GENERAL:

Rider M McNab advised he would not be attending today's meeting due illness. M McNab is to provide a medical clearance to Stewards prior to racing next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 NOTTINGHAM CASTLE HOTEL 2200

PRINCE ALBERT (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance rider J Waddell advised the gelding had been disappointing and would be advising the connections to experiment with gear changes.

BAYEUX (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MASTER FRECKLES (A Calder) – Slow to begin. Eased down by its rider in the final straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which confirmed the gelding to have bled. Connections were advised that MASTER FRECKLES would now be subject to a two month stand down from racing, a three month stand down from training and a veterinary clearance would be required prior to trialing or racing next.

BORDER LEICESTER (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Inconvenienced approaching 400 metres by PRINCE ALBERT which shifted out to obtain clear running.

TWO MADISON (M Cameron) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

C Dell (PAX VOBISCUM) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

ISKANDER (T Yanagida) – When questioned regarding improved performance trainer J Ruddell advised that ISKANDER had received a favourable run in transit when ridden forward and had been suited by today's track conditions.

Race 2 MAINFREIGHT 1400

LETS ROC (D Mansour) – Declared a late scratching at 1.04 pm after rearing over dislodging jockey D Mansour. D Mansour was attended to by on course Ambulance personnel and was unable to be moved due to his injuries with the race meeting being delayed while arrangements were made for D Mansour to be transported to hospital by helicopter. The race meeting was officially put back three races.

FOODIE KING (L Innes) – Was a late scratching at 2.47 pm after dislodging its rider in the preliminary.

All runners underwent a veterinary examination on arrival at the barrier and passed fit to start.

MANAVGAT (R Scott) - Slow to begin.

BLEW BY YOU (R Smyth) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LUDUS (J Waddell) – Held up until near the 250 metres.

HVAR (A Calder) – Held up until near the 250 metres.

A Calder (HVAR) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 3 LEVENA (HINES) LAIRD 100TH BIRTHDAY 1400

SAVAPPIEL (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

RIPPER OF A DREAM (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HUGH GLASS (R Kozaki) – Crowded leaving the barrier.

ITSY BITSY (L Innes) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out to obtain clear running 500 metres forcing TABATA wide.

TABATA (C Grylls) – Hampered 500 metres when forced wide.

Linnes (ITSY BITSY) – Defended a breach of careless riding in that he permitted ITSY BITSY to shift out near the 500 metres when insufficiently clear of TABATA which was hampered and forced wide. After hearing relevant evidence the charge was found proven with the Judicial Committee suspending Linnes' license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 6 November up to and including racing on 15 November, 7 national riding days.

R Beemud (VALTTERI) – Weighed in 0.4 kg below the handicapped weight. Apprentice R Beemud was reminded of his obligations with regard to maintaining his weight.

Race 4 DONAGHYS N-BOOST 1400

RUIZ (A Goindasamy) – Was removed from its barrier after being fractious in its barrier stall and underwent a veterinary examination being declared a late scratching at 4.05 pm.

RIP 'N' BURN (A Calder) - Began awkwardly.

PLATO (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

SIR RALPH (C Burdan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BUTTERFIELD (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JOJO ROXX (S Spratt) – Held up rounding the final bend.

Race 5 DONAGHYS TASMAN TIM 1200

THOUSANDKISSESDEEP (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly.

JUST CHICKY (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DON DRAPER (J Waddell) – Held up until near the 200 metres.

QIJI MELODY (M Cameron) – Hampered over the concluding stages after improving on to the heels of MABILIS which shifted out.

Race 6 DONAGHYS UDDERMAX 1400

THE BUZZ (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin. Commenced to lay in soon after entering the final straight crowding VERBALIZER near the 400 metres and again near the 200 metres. THE BUZZ continued to hang in despite the efforts of its rider.

VERBALIZER (V Colgan) – Restrained from a wide barrier. Crowded 400 metres, then raced in restricted room for a distance 200 metres.

MISS VALENCIA (S Collett) – Crowded approaching the 1300 metres to the inside of TAMMIE WYNETTE (T Yanagida) which shifted in with MISS VALENCIA then continuing to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

T Yanagida (TAMMIE WYNETTE) – Issued with a warning after permitting TAMMIE WYNETTE to shift in approaching the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of MISS VALENCIA which was crowded and steadied.

MOET MOLLY (E McCall) – Crowded for a distance passing the 1300 metres and steadied.

M Coleman (PIERINA) – Issued with a warning after permitting PIERINA to shift in passing the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of MOET MOLLY which was crowded and steadied.

LADY PAINTON (O Bosson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ZENVO (C Grylls) – Held up until shifting in passing the 300 metres.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200 Metres)

KATE LOUISE (T Thornton) – Late scratched at 5.47 pm after refusing to load. The connections were advised the mare will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

HIBERNIA SEA (R Kozaki) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

DOUBLE EXPRESSO (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Hung out and ran wide when making the final bend.

ORIGINEEL (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHEERS (A Goindasamy) – Became awkwardly placed for a distance passing the 1000 metres when improving inside the heels of CONQUERING KELLY. Raced wide without cover.

R Kozaki (HIBERNIA SEA) – Reminded of his obligation in that he must not shake hands prior to weighing in.

Race 8 DONAGHYS PRO-DAIRY 1600

VAN BLANC (V Colgan) – Declared a late scratching at 6.13 pm after the Starter reported that the saddle of rider V Colgan had a broken tree. After inquiries the Stewards were satisfied that the saddle was presented in a satisfactory condition and that it was likely that it had broken during the preliminary.

LINCOLN KING (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

FLOURISHING (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.

HOLY LOCH (C Burdan) – Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

TIPPING POINT (J Riddell) – Crowded passing the 400 metres becoming unbalanced by TRUMPET (J Waddell) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Contributing was slight inward movement from CRAFTYEVA. J Waddell was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (E McCall) – Held up entering the final straight before shifting out approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

J Riddell (TIPPING POINT) – Reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use.

Race 9 TEAM WEALLEANS 1200

THE REVENANT (R Elliot) – Slow to begin. Briefly crowded near the 400 metres by PUKEKURA (C Lammas) which shifted in to obtain clear running. C Lammas was advised to exercise greater care.

IHU (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

SHOW THE LOVE (E McCall) – Knuckled on jumping away.

PAUL'S SUPER ARIKI (M Cameron) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages losing ground abruptly passing the 1000 metres and hampering PUKEKURA.

PUKEKURA (C Lammas) – Hampered passing the 1000 metres.

ROCCO VALENTI (S McKay) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.
