Late Scratching: Race 1 ROSIE MAE – At 11.52 am for refusing to take its place in the starting gates

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 AART ON ST ANDREW MAIDEN 1600m

ROSIE MAE (R Mudhoo) – Was a late scratching at the barrier at 11.52 am for refusing to take its place in the starting gates with the connections being advised the mare must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

MY CASHIER (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SHE'LL CAT CHOUX (K Chowdhoory) – Briefly steadied when in restricted room passing the 1300 metres.

PICTURE THIS (J Laking) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (K Asano) – Briefly inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres when RENOUNCE shifted out under pressure and again near the 100 metres making contact with RENOUNCE shifting out bumping SCANDALOUS.

RENOUNCE (L Callaway) – Shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres inconveniencing OUR BOY RITCHIE and made contact near the 100 metres.

SCANDALOUS (S Wynne) – Bumped near the 100 metres.

ZEDAAM (C Campbell) – Held up entering the home straight, continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

RAY'S IN COMMAND (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding the apparent improved performance trainer T Kennedy advised the gelding had appreciated the addition of blinkers today.

Race 2 IDEAL ELECTRICAL 1600m

There was a delay to the start of this event when FEEL THE RUSH was presented in incorrect gear and was required to return to the stables to have the correct gear applied. Training partnership K & A Tyler were fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule.

TAPONISME (L Callaway) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NESTA (J Laking) – Held up rounding the bend and early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

WHAT'S UP ALF (K Kwo) – Held up approaching the 200 metres when AULYN STAR lay in under pressure having to be angled across heels.

COURTE ZARINDI (C Campbell) – Gave ground over the concluding stages with the rider advising that the mare had held its breath during the running.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (R Mudhoo) – When spoken to regarding the performance of the favourite, rider R Mudhoo advised that he had been off the bit throughout and under pressure with the mare being very disappointing.

A Bohorun (HE AIN'T HEAVY) – Was reminded of his obligations to ensure he rides his mount to the finish line where circumstances permit.

Race 3 SPEIGHTS 1200m

STELLA DAZE (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

SWEET OAK (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

TONY TWO CHIPS (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up passing the 200 metres having to be restrained before being angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 50 metres.

BOOK SMART (T Comignaghi) – Crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres when MEDITERRANEAN STAR who was laying in shifted in marginally at this point. Rider S Wynne was reminded of her obligations to give runners to her inside sufficente room. Rider dropped the whip passing the 100 metres.

TIMES TIME (K Asano) – When spoken to the rider advised that in his opinion the mare had been feeling the effects of recent racing and would appreciate tracks with more moisture in them.

S Wynne (MEDITERRANEAN) – Issued with a warning for using her whip on consecutive strides and seven times prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 H & J SMITH 1200m

KING PIN (K Kwo) – Slow to begin.

ALWAYS ON CALL (C Johnson) – Raced four wide without cover in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 700 metres. Jostled with DARCI MAC approaching the 100 metres. Shifted in under pressure crowding FEELIN THE LOVE inside the final 100 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

DARCI MAC (J Laking) – Bumped with VANILLA MOON when improving into a marginal run to that runners inside early in the home straight. Then jostled with ALWAYS ON CALL for a distance approaching the 100 metres.

VANILLA MOON (T Comignaghi) - Bumped and shifted wider on the track early in the home straight.

FEELIN THE LOVE (K Williams) – Crowded and had to be steadied inside the final 100 metres.

ROCANTO (K Asano) – Rider reported the gelding lost a front near plate during the running.

J Laking (DARCI MAC) – Was spoken to advisedly regarding using his whip for consecutive strides.

MR TYPHON (T Moseley) – When asked to comment on the performance rider T Moseley advised he had been disappointed by the effort and could offer no tangible excuse.

Race 5 CHEVEUX HAIR MAIDEN 1400m

ALL ABOUT ROY (L Callaway) – Shifted out as the start was made hampering SABOTEUR.

SABOTEUR (R Mudhoo) – Hampered at the start losing ground. Became awkward in its actions for a short distance when being restrained off heels passing the 650 metres. Held up through the middle stages of the run home.

GERRY JOYCE (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages.

DONTPUTYAFOOTINIT (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JIMINY CRICKET (K Chowdhoory) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Bumped early in the home straight.

HAVANA HEIGHTS (C Barnes) – Restrained off heels near the 700 metres.

ROSSO CAVALLA (T Comignaghi) – Lay in early in the home straight bumping JIMINY CRICKET. Rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.

RAISE YA CARDS (J Lowry) - Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 100 metres.

SPEIGHTS (C Campbell) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight. When asked to comment on the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuses other than the gelding was very disappointing. Displaced a plate during the running and was reported to have been galloped on during the running by the connections.

Race 6 EDINBURGH REALTY MAIDEN 1200m

THE SUZE (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly settling back. Held up rounding the final bend. Had to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.

WARNING BIRD (R Beeharry) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

OUR ECHO (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

HEIDI HI (S Wynne) – Got its head up when making the first bend awkwardly and raced three wide without cover through the early to middle stages.

I'VE GOTTAGO (R Mudhoo) – Contacted the running rail passing the 250 metres over reacting, becoming awkward in its stride and losing momentum.

MUSTARD (C Campbell) – Briefly crowded passing the 200 metres. Lay inwards across heels over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

KENTUCKY COUGAR (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding performance of favoured runner rider C Johnson

advised he had been obliged to go back from a wide draw but when placed under pressure in the home straight the filly had only battled.

Race 7 DUNEDIN CASINO 1200m

KNUTQUACKER (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

OUTRAM (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres.

CAN'T SAY ENOUGH (L Callaway) – Knuckled at the start and then raced keenly in the early stages.

BELOW ZERO (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Crowded and unbalanced when tiring having to steady passing the 150 metres when OUTRAM who was laying in shifted in slightly at the same time as BELOW ZERO shifted ground outwards under pressure.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) - Raced three wide without cover on the pace throughout.

MILANO (S Wynne) – Got its head in the air making the bend at the 850 metres awkwardly.

MISTER MOCHA (K Chowdhoory) – Crowded when tiring passing the 150 metres with the rider reporting the gelding had been disappointing in its efforts today and could offer no tangible excuses.

TICKETS ON HER (T Comignaghi) – Held up from the 150 metres and went to the line untested by its rider.

ROSIE GLOW (K Williams) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running through the middle part of the run home and had to be steadied passing the 150 metres.

Race 8 HARCOURTS DUNEDIN OPN 1400m

TIMY TYLER (Z Bholah) – Ran up onto heels having to be steadied over the final stages.

FINBARR (L Callaway) – Tightened having to be steadied passing the 200 metres when denied a marginal run to the inside of IRISH EXCUSE.

Race 9 MEEHANS BY LIQUORLAND 750 GREAT KING ST 1400m

TRUE ELEGANCE (R Beeharry) – Restrained from the outside draw settling back. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

FINE BOUQUET (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HE'S GOT POWER (K Kwo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

TOBILICIOUS (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

OPIO ROSE (A Bohorun) – Restrained off heels passing the 600 metres.

SUPERSTITION (J Lowry) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

GARMENT (S Wynne) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear racing room early in the run home.

NAZARE (J Laking) – Held up over the concluding stages and went to the line not tested by its rider.
