GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TELTRAC PREMIER (1400m)
DOCKET (T Harris) - Began awkwardly, checked passing the 300 metres when weakening.	

S Weatherley (LIAM) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of DOCKET (T Harris) which was checked. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Weatherley's licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing today, Saturday 16 November up to and including Wednesday 27 November.

SHANPARK (R Elliot) - Slow to begin, crowded and checked near the 250 metres.

S Wynne (SEVERINE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of SHANPARK which was checked near the 250 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Wynne's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Friday 29 November up to and including Sunday 8 December.

IFFIDA (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LIAM (S Weatherley) - Held up early in the run home.

SURE IS (K Williams) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (M McNab) - Lay inwards through the run home and had difficulty obtaining clear running, going to the line without being fully tested by its rider.

SHOW PARK (R Elliot) - Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils undergoing a veterinary inspection which confirmed the gelding to be a bleeder now being subject to the mandatory stand down periods.

S Wynne (SEVERINE) - Issued with a warning for her whip use after striking her mount on three consecutive strides just prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2	KNCOOLTAINER PREMIER (1800m)

POP 'N' ROCK (K Williams) - Bounded at the start beginning awkwardly, briefly crowded passing the 350 metres when TOP LAURELS shifted outwards under pressure, rider dropped the whip passing the 200 metres.

VELADERO (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

TOP LAURELS (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin, raced wide without cover through the early stages, shifted out under pressure passing the 350 metres.

HEAD OFFICE (K Asano) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

BAKELA (C Johnson) - Over raced and had to be restrained off heels on at least two occasions in the early stages.

PICTURE ME ROLLIN (R Mudhoo) - Had to be momentarily steadied passing the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of BAKELA (C Johnson) which shifted inwards slightly. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care.

DUKE OF PLUMPTON (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

ALBUTME (R Hannam) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding may not have backed up from its first day performance.

SIR NATE (L Innes) - Received veterinary treatment post race after displaying a slow recovery.

Race 3	CASHMERE ESTATE - LIVE WITHOUT COMPROMISE PREMIER (2500m)

TO LOVE YOU (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages, shifted out and made contact with CINTO BAY passing the 425 metres, shifted away from CINTO BAY which lay in passing the 150 metres.

MONDORANI (K Asano) - Briefly crowded passing the 650 metres when RIPCORDER (R Myers) shifted ground. R Myers was advised to exercise care. Placed in restricted room briefly passing the 125 metres when RIVIERA ROCK shifted in.

CINTO BAY (S Weatherley) - Contacted from the inside when TO LOVE YOU shifted out slightly passing the 425 metres, lay inwards passing the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

AHYUM (T Comignaghi) - When questioned rider advised that the mare did not back up after the second day of the meeting and failed to see out the distance of today's race.

Race 4	VERNON & VAZEY TRUCK PARTS PREMIER (1400m)

BELLE FASCINO (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly then making heavy contact with TRUDEAU losing ground as a result.

TIMY TYLER (L Allpress) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

KILLARNEY (C Johnson) - Raced fiercely in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had over raced in the early stages however travelled into the race well but failed to let down over the concluding stages.

EL BEE DARCI (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

TICKET TO RIDE (K Williams) - Steadied away from the heels of ROCANTO which lay out passing the 200 metres shifting ground inwards to find clear racing room.

KIWI IDA (A Mudhoo) - Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 5	BARNESWOOD FARM WELCOME STAKES (1000m)

SHOWEMHOWITSDONE (S Spratt) - Began very awkwardly losing ground.

SILENT ZONE (L Callaway) - Crowded and made contact with the running rail shifting out across the heels of OHIO SHOWGIRL (L Allpress) passing the 250 metres clipping a heel and blundering badly unbalancing the rider.

L Allpress (OHIO SHOWGIRL) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she attempted a run between SILENT ZONE and QUEEN OF THE PROM when there was insufficient room to do so resulting in SILENT ZONE being crowded and badly unbalanced after clipping a heel passing the 250 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 23 November up to and including Wednesday 4 December.

CHOKITO (R Myers) - Shifted inwards at the start crowding FOLLOW YOUR HEART which lost ground.

FOLLOW YOUR HEART (K Williams) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

LA ROMANEE (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

OPIHI COMMANDER (R Beeharry) - Badly hampered 250 metres and was not persevered with.

LACED WITH GOLD (S Weatherley) - Lay in throughout the run home, with the rider reporting that the filly was unable to be ridden out fully.

Race 6	NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER (2000m)
<p>SHE'S GALLANT (R Mudhoo) - Began very awkwardly then shifting inwards abruptly and refusing to hit out eventually dislodging its rider. R Mudhoo was uninjured in this incident. The connections were advised that the mare must barrier trial on a number of occasions prior to racing next. Trainer M McCann advised that the mare will not be persevered with as a racing proposition.</p> <p>SCOOBY (J Lowry) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 7	GAVELHOUSE.COM 47TH NEW ZEALAND 1000 GUINEAS (1600m)
<p>KALI (T Harris) - Bounded at the start losing ground before being further hampered when bumped from the inside by JENNIFER ECCLES which shifted outwards. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in the right nostril which after veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination was deemed not to be a bleeder having suffered an injury consistent with hitting its head on the starting gates.</p> <p>HOT TAP (R Hannam) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>AVADANE (R Myers) - Lay in throughout the run down the back straight placing ARETHA in restricted room on a number of occasions.</p> <p>ARETHA (M Cameron) - Placed in restricted room on a number of occasions racing down the back straight then began to over race for a distance passing the 1050 metres having to be restrained off heels.</p> <p>FLAUNTING (S Spratt) - Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>RIVA CAPRI (C Grylls) - Bumped from the inside when LOIRE shifted outwards looking for clear racing room passing the 700 metres. M McNab was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>ALL ABOUT MAGIC (L Allpress) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>LOIRE (M McNab) - Lay in throughout the run home and passing the 125 metres shifted inwards having to be straightened.</p> <p>JENNIFER ECCLES (S Weatherley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>TRAVELLING LIGHT (S Collett) - Had a tendency to lay out under pressure in the run home.</p> <p>BRONTE BEACH (C Johnson) - Received veterinary treatment post race after displaying a slow recovery.</p>	
Race 8	AVON CITY FORD PREMIER (1200m)
<p>PIPIANA (McNab) - Bounded at the start and shifted outwards crowding BARABAS and CLOONEY which both lost ground, raced wide without cover.</p> <p>BARABAS (S Toolooa) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>CLOONEY (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>MAGNIFY (T Harris) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>DESERT MAGIC (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>FASCINO LASS (S Collett) - Held up early in the run home.</p>	

VENDIMA (L Callaway) - Placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres when DESERT MAGIC which was laying out shifted outwards briefly before being corrected.

KHIMAR WAR (R Myers) - Held up for a passing the 250 metres and was unable to obtain clear racing room for remainder of the race.

MEDITERRANEAN STAR (S Wynne) - Lay in over the final stages.

TEE CEE COUP (S Weatherley) - When asked to comment on the performance, rider could offer no tangible excuse and advised that the mare had been very disappointing.

Race 9	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO 156TH NEW ZEALAND CUP (3200m)
---------------	---

PAMIR - Declared a late scratching at 4.00 pm by order of the Stewards after trainer J Luxton had been observed to be administering a substance to the mare by way of oral syringe in the saddling area of the racecourse. Prior to the scratching being actioned a request for a ruling had been lodged with the Judicial Committee who confirmed the decision of the Stipendiary Stewards. The actions of Mr Luxton is now the subject of an ongoing investigation.

OWEN PATRICK (K Asano) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

HUMBLE PIE (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early and middle stages.

CHIEF SEQUOYAH (R Hannam) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

DUPLICITY (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse and advised that the gelding had felt a little flat today. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

S Wynne (DIORISSIMO) - Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip in that she struck her mount 13 times prior to the 100 metres including five strikes on consecutive strides. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Wynne's licence to ride at race meetings for 10 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 8 December up to and including Saturday 21 December.

Race 10	FRANTIC BLOODSTOCK PREMIER (1600m)

KANDARI (K Williams) - Blundered badly at the start shifting outwards abruptly hampering JIN LU which lost ground.

JIN LU (M Cameron) - Hampered at the start losing ground.

UPSCALE (C Grylls) - Very slow to begin, had to be restrained off heels when racing keenly passing the 1400 metres.

TORRE DEL GRECO (K Asano) - Raced keenly through the early stages and had to be restrained away from heels passing the 1200 metres, continued to over race and again had to be steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres.

MISS DOHERTY (L Allpress) - Over raced through the middle stages.

HEE'S OUR SECRET (J Lowry) - Raced four wide without cover for the majority of the race.

THE GROWLER (S Collett) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

TAPONISME (T Harris) - Held up through the middle stages of the run home and had to be restrained off heels passing the 250 metres.

AWESOME AL (J Waddell) - Jostled with HEE'S OUR SECRET for a short distance passing the 350 metres.	
Race 11	SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1400m)
<p>VOUCH (K Asano) - Blundered at the start.</p> <p>SHARP 'N' SILVER (C Campbell) - Bounded at the start losing ground, hampered passing the 1100 metres, held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>MIDSUMMER MAGIC (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>LADY STYLE (J Waddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>PURE CLASS (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>I GOT A ROCK (L Allpress) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground, hampered passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>PERFIDIA (C Johnson) - Over raced through the early stages.</p> <p>SISTER MONICA (T Comignaghi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after being caught wide the mare had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure.</p> <p>THE SWISS MAESTRO (M McNab) - Had to be restrained away from heels when over racing passing the 1100 metres with the trailing SHARP 'N' SILVER and I GOT A ROCK being hampered in consequence.</p> <p>AUGUSTACE (S Toolooa) - Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages dictating MARQUITA MISS outwards onto QUEEN JETSUN which was hampered and had to be steadied, continued to lay out and again made contact with MARQUITA MISS in the shadows of the winning post. S Toolooa was reminded of his obligation to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>SECRET SOUND (C Barnes) - When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner, rider reported that the mare had hung during the running but otherwise could offer no tangible excuse.</p>
