TO PERFECTION (J Riddell) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

ANNA CECELIA (S McKay) - Began awkwardly.

SERENA (S Collett) - Had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of PIMLICO (J Waddell) which had to steady and shift inwards away from the heels of MANCHU when that runner was being steadied with J Waddell then taking immediate corrective measures.

Race 8

BCD GROUP 1600

SAINT EMILION (M Coleman) - Lost its footing and blundered badly leaving the barriers losing considerable ground. The Course Manager was spoken to with machinery put through the 1600 metre start point prior to the last race.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (A Goindasamy) - Jumped away awkwardly then being further hampered losing ground.

CONCERT HALL (M Cameron) - Jumped away awkwardly. Held up near the 300 metres.

SWING NOTE (C Burdan) - Slow away.

NO LOITERING (T Yanagida) - Raced three wide without cover.

CONTESSA VANESSA (T Thornton) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

TRUE ENOUGH (J Riddell) - Held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

Race 9

LODGE REAL ESTATE 1600

SODA (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when POLZEATH shifted outwards under pressure.

SAVY YONG BLONK (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly.

GLIMPSE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly.

SYMBIO (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly then raced in restricted room being steadied.

CLADDAGH (M Cameron) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

FARM BOY (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

MASETTO (D Mansour) - Raced three wide without cover. Contacted near the 350 metres when SAVY YONG BLONK shifted outwards to obtain clear running.
