GENERAL:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400m)
ATAAHUADREAMSRFREE (L Callaway) – Hampered having to be restrained heavily to avoid the heels of SHARP 'N' SILVER passing the 1000 metres. Held up for a distance passing the 150 metres.	
PURE CLASS (R Beeharry) – Hampered at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.	
SURE IS (C Johnson) – Raced wide without cover from the 900 metres.	
HAPPY HITTER (J Fawcett) – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin. Placed in restricted room and held up passing the 400 metres.	
QUEEN SWEEP (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.	

SAINTED PEARL (J Laking) – When questioned regarding performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse.	
SEVERINE (S Wynne) – Jumped away awkwardly.	
SHARP ‘N’ SILVER (C Campell) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres due to the easing of pace, going back onto ATAAHUADREAMSRFREE which was hampered. M McNab (DREAMTESTA) was advised that he must not steady his mount to a degree which puts other riders in difficulty.	
Race 2	BPRC LIFE MEMBERS MAIDEN (2200m)
BAHHGOOFY (T Comignaghi) – Wide entering the home straight.	
FIVE PRINCES (L Callaway) – Had to be steadied passing the winning post first time round. Held up momentarily on entering the home straight.	
THE SAINTLY ONE (M McNab) – Dislodged rider in the preliminary and escaped riderless for a distance being declared a late scratching at 12.32 pm. Rider M McNab stood down from his ride in Race 3 but was subsequently cleared to fulfill his remaining engagements.	
DONNATINA (K Kwo) – Over raced through the early stages then being allowed to stride forward three wide to sit outside the leader passing the 1400 metres.	
WHISPER ROCK (K Asano) – Jumped away awkwardly hitting the outside gate on leaving the barriers. Lay inwards early in the home straight and had to be straightened.	
LATASSO (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend.	
Race 3	ALISTAIR GRAY EMORIAL MAIDEN THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200m)
KHITAN WARRIOR (T Moseley) – Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres having to be restrained.	
THE BUFFER (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
ATLANTEAN (C Barnes) – Lay out rounding the final bend inconveniencing NYMPHADORA TONKS and BRIGHT FLASH on the home turn.	
THE ACE (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.	
LA CONSEILLE (S Shinde) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after rearing over backwards at the start area and was cleared to start. Began awkwardly.	
VIVACE LADY (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Checked off heels at the 600 metres after being placed in restricted room.	
SOMBRA DEAMOR (T Comignaghi) – Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres having to be restrained.	
YOUNEVERKNOW (S Weatherley) – Had difficulty obtaining a clear run until inside the final 100 metres.	
Race 4	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200m)
DUBLIN ROSE - Rider C Campbell was questioned regarding his ride advising that his instructions had been to ride the mare where it was comfortable but to attempt to obtain cover from its wide-ish draw as the mare has not finished its	

paces off when having to cover ground. The explanation of C Campbell was noted and he was advised that in the Stewards view that after beginning well, a better option may have been to ride the mare more positively in the early stages.

EXCLAIM (T Moseley) – Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres.

NORMA JEAN (J Lowry) – Taken back from a wide barrier at the start.

OPHELIA ROSE (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Had to be heavily restrained passing the 800 metres and in doing so shifted out wider.

RECOMMENDED FLIGHT (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

OUR GIRL GILLY (K Chowdhoo) – Began awkwardly.

ATAAHUALUVTHEDREAM (L Callaway) – Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 800 metres.

OUR ROSETTE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Lost the off hind plate during the event.

QUINTUPLE TWINS (AUS) (J Laking) – Was very fractious in the barrier prior to the start. Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover passing the 900 metres. Then made the bend awkwardly at the 800 metres shifting out hampering OPHELIA ROSE. Held up passing the 400 metres after laying in when shifting across heels.

Race 5	GRANT THORNTON MAIDEN (1400m)

PANZER (T Comignaghi) – Got its head up on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres. Held up by a tiring runner for a distance rounding the bend by the 500 metres.

SUCCOSO SEGRETO (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded shortly after the start losing further ground. Raced keenly. Got its head up when being steadied away from the heels of the runner in front passing 900 metres.

MISS DAZZLER (S Wynne) – Got its head up on a number of occasions when over racing in the early to middle stages. Lay outwards entering the home straight for a short distance.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) – Shifted in abruptly at the start crowding insider runner with both runners losing ground. Steadied off heels passing the 500 metres.

Race 6	RURAL LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1400m)

OCEANS AWAY (C Johnson) – Placed in restricted room and had to be eased for a few strides passing the 850 metres.

BOGATYR (J Lowry) – Bounded on jumping.

DAL LAD (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after the start losing further ground. Had to be restrained passing the 800 metres after being placed in restricted room. Was held up briefly passing the 600 metres.

ROMANTIC HERO (C Campbell) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced greenly in the early stages and had to shift outwards to avoid heels near the 1000 metres and was obliged to race wide without cover from that point.

S Wynne (LEIGHTON WARRIOR) was spoken to advisedly regarding her use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

<p>GOLDEN AGE (M McNab) – Bounded at the start losing ground. Improved wide entering the home straight.</p> <p>STOP MAKING SENSE (K Williams) – Had to be steadied near the 1300 metres for a few strides.</p> <p>EPAE ROAD (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had never travelled well. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed severe lameness in the left front with trainer P Harris indicating that the gelding will now likely be retired.</p> <p>BRUCE BANNER (R Beeharry) – Crowded at the start losing ground when STAR WARS PRINCESS shifted out.</p> <p>OUR ROYAL (L Callaway) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>PER FORM (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages and got its head up when being restrained to take cover passing the 1700 metres.</p>	
Race 8	C S STEVENS MEMORIAL BANKS PENINSULA CUP (2200m)
<p>SITARIST (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>RED RIVER ROCK (L Allpress) – Crowded by inside runners at the start losing ground.</p>	
Race 9	MICK & MELBA MURFITT MEMORIAL RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>ALL BLACK MAGIC (K Asano) – Got its head up when being steadied to take a trail passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>HEAD OFFICE (D Prastiyou) – Checked near the 1150 metres. Held up to obtain clear racing room passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>L Callaway (KEEP THE CASH) – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards crowding and checking HEAD OFFICE near the 1150 metres. After hearing submissions and viewing video evidence his licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 5 November up to and including racing on Friday 15th November, 8 National riding days.</p> <p>DEVINE LOVE (S Wynne) – Began very awkwardly then being further hampered when buffeted between runners losing ground as a result.</p> <p>MISS DIORELLA (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final bend and in the run home gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 10	CANTERBURY EQUINE CLINIC RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>OKAY PAL (AUS) (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have an elevated heart rate and a poor recovery.</p> <p>HIGHLY XCITED (T Moseley) – Crowded and had to be steadied when taken in by ALL OR NOTHING which lay in at the 375 metres before being straightened.</p> <p>WHACKOMACO (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ZAH WANTED (AUS) (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels when held up passing the 600 metres.</p>	
Race 11	COUNTRY FEASTS RATING 72 (1400m)

VELADERO (AUS) (K Chowdhury) – Slow to begin with the rider losing the use of the inside iron for a short distance. Held up for clear running early in the run home.

BENEFICIAL (J Laking) – Held up through the middle part in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 175 metres.

MAMMA SANS (B Murray) – Clipped a heel and fell near the 175 metres. An enquiry into this incident was opened and adjourned due to the unavailability of rider B Murray who was transferred to Christchurch Hospital for further evaluation of a suspected collar bone fracture. MAMMA SANS was attended to by the course Veterinarian and transported by the horse ambulance to a local Veterinary Clinic for further evaluation and treatment.

ABRAHAMS (L Allpress) – Shifted in abruptly at the start when jumping from the number one barrier then being ridden with urgency to recover and lead.

TE QUIERA (M Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE LUSTRE (J Lowry) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MEARA MARY (S Weatherley) – Required post-race veterinary treatment for a superficial leg wound after being galloped on during the running.

MISS SCANDINAVIA (AUS) (M McNab) – Held up passing the 300 metres before shifting outwards to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.
