<b>Race 1</b>	<b>DIPROSE MILLER 1600</b>
<p>The race was delayed 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.</p> <p><b>VIVA VOLARE</b> (M McNab) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>DEEP BEAUTY</b> (R Elliot) - Slow to begin then ridden urgently to recover. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight then had to be steadied passing the 100 metres when held up.</p> <p><b>YING RESOLUTE</b> (T Yanagida) - Knuckled leaving the barrier.</p> <p><b>SCORPZ</b> (M Cameron) - Crowded approaching the 1400 metres by SECRET RUNNER which lay out when making the crossing onto the course proper.</p> <p><b>WILD WEST</b> (J Waddell) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Improved onto heels near the 1100 metres having to steady.</p> <p><b>ALFA ROSSO</b> (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p><b>OVERTHEMARK</b> (A Calder) - Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p><b>SECRET RUNNER</b> (O Bosson) - Held up entering the final straight.</p> <p><b>T Thornton</b> (GO BOBBY) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JOHNNY REVELL 1200</b>
<p>The race was delayed 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.</p> <p><b>LAURANT</b> (S Collett) - Began awkwardly after being fractious in the barrier.</p> <p><b>ACUTUS</b> (O Bosson) - Restrained from a wide barrier. Had to be straightened over the concluding stages after shifting in near the 50 metres.</p> <p><b>LAGERTHA</b> (R Kozaki) - Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p><b>OLIVIA</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied passing the 500 metres after improving onto heels.</p> <p><b>BOTHERED</b> (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer K Opie advised that he believed the addition of side winkers and back to racing right-handed today, had benefited the mare.</p> <p><b>MAISON ROXANNE</b> (J Riddell) - Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres when FINALE (V Colgan) shifted in when not fully clear. V Colgan was advised to exercise care.</p> <p><b>LADY LIRA</b> (M Cameron) - Raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres to the inside of ACUTUS which shifted in before being correct by its rider.</p>	

<b>O Bosson</b> (ACUTUS) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in near the 50 metres when not fully clear of LADY LIRA which had to be steadied.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>TWO TONES CATERING 1200</b>
<p><b>ATLANTA GEORGIA</b> (C Burdan) - Began awkwardly then steadied when crowded.</p> <p><b>SWEET DREAMS</b> (C Grylls) - Crowded and steadied approaching the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>DIOGENES</b> (M McNab) - Crowded and steadied approaching the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>ELECTROFYING</b> (S McKay) - Began awkwardly then lay in in the early stages despite the efforts of its rider crowding SWEET DREAMS and DIOGENES near the 1100 metres then raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Forced wider 350 metres.</p> <p><b>MABILIS</b> (S Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p><b>MAKING WAVES</b> (J Waddell) - Shifted out approaching the 350 metres making slight contact with ELECTROFYING which was forced wider.</p> <p><b>RECENSION</b> (T Thornton) – Briefly held up entering the final straight.</p> <p><b>ROMANOV GIRL</b> (E McCall) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>LIMENTIS</b> (C Lammas) - Held up briefly entering the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TE AROHA TRACTORS &amp; GARDEN MACHINERY 1400</b>
<p><b>PATSYS LAD</b> (R Smyth) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>SHE SPEEDS</b> (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly then steadied.</p> <p><b>SIRACUSA</b> (S Collett) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>NOT USUAL LITENING</b> (J Riddell) - Crowded and steadied approaching the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>FOOGAYZEE</b> (V Colgan) - Crowded and steadied approaching the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>M Coleman</b> (PERENNIAL) - Issued with a warning for permitting PERENNIAL to shift in approaching the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of NOT USUAL LITENING and FOOGAYZEE which were crowded then steadied. Was reminded of his obligations regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>R James</b> (FOOGAYZEE) – Issued with a warning for presenting FOOGAYZEE to race with blinkers which were not notified.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>TE AROHA STALLION SERVICES SCHEME 1400</b>
<p><b>MISTER PRESIDENT</b> (C Lammas) - Slow to begin. Hampered near the 400 metres by NOT USUAL GLORIOUS which shifted out.</p> <p><b>ANJARDEN</b> (M Coleman) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p><b>AQUEDUCT</b> (V Colgan) - Steadied approaching the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels.</p>	

**DARK HORSE** (O Bosson) - Raced wide without cover. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight with the rider not being able to ride the gelding out fully to the finish.

**BOSCOLO** (S Collett) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of DARK HORSE which was laying in despite the efforts of its rider near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding would benefit from firmer track conditions and racing over more ground.

**C Grylls** (NOT USUAL GLORIOUS) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift out when not fully clear of MISTER PRESIDENT which was hampered near the 400 metres.

**J Waddell** (DON DRAPER) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>RYAN BRADLEY BAYLEYS COMMERCIAL 1600</b>
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**FELIX FAURE** (S Collett) – Crowded approaching the 1400 metres then raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Rider advised that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action in the final straight when being eased down. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination revealed left side pelvic muscle soreness. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**T Yanagida** (TAMMIE WYNETTE) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of FELIX FAURE near the 1400 metres.

**EN SOIE** (R Elliot) - Slow to begin. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 450 metres.

**GIRL OF STEEL** (C Burdan) – Slow to begin.

**INITIATIVE** (A Calder) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

**MASTER PAINTON** (O Bosson) – Slow to begin.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600 metres)</b>
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**DAWON** (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

**SHOCKING PENNY** (J Fawcett) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**VALMUR** (R Smyth) - Held up entering the final straight.

**MIRADELLO** (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>SHACKELL ELECTRICAL 2200</b>
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**TE WAEWAE BAY** (A Calder) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

**SIR ZACH** (R Smyth) - Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier. Over raced in the early stages then was allowed to improve from near the 1400 metres to race wide without cover for the rest of the race.

**HORSEY HORSE HORSE** (T Thornton) - Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

**LINCOLN KING** (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

**CENTRUY MISS** (M Coleman) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had hung out throughout the running and had been unsuited by today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and could find no abnormality.

**L Satherley** (MEANT TO BE) – Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

**Race 9**

**THAMES RACING TE AROHA 3 JAN 1400**

**EXPRESSIVE** (V Colgan) - Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

**JOJO ROXX** (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly then steadied.

**MATTER OF FACT** (C Grylls) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Lay in approaching the 100 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

**HEZA BIG HOPE** (S Weatherley) - Raced wide for the majority of the race.

**O Bosson** (GINGER TOO) - Was spoken to regarding his use of the whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.
