GENERAL:

Track was downgraded to Dead 4 prior to Race 1 after 6mm of rain fell during the morning. Downgraded to Dead 6 prior to Race 5 after further rain. Then Slow 7 prior to Race 6.

M Cropp (OCTAVIOUS) advised he would not be riding the meeting on Saturday morning and was replaced by M Singh in Race 6.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WANGANUI MOTORS 2200m

HUJAR (M Singh) - Late scratched at approximately 12:23pm after dislodging the rider prior to the start. Rider M Singh was examined by St John paramedics and cleared to ride.

MASTER BLACK JACK (Z Moki) - Slow away. Lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened.

BLACK ANASTA (D Turner) – Restrained from a wide draw, settling back.

HOUBOUCHOUX (H Andrew) - Slow away. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

PRINCESS JENNI (J Fawcett) - Raced ungenerously for a distance near the 1,700 metres. Held up for a distance near the 400 metres. When questioned into the performance Rider J Fawcett advised the mare may appreciate some easing in the track conditions.

ANTIPODES (R Myers) - Raced three wide in the early stages before being ridden forward to sit outside the leader near the 1,200 metres. Lay inwards near the 350 metres bumping **PONDERING.**

PONDERING (T Yanagida) – Bumped near the 350 metres.

FIFTYSHADESDARKER (R Goldsbury) - Raced wide throughout.

VAZZA'S GIFT (C Burdan) - Ran in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened. When questioned into the improved performance connections advised the mare appreciated the extra distance of today's race.

J Parkes (Great North Road) - Was reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts fully to the finish when able to do so.

Race 2 R&L FREIGHT/TOTAL LOGS 1200m

SCHOONER O'CEIRIN (T Yanagida) - Slow away.

TAKE CONTROL (M Singh) – Slow away.

STREAK OF POWER (L Hemi) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Steadied near the 450 metres.

R Goldsbury (Another Secret) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) after allowing her mount to shift out near the 450 metres when not fully clear of **STREAK OF POWER** which was steadied.

DUNDEEL'S GIRL (C Burdan) - Tightened approaching the 600 metres when in restricted room. When questioned into the performance Rider C Burdan advised the mare may appreciate more ground.

FLIRTINI (D Bradley) - Restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of JUDITH near the 600 metres.

Race 3 SUMMIT ELECTRICAL 1200m

BROTHER ONE (R Goldsbury) - Began awkwardly settling back.

LA BELLA ROSA (C O'Beirne) – Steadied when placed in restricted room going into the first turn. When questioned, Rider C O'Beirne stated that the mare had over-reacted to runners around it and when being steadied went back on to STAND TALL which shifted out to avoid heels and when doing so hampered HUNDYAMONTH and BORN TO FIGHT. Held up rounding the final turn. Angled outwards across heels inside the final 100 metres to gain clear running.

BORN TO FIGHT (D Turner) - Hampered 800 metres, then commenced to over-race.

HUNDYAMONTH (L Allpress) – Hampered 800 metres.

J Parkes (Wild Seas) - Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4 WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS 1650m

FLYING MEG (L Hemi) - Slow away. Restrained off the heels of STAR QUALITY near the 1,400 metres.

ARIDITY (R Hannam) – Slow away.

STAR QUALITY (M Singh) - Restrained off heels near the 1,400 metres.

GRANITE RIDGE (T Taiaroa) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

AMORATA (L Allpress) – Held up behind the tiring **MISS SHER NAN** near the 500 metres having to be restrained and then again for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Disappointed for a run between **ARIDITY** and **WHENHARRYMETSADDLE** near the 200 metres having to be restrained when both runners shifted ground.

MISS SHER NAN (D Bradley) - Gave ground quickly from the 800 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned Rider D Bradley could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

MYRTLE (R Goldsbury) - Placed in restricted room having to be steadied near the 1400 metres when **PORTLAND JIMMY** (J Parkes) shifted in, going back onto **STAR QUALITY** which had to be restrained. Rider J Parkes was advised to exercised care.

Race 5 TOM ANDREWS CONTRACTING/PGG WRIGHTSON 1400m

HERMES (R Goldsbury) – Late scratched approximately 13:25 on veterinary advice after being injured in the float.

ROSE OF DELGATIE (L Hemi) – Was removed from the barriers after becoming fractious, underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start.

FIRE DANCER (D Turner) – Began awkwardly.

JENEVER (R Hannam) - Tightened at the start when QIJI OLYMPIA began awkwardly.

NOBLE EMILY (L Allpress) – Slow away.

QIJI OLYMPIA – (R Myers) - Lay out rounding the bend near the 1,200 metres inconveniencing **THATZ DAISY**, then raced ungenerously for a distance.

TIGERBEE (J Fawcett) - Raced wide throughout and was not persevered with in the straight when out of contention.

RUIE'S CRUMPET (H Andrew) – When questioned into the improved performance Trainer G Lowry advised the mare had raced greenly when amongst the field at its earlier starts and appreciated being ridden more positively in front today.

YOULLBEFINE (B Ansell) – Following the running of the race the mare suffered an internal haemorrhage which was fatal.

Race 6 WAVERLEY HARVESTING/BIG BLADES 1650m

JUST LIKE ROSIE (L Hemi) - Tightened at the start settling back.

CAPTION (H Andrew) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

WOLOWITZ (R Myers) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 7 STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP WAVERLEY CUP 2200m

Trainer K Myers was fined \$50 under Rule 537 (a) after not declaring a rider for **OVERTHERIVER** by the required time.

BEYOND THE FORT (D Turner) – Slow away after beginning awkwardly. When questioned into his ride D Turner advised that after being awkwardly away he found himself further back than intended. He further added the mare was never comfortable in today's Slow 7 going and had to push the mare along to maintain its position from near the 1,400 metres and was then obliged to improve wide rounding the turn.

L Allpress (Hank Moody) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

SANCHEZ (R Myers) - When questioned into the performance Rider R Myers advised the gelding may not have appreciated today's rain affected conditions.

Race 8 C R GRACE/WILSON LIVESTOCK 1400m

SKY HI RAHTWO (L Hemi) - Slow away.

ALL IN MANA (H Andrew) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

BELLA PADOZA (B Ansell) — Lay inwards near the 500 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **CHICKABERINDA** having to be steadied.
