Race 1	BUNNINGS NEW PLYMOUTH MDN 1800 M
PRINCESS JENNI (L Allpress) – Tightened at start when BERRY DELIGHTFUL began awkwardly.	
BERRY DELIGHTFUL (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.	
EUREKA RISING (R Myers) – Slow away.	
J Riddell (KRAKADEEL) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.	

Race 2	PRIMOWIRELESS MDN 1100 M
<p>A Sharrock – Was fined \$50 under Rule 537(a) after not declaring a rider for LA FEELYA by the required time.</p> <p>ENDURING LOVE (O Bosson) – Blundered at the start.</p> <p>MI GOLD CARD (D Turner) – Hung outwards throughout.</p> <p>BARNEY RUBBLE (R Myers) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth consistent with having bitten its tongue during the race.</p> <p>STARRY SHIRAZ (R Smyth) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight before being angled inwards across heels approaching 200 metres, tightened having to be steadied near the 150 metres.</p> <p>M Hudson (SHEEZANICEGIRL) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing her mount to shift in near the 150 metres tightening STARRY SHIRAZ which was steadied.</p>	
Race 3	TE AO HONEY CO MDN 3YO 1100 M
<p>POROTENE CHARM (C Burdan) – Slow away.</p> <p>IFNDOUBTGETOUT (Z Moki) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages getting its head in the air making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. Lay in under pressure early in the home straight having to be straightened.</p> <p>KICK START (S Collett) – Lay in shortly after the start contacting MADAM HASS becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p>VEDETTE ROUGE (K Asano) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 4	REVITAL FERTILISER MDN 1600 M
<p>FIRE DANCER (D Turner) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>ADMIRE (R Myers) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Tightened having to be steadied near the 75 metres when KIPCHOGE (O Bosson) shifted in under pressure. O Bosson was advised he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>ATOMIC KITTEN (S Collett) – Lay out near the 1100 metres bumping MISSANDEI.</p> <p>MISSANDEI (M Cameron) – Bumped near 1100 metres.</p> <p>LED ZED (L Allpress) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 1000 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.</p> <p>MAUNA LOA (J Laking) – Disappointed for a run near the 75 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ADMIRE and could not be ridden to full advantage over the final stages.</p> <p>M Hudson (FIFTYSHADESDARKER) – Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 5	WAIKATO EQUINE VEGTERINARY 1400 M
<p>VAN COOGA (L Hemi) – Tightened at the start when AQUILA STAR began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>AQUILA STAR (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly.</p>	

SAIGON HOT NIGHT (R Smyth) – Slow away.

SIR CALEB (R Myers) – Got its head in the air when being restrained near the 1100 metres.

SACROSANCT (S Collett) – Held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.

COMBAT QUEEN (D Johnson) – Ran up on to heels approaching the 400 metres having to be restrained.

K Asano (SMARTY PANTS) – Was spoken to with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **GIRLS GO RACING MDN 1400 M**

SHADY GREY (L Allpress) – Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection after being kicked behind the start.

WINE N' DINE (R Myers) – Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection after being kicked behind the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

HERMES (K Asano) – Began awkwardly then raced keenly in the early stages.

DEN BOSCH (J Parkes) – Was obliged to improve very wide rounding the final turn.

OCEAN SPIRIT (S Collett) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 500 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised she felt something was amiss. Subsequently veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be arrhythmic and tachycardic. Connections were advised the gelding will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing or trialling.

M Cameron (VISENYA) – M Cameron was kicked when dismounting VISENYA in the enclosure following the race, he was attended to by St John's and stood down for his remaining ride. M Cameron will require a medical clearance prior to racing again.

Race 7 | **MASON APPLIANCES 1800 M**

BELLA PADOZA (B Ancell) – Underwent and passed a pre-race veterinary inspection after getting down in its tie-up. Rider dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

CALL DOUBT (C Burdan) – Held up entering the home straight before being angled across heels to gain clear running passing the 200 metres.

MAV (D Turner) – Lay in under pressure in the home straight before being straightened.

FLOURISHING (K Asano) – Held up from near the 400 metres, continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight

D Turner (MAV) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b) (ii) with regards his whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 8 | **LA NUOVA APPARELMASTER 1400 M**

SAVASTEP – D Johnson replaced M Cameron (injured). Blundered at the start, then tightened shortly after when INTO THE DEEP began awkwardly.

AMAZING BANKER (M Hudson) – Raced keenly when racing three wide without cover. Trainer K Reid attributed the improved performance of the gelding to the apprentice M Hudson not using her whip and riding hands and heels, as in her opinion AMAZING BANKER does not react well to being struck with the whip.

CLEAVER (J Riddell) – Raced very wide without cover throughout.

SKY HI RAHTWO (C Burdan) – Restrained of heels when approaching the 800 metres.

GOBUYIT (L Allpress) – Held up rounding the final turn.

L Hemi (MAL DEE) – Was spoken regarding her use of the whip on a runner out of contention.
