<u>Wanganui Racing Club – Race 8 A+ PLUMBING 1340 – 30 November 2019</u>
At an adjourned inquiry, Apprentice Jockey M Hudson was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) in that she allowed her mount BANGLES to shift inward near the 700 metres when not fully clear of TERRACOTTA WARRIOR which was steadied. Stewards took into account the tendency of BANGLES to over race when assessing the degree of interference.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EPSOM & ASCOT GEORGE & WHEELS MDN (2000M)
I AM A CRAFTSMAN (M Singh) – Awkwardly away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	

CALLYROSE (J Parkes) – Slow away. Gave ground passing the 1000 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. When questioned into performance rider advised that he felt something may be amiss. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

NOT USUAL DREAM (J Riddell) – Held up rounding the final turn having to be angled outwards across heels in the home straight gaining clear running near the 250 metres.

OCTAVIOUS (S McKay) – Blundered at the start losing ground then raced keenly for a short distance.

JUST LIKE ROSIE (M Hudson) – Restrained off heels approaching the 800 metres.

H Andrew (DETONATE) – Was spoken to with regard to her whip use prior to 100 metres.

Race 2	WEST END BOWLING CLUB MDN 3YO (1100M)
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O'CHARM (K Asano) – Jumped outwards at the start tightening SWEET FIELDS and MOZART'S MISTRESS.

SWEET FIELDS (R Elliot) – Tightened at start.

MOZART'S MISTRESS (L Allpress) – Tightened start then raced keenly for a short distance.

IFNDOUBTGETOUT (Z Moki) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

MERITORIOUS (C Grylls) – When questioned into performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

BOUTONNIERE (J Parkes) – Shifted in and away from IFNDOUBTGETOUT which lay inwards near the 75 metres.

MISS MAPLE (H Andrew) – Ran up on to the heels of the tiring MERITORIOUS entering the home straight having to be angled inwards to improve.

Race 3	NULOOK ALUMINIUM MDN (1100M)
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OCEANA LAD (C Grylls) – Awkwardly away.

SHIPSHAPE (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

R Hannam (REGAL REWARD) – Was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

SHANGHAI EXPRESS (L Allpress) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

Race 4	STELLA ARTOIS MDN (1200M)
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BARNEY RUBBLE (S Collett) – Slow away.

ALL THAT JAZZ (J Parkes) – Over reacted and got its head in the air when being restrained approaching the 900 metres. Held up for a distance near the 600 metres.

VISTOCK (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 5	SMOKEYLEMON MDN 3YO (1400M)
<p>Trainers R James & R Wellwood were issued with a warning under Rule 537(a) after not declaring riders for EROS and LYN'S ORCHID by the required time.</p> <p>LYN'S ORCHID (R Elliot) – Slow away.</p> <p>C Grylls (OUR CREED) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift in near the 1200 metres when not fully clear of STREAK OF POWER which was inconvenienced.</p> <p>STREAK OF POWER (M Singh) – Inconvenienced 1200 metres shifting out bumping GOLD BRACELET then raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>GOLD BRACELET (L Allpress) – Bumped 1200 metres.</p> <p>EROS (S McKay) – Restrained off heels passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>ALL IN CHILLY (Z Moki) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>SMARTY PANTS (S Weatherley) – Disappointed for a run to the inside of OUR CREED approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>DUNDRUM (S Collett) – Restrained off heels going into the first turn making the bend awkwardly. Held up rounding the final turn having to be restrained approaching the 250 metres before being angled outwards across heels to improve inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p>POROTENE CHARM (C Burdan) – Raced greenly throughout with a tendency to lay inwards.</p>	
Race 6	LANDMARK HOMES MDN 1 (1400M)
<p>SCOMADI (S McKay) – Awkwardly away.</p> <p>DEE KEEPA (S Collett) – Slow away. Held up rounding the final turn gaining clear running approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>KORBEL (R Elliott) – Restrained from a wide draw.</p> <p>DALMATIA (J Riddell) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight. Contacted 100 metres.</p> <p>BLUE ARROW (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When being restrained off heels near the 800 metres shifted outwards then raced three wide without cover for the remainder. Steadied over the final stages when JENEVER (K Asano) shifted in under pressure. K Asano was advised to exercise greater care than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>J Parkes (SCHERZO) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift inwards approaching the 100 metres inconveniencing MIDNIGHT SPARK which become awkwardly placed on its heels, being taken inwards contacting the hind quarters of DALMATIA which turned out.</p> <p>MIDNIGHT SPARK (C Burdan) – Inconvenienced 100 metres.</p>	
Race 7	SLOTS AVAILABLE FOR \$101,000 FEB 1ST MDN (1600M)
<p>SAIGON HOT NIGHT (Z Moki) – Began awkwardly bumping WHITE HIBISCUS. Raced ungenerously in the middle stages. Disappointed for a run passing the 200 metres.</p>	

CAPTION (H Andrew) – Slow away. Ran up on to the heels of MONGOLIAN DYNASTY approaching the 200 metres going to the finish not fully tested. Lost both front pates during the running.

NOT USUAL GLORIOUS (S Weatherley) – Held up rounding the final turn and again approaching 200 metres.

ADMIRE (L Allpress) – Raced ungenerously for a distance crossing the junction on to the course. Lay in over the final stages.

WHITE HIBISCUS (C Grylls) – Lay in under pressure over the final stages.

Race 8

RACING DEC 27TH & 29TH (1800M)

BRAHMARAHMA Underwent a veterinary inspection prior to the race after the rider felt something was amiss arriving at the start and was late scratched on Veterinary advice. Connections were advised that a Veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing next.

REGAL ROCK (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

MISTER GERONIMO (C Burdan) – Raced wide in the early stages so was ridden forward to lead near the 1700 metres.

CALL DOUBT (T Taiaroa) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DECLARADA (J Riddell) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may appreciate some easing of the track conditions.

INTO THE DEEP (J Parkes) – Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres. When questioned into performance rider advised he felt something may be amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be lame in both front forelegs. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to next racing.
