RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 HB RACING SUPPORT FAWC 2100 (2100 METRES)

TEAPOT (R Myers) - Slow away.

PARIS COUTURE (S Collett) – Slow away. When questioned regarding performance the rider reported the mare would prefer more rain affected going.

RESOLUTION (J Riddell) - Raced three wide in the early stages before improving outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

WHOLETTHEFOXOUT (R Hannam) - Raced keenly for a short distance in the middle stages, when being restrained shifted outwards bumping CRISTAL BUBBLE near the 1200 metres.

CRISTAL BUBBLE (E McCall) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority, bumped 1200 metres, contacted entering the home straight when PRINCE ALBERT improved quickly to its inside.

S Weatherley, L Hemi and M Singh were spoken to regarding their whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 LIVAMOL 1200 (1200 METRES)

STAR ELLIPSE (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of MISS MIRABELLE having to be restrained near the 900 metres.

MISS MIRABELLE (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously for a short distance getting its head in the air when being restrained near the 900 metres.

HOLSTY (C Grylls) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, lay in under pressure making contact with RAKUTEN near the 100 metres.

RAKUTEN (M McNab) – Contacted near the 100 metres.

J Parkes was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

BELLA (S Collett) – Rider reported the mare had felt indifferent in its action, so was not preserved with over the final stages when out of contention. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the mare to have pain in the sacroiliac area. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing or trialing.

Race 3 STELLA ARTOIS 3YO (1300 METRES)

RIVER RISING (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly, hung outwards rounding the final turn inconveniencing ZOULUMINOUS and DUNDRUM.

ZOULUMIOUS (M McNab) - Inconvenienced near the 350 metres.

DUNDRUM (C Grylls) - Inconvenienced near the 350 metres.

Race 4 TWILIGHT RACES @ HASTINGS 11/12 1300 (1300 METRES)

THE HELIX (M Coleman) – Slow away, tightened near the 850 metres. When questioned M Coleman could offer no tangible excuse and advised the gelding had been disappointing.

MOTIVATION (J Parkes) – Bounded at the start shifting inwards contacting YOSSARIAN, then clipped a heel of that runner blundering and losing ground, held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled inwards across heels to gain clear running near the 200 metres then had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the 100 metres.

YOSSARIAN (R Myers) – Contacted at start, raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 850 metres shifting in and tightening THE HELIX.

GARADOS (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance the rider reported the gelding may have held its breath. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

M Coleman and J Parkes were spoken to regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5

VERTIGO CATERING 1400 (1400 METRES)

I'M NOT JOKING (M Singh) - Began awkwardly, restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.

FLYING SURF (S Weatherley) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, tightened near the 250 metres.

POLAR NIGHT (C Grylls) - Lay in under pressure early in the home straight tightening FLYING SURF near the 250 metres before being straightened then continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.

Race 6 TE AWA WINERY RESTAURANT 1200 (1200 METRES)

WHAT A SMASHER (M Singh) – Awkwardly away, held up for a short distance near the 400 metres and again passing the 200 metres before being angled into a narrow run near the 100 metres making contact with BYZANTINE.

EDWARDIAN LADY (T Taiaroa) - Held up entering the home straight having to be angled out across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

BYZANTINE (M McNab) - Held up entering the home straight, bumped approaching the 100 metres, raced in restricted room for the remainder going to the line not fully tested.

MARIA DIOR (D Hirini) – Shifted in under pressure early in the home straight and then tightened over the final stages when EDWARDIAN LADY lay in under pressure. T Taiaroa was advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

MISS LABASA (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced 500 metres, lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened on two occasions.

D Hirini (Maria Dior) Issued with a warning under [Rule638(1)(d)] after allowing her mount to shift in near the 500 metres inconveniencing MISS LABASA.

L Allpress (Stumpy)- Issued with a warning under [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] after striking her mount on three consecutive occasions just outside the 100 metres.

Race 7 CONGRATULATONS MELODY BELLE MILE (1600 METRES)

MI JAKKY (M Singh) - Slow away, inconvenienced 1400 metres, raced greenly under pressure in the home straight.

RAUCOUS (C O'Beirne) – Contacted at the start when UNION HALL jumped inwards then raced greenly throughout with a tendency to get its head in the air, making the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly inconveniencing MI JAKKY.

PHELAN FOXY (L Hemi) - Ran up onto heels approaching the 400 metres having to be restrained.

Race 8 THREE WISE BIRDS MILE (1600 METRES)

Stewards were informed at 10.45am that DEEP BLUE had incurred a float injury so was subsequently late scratched.

RIPPIN (R Myers) - Was declared a late scratching at 4.48pm on veterinary advice after presenting lame in the left forelimb when trotting up prior to the start.

PLATINUM WILD CARD (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider stated in his opinion the gelding may be better suited to improved track conditions.

THE MIDNIGHT SHIFT (J Fawcett) – Held up early in the home straight.
