**RACE COMMENTS:** 

Race 1 RACING AT NEW PLYMOUTH DECEMBER 27<sup>TH</sup> – 29<sup>TH</sup> MDN 2000M

HOUBOUCHOUX (H Andrew) – Slow away.

FOURCHOUX (R Hannam) – Slow away. Briefly inconvenienced near the 1700 metres.

**ULUAK**I (S Collett) – Began awkwardly settling back.

**ANTIPODES** (R Myers) – Made the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly briefly inconveniencing FOURCHOUX.

**ZAREEBA** (M McNab) – Held up rounding the final turn.

**PONDERING** (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MASTER BLACK JACK (H Schofer) – Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

**DOUBLE ACT** (J Parkes) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres. When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

J Parkes (DOUBLE ACT) – Was spoken to with regards his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 DENIS WHEELER EARTHMOVING MDN 1100M

**ROYAL CHARTER** (J Fawcett) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after becoming fractious in the gates and was cleared to start. Blundered at the start.

AGAINST ALL ODDS (R Elliot) – Restrained from a wide draw settling back. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

**SMARTY PANTS** (R Myers) – Slow away. When questioned into performance rider advised that after beginning slowly the filly had raced greenly.

**WASP** (C Lammas) – Knuckled at the start. Inconvenienced 800 metres.

**IFNDOUBTGETOUT** (Z Moki) – Raced fiercely in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, shifting out inconveniencing WASP. Then continued to race ungenerously becoming awkwardly placed to the inside of I'M BUZZ which shifted in near the 700 metres, dictating IFNDOUBTGETOUT on to STREAK OF POWER which was checked. Continued to race greenly for the remainder of the race. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's racing manners.

**STREAK OF POWER** (L Hemi) – Checked 700 metres.

**SIR CALEB** (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, running wide rounding the turn.

CHALLA (M McNab) – Lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 3 STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1200M

**ON THE NIGHTTRAIN** (A Goindasamy) – Blundered at the start making contact with EN ZED FOXY, then raced keenly in the early stages.

**EN ZED FOXY** (H Andrew) – Contacted at the start.

SHADY GREY (H Schofer) – Began awkwardly.

BLUE ARROW (L Allpress) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Dictated outwards near 200 metres.

**IRISH TRIX** (J Parkes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**DEE KEEPA** (R Myers) – Bounded at the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final turn having some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight gaining clear running inside the final 100 metres.

**THE GREEN DRAGON** (C Lammas) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised he felt something was amiss. Subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**LA STRATA** (S Weatherley) – Was tightened and had to steady out of a narrow run near the 200 metres as ENDURING LOVE which was improving to its inside was tightened, when BLUE ARROW was dictated outwards by STARRY SHIRAZ which lay out under pressure simultaneously as ON THE NIGHTTRAIN shifted in.

STARRY SHIRAZ (R Smyth) – Lay outwards near the 200 metres.

**ENDURING LOVE** (M McNab) – Held up approaching the 500 metres before being angled outwards into a narrow run approaching the 200 metres being tightened, then lay out under pressure over the final stages.

**R Smyth** (STARRY SHIRAZ) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) for the manner in which she used her whip prior to 100 metres.

Race 4 NZ FARME

NZ FARMERS LIVESTOCK MAIDEN 1400 M

ALBARON (D Hirini) – Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection after bumping a leg in the tie-ups. Slow away.

**RIBZZ** (S McKay) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting ROCKLEY BEACH, continued to lay out dictating ROCKLEY BEACH tightening THE BARMAN PAYS which settled back.

**THE BARMAN PAYS** (R Elliot) – Tightened shortly after the start settling back. Held up for some distance rounding the final turn.

**ROCKLEY BEACH** (S Collett) – Held up approaching the 400 metres before being angled outwards in the home straight to gain clear running near the 300 metres.

**BREATH OF FIRE** (R Goldsbury) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**R Elliot** (THE BARMAN PAYS) – Was reminded of his obligations with respect to his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 5 PLATINUM HOES TARANAKI MAIDEN 1400M

VANCOOGA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly settling back. Steadied near the 250 metres.

QUEEN OF VENLO (C Burdan) – Raced greenly in the early stages when wide without cover.

**FIRE DANCER** (D Turner) – Tightened and steadied near the 350 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WOLOWITZ.

**LOVE POTION** (R Hannam) – Held up rounding the turn having to be angled outwards across heels early in the home straight to improve approaching the 200 metres.

BLIZZING AWAY (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**OCEAN'S EIGHT** (M McNab) – Held up early in the home straight then raced in restricted room for the remainder, going to the line not fully tested.

WHITE HIBISCUS (C Grylls) – Held up approaching the 200 metres having to be angled outwards to gain clear running near the 100 metres

**C Grylls** (WHITE HIBISCUS) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after angling his mount outwards near the 150 metres when not clear of VANCOOGA which was steadied.

S Weatherley (RANGITATA) - Was spoken to with regards his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 ISABELLA SPIERS 1400 M

**MONKEY SHOULDER** (J Parkes) – Blundered badly at the start losing ground. Restrained off the heels of ARIDITY near the 600 metres and when doing so went back on to CLEAVER which was hampered.

MEILA REI (R Myers) – Hampered at the start when LADY LIRA began awkwardly.

**SIMONA** (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**CLEAVER** (R Smyth) – Hampered near the 600 metres, restrained off heels approaching the 450 metres.

**LADY LIRA** (C Burdan) – Raced greenly in the home straight. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare had raced greenly throughout.

**BELLA PADOZA** (R Goldsbury) – Tightened near the 100 metres when LADY LIRA (C Burdan) shifted out under pressure. C Burdan advised to exercise care.

**NEVERSTOPLAUGHING** (L Allpress) – Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

### Race 7 COMCAT MAIDEN 1600M

The start of race 7 was delayed by approximately 3 minutes due to the horses being late leaving the enclosure.

THE RAHTWO BRO (Z Moki) – Awkwardly away settling back.

EUREKA RISING (D Turner) – Slow away.

MR JIMMY POCKET (H Andrew) – Slow away.

JUST LIKE ROSIE (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**KIPCHOGE** (S Weatherley) – Tightened and checked approaching the 1100 metres when TUBTHUMPING shifted in and away abruptly from RAZOR, with TUBTHUMPING making contact with the running rail, also inconveniencing FALTONIUS. S Weatherley reported that his mount raced greenly after being checked.

**FALTONIUS** (M McNab) – Inconvenienced near the 1100 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final stages having to be steadied.

**TUBTHUMPING** (J Parkes) – Over reacted and shifted in abruptly approaching the 1100 metres making contact with the running rail. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed against the gelding's racing manners.

# Race 8 OCEAN EMPEROR @ WEOWNA STUD 1800M Trainer S Ralph was issued with a warning under Rule 614(2) after saddling OHTHOSERUSSIANS with incorrect saddle cloth.

**TRENDING** (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

**WHENHARRYMETSADDLE** (R Myers) – Slow away.

**BRIAN BORU** (C Burdan) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres and again near the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly.

**WAISAKE** (H Schofer) – Tailed the field throughout. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had never travelled comfortably during the race. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**C Burdan** (BRIAN BORU) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 9NEXT TWILIGHT FRIDAY NOV 22<sup>ND</sup> 2000MROC YA SOX (J Parkes) – Reared as the start was effected losing ground.

**SHOCKTILLYOUDROP** (D Hirini) – Slow away.

**UNIQUEBOUTIQUE** (C Burdan) – Began awkwardly making contact with ROSCHANA. Raced ungenerously getting its head in the air making the bend near the 1700 metres awkwardly running wide on the track, hampering ROSCHANA, before being allowed to improve forward to lead near the 1000 metres. Rider C Burdan reported that after receiving a bump at the start the mare had refused to settle in the early stages.

**ROSCHANA** (R Myers) – Contacted at start then hampered 1700 metres.

THAT'S FUNNY (R Hannam) – Restrained from a wide draw. Held up for a short distance entering the home straight.

**BATTLE ROYAL** (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the middle stages.

VENCEDORA (R Smyth) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ASCOMANNI (R Elliot) – Held up near the 300 metres having to be restrained.
