SUPPLEMENTARY:**Banks Peninsula RC - Sunday, 3 November 2019****Race 11 - Country Feasts 1400**

M McNab - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount MISS SCANDINAVIA to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear dictating MAMMA SANS outwards with that runner then striking a heel of THE LUSTRE and falling near the 175 metres. After viewing film footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races for 5 weeks effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 16 November up to and including Saturday 21 December 2019 (26 national days).

RACE COMMENTS:**Race 1 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO PREMIER (2000m)**

POP 'N' ROCK (K Williams) - Declared a late scratching at 12.02 pm on veterinary advice behind the barriers, with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing next.

MONDORANI (K Asano) - Slow to begin, had to be steadied off the heels of SITARIST near the 1800 metres.

PICKUP (C Campbell) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages before improving forward to lead.

SITARIST (T Comignaghi) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight before shifting outwards across hells to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

ROAD TO REDEMPTION (J Laking) - Gave ground from the 600 metres finishing a distant last with the rider being unable to offer any excuse. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

ANYTHINGCOULDHAPPN (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had never travelled and had lugged outwards throughout. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 2 GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND PREMIER (1400m)

THE GROWLER (J Laking) - Declared a late scratching at 11.58 am on veterinary advice.

AWESOME AL (J Waddell) - Slow to begin, contacted rounding the final turn. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had not been suited by the slow tempo of the race and was of the opinion that it would now be better suited stepping up to 1600 metres.

FINAL SAVINGS (M Cameron) - Slow to begin.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (K Asano) - Over raced and got its head up when being steadied away from heels on several occasions due to the lack of tempo in the early to middle stages.

NELLIE BLY (K Chowdhooory) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TRYFAN (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final turn making contact with AWESOME AL when attempting to obtain clear running.

Race 3	DAKINS GROUP PREMIER (1400m)
<p>TOO FERLAXED (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ALBARON (D Hirini) - Slow to begin, placed in restricted room passing the 1100 metres to the inside of AMPUIS (L Hemi) which shifted inwards, had a tendency to over race in the middle stages, had to be steadied away from heels near the 600 metres.</p> <p>L Hemi - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres crowding ALBARON.</p> <p>BOGATYR (J Lowry) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>M Cameron - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount SLIGO to shift inwards near the 1100 metres crowding SOMBRA DEAMOR which got its head up and raced ungenerously placing OCEANS AWAY in restricted room.</p> <p>OCEANS AWAY (J Waddell) - Raced in restricted room near the 1100 metres and shifted inwards crowding CLUBCARD.</p> <p>CLUBCARD (K Chowdhooory) - Crowded near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>SOMBRA DEAMOR (K Asano) - Raced ungenerously when crowded near the 1100 metres when SLIGO shifted inwards, held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>ACRE (T Comignaghi) - Reacted poorly when being steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously losing ground.</p> <p>SAVVY LAD (S Weatherley) - When attempting a marginal run to the inside of MAXWELL on the point of the bend near the 450 metres made contact with the hindquarters of MAXWELL when that runner lay in when being struck with the whip with SAVVY LAD and MAXWELL then continuing to come together for several strides.</p> <p>MAXWELL (S Wynne) - Turned inwards when its hindquarters were contacted passing the 450 metres then coming together with SAVVY LAD for several strides before being further hampered near the 350 metres when SAVVY LAD (S Weatherley) shifted outwards.</p> <p>S Weatherley (SAVVY LAD) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards hampering MAXWELL near the 350 metres.</p> <p>CAPODANNO (L Allpress) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 300 metres.</p> <p>S Weatherley (SAVVY LAD) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>OUR GIRL GILLY (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been caught wide throughout, had held its breath and in his opinion would be better suited to track conditions with more give.</p>	
Race 4	AVONHEAD TAVERN PREMIER (1100m)
<p>DESERT MAGIC (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>PIPIANA (M McNab) - Blundered as the start was made shifting outwards crowding BARABAS which lost ground.</p> <p>BARABAS (K Chowdhooory) - Crowded start losing ground.</p> <p>TOP LAURELS (C Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

SOLOMON (J Laking) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when DESERT MAGIC shifted inwards under pressure.

CLARA (C Grylls) - Had to be steadied away from the heels of DESERT MAGIC (D Hirini) which shifted inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres.

D Hirini (DESERT MAGIC) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards passing the 100 metres when not fully clear.

The starter was spoken to after mistakenly applying a barrier blanket to SHEEZALLMINE.

WEKAFORCE (L Allpress) - Bounded at the start losing ground, held up in the early stages of the straight.

SIGNIFY (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

VINNIE'S VOLLEY (C Lammas) - Restrained to obtain cover passing the 800 metres.

K Chowdhoory (EXEMPLAR) - Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6	ENERGY EVENTS CENTRE ROTORUA PREMIER (1600m)

VELADERO (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

THE HEIRESS (M Cameron) - Fractious prior to the start showing signs of being in season. Very slow to begin and reluctant to hit out in the early stages losing considerable ground. Co-trainer A Furlong was advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stipendiary Stewards prior to racing next. Ms Furlong indicated that THE HEIRESS would now be retired.

DUKE OF PLUMPTON (R Myers) - Made contact with the running rail and blundered after being placed in restricted room to the inside of SELFIE (C Johnson) near the 900 metres. C Johnson was advised to exercise care.

VELADERO (S Weatherley) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

SELFIE (C Johnson) - Accidentally struck on the head by the whip of R Myers (DUKE OF PLUMPTON) near the 40 metres.

Race 7	AL BASTI EQUIWORLD 47TH NEW ZEALAND 2000 GUINEAS (1600m)

CALLSIGN MAV (C Grylls) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start making firm contact with CHUCK A LUCK which was bumped outwards onto CHARLIE AWESOME.

CHUCK A LUCK (S Weatherley) - Contacted start.

CHARLIE AWESOME (C Johnson) - Knuckled leaving the barriers then being further hampered.

AOTEA LAD (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages and jostled with ALL ABOUT MAGIC for a distance passing the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had felt a little sore on pulling up having lost the left hind plate. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality other than the lost plate.

LIGHTNING JACK (R Myers) - Raced wide in the early stages before being restrained to obtain cover passing the 1000 metres.

RUN TO PERFECTION (M Cameron) - Over raced in the early and middle stages, unbalanced when contacted by CATALYST near the 400 metres when CATALYST shifted away abruptly from ZELENSKI after receiving slight contact from that runner.

HARLECH (C Lammas) - Got its head up when being steadied off heels near the 1000 metres, again got its head up when having to be firmly restrained after improving onto heels approaching the 600 metres.

CATALYST (T Harris) - Held up rounding the final bend and after receiving slight contact from ZELENSKI shifted outwards abruptly making firm contact with RUN TO PERFECTION near the 400 metres.

Race 8	GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1200m)

ON SHOW (C Grylls) - Buffeted between runners at the start.

LOUIE LOUIE (C Johnson) - Shifted outwards at the start crowding HAPPY HITTER which lost ground.

HAPPY HITTER (R Beeharry) - Crowded start losing ground.

TITANIUM JACK (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

RUNNING MAN (K Asano) - Over raced in the early stages.

TICKETS ON HER (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

CYCLOPS (S Weatherley) - Raced wide without cover throughout, inconvenienced 150 metres.

CLOONEY (T Moseley) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres and when shifting to the outside of FASCINO LASS was taken outwards by that runner inconveniencing CYCLOPS.

SOMEWHERE MAN (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

Race 9	REDWOOD METROPOLITAN TROPHY HANDICAP (2500m)

NYMPH MONTE (J Waddell) - Slow to begin.

SAVAPAK (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early and middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

AL HARAM (M McNab) - Raced wide without cover rounding the first bend until the 2000 metres, inconvenienced when weakening near the 450 metres when SOLESEIFEI shifted outwards to improve. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well but had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure and was unable to offer any excuse. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

MY GIFT (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

L Allpress (SOLESEIFEI) and **J Waddell** (NYMPH MONTE) were spoken to regarding their whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 10	BLUE STAR TAXIS PREMIER (1600m)

The start was delayed when SCOOBY which had been fractious in its barrier required some alterations to the gelding's bridle after the nose band had broken.

KIPLING (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly shifting inwards making contact with ROLL THE DICE.

ROLL THE DICE (J Waddell) - Contacted start.

UPSCALE (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

MONASH (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly.

STELLACANTO (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LETSBRINGTON (M Cameron) - Held up early in the run home and when shifting out to obtain clear racing room passing the 200 metres made firm contact with BILLY MAV which lay in.

BILLY MAV (R Myers) - Lay in making contact passing the 200 metres.

J Laking (I AM A ROCK) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
