Race 1	RANGIORA NEW WORLD MAIDEN (1200m)	ĺ
LADY CAMORRA	(R Mudhoo) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with QWERTY which was bumped inwards making	ĺ

solid contact with JACK BE QUICK.

QWERTY (K Williams) – Hampered when buffeted between runners leaving the barriers, had to be severely restrained when improving quickly onto heels when making the junction by the 600 metres.

JACK BE QUICK (T Comignaghi) – Unbalanced when contacted leaving the barriers, crowded and had to be steadied passing the 50 metres.

K Chowdhoory (ALONZO) was issued with a warning when allowing his mount to shift in passing the 50 metres crowding JACK BE QUICK which had to be steadied. Also contributing to this incident was some outward movement from MONTREUX MISS.

NYMPHADORA TONKS (C Campbell) – Restrained early to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

ALONZO (K Chowdhoory) – Raced wide throughout.

NORMA JEAN (T Moseley) – When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had been held up for clear racing room crossing the junction and when clear racing became available had been disappointing and may not have let down on today's firm track conditions.

The track was upgraded to Good (2) following this race.

Race 2 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN (1200m)

QUINTUPLE TWINS (C Johnson) – Lost the tongue tie at the barriers which could not be replaced prior to the start, steadied when crowded shortly after leaving the barriers, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, hampered near the 1000 metres.

COINTREAU (R Mudhoo) – Very slow to begin losing considerable ground. Trainer M McCann was advised that the filly would be placed on a barrier manners warning. Mr McCann advised he would return COINTREAU to the barriers prior to racing next.

SHOCK PROSPECT (K Williams) – Blundered when jumping away losing ground.

CADMAN (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly then knuckled.

QUELLA RAGAZZA (D Prastiyou) – Crowded and checked near the 1100 metres, QUELLA RAGAZZA then commenced to over race and shifted outwards hampering QUINTUPLE TWINS near the 1000 metres.

K Chowdhoory (CADMAN) defended a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of QUELLA RAGAZZA which was checked near the 1100 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the charge and suspended Mr Chowdhoory's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on Tuesday 17 December up to and including Friday 27 December.

SLIGO (BB Hong) – Shifted ground outwards early in the run home.

HEAPZAHOPE (T Moseley) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 300 metres inconveniencing MY EXCUSE.

BB Hong (SLIGO) was spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

ZURAFAA (L Callaway) – When asked for a comment on today's performance rider advised that in his opinion the gelding needs more distance with tracks with more moisture.

Race 3 ROYAL ASCOT WITH GEORGE & WHEELS MAIDEN (1600m)

MISTRESS QUICKLY - Trainer **N Ridley** was issued with a warning for presenting his mount to race without notified side winkers.

SERGEANT PEPPER (R Beeharry) – Jumped away awkwardly.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing some ground.

ALL ABOUT ROY (L Callaway) – Over raced through the early stages due to the lack of tempo.

MISTRESS QUICKLY (K Kwo) – Over raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

Y Chew (WALK WITH KINGS) was issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in passing the 1300 metres when not fully clear crowding SUCCOSO SEGRETO which had to be restrained.

WALK WITH KINGS (Y Chew) – Raced three wide without cover, over raced when being steadied away from heels and shifted out abruptly passing the 1200 metres forcing JIMINY CRICKET wider on the track, again shifted out when over racing passing the 1000 metres hampering BROTHER WILL, gave ground passing the 400 metres.

BROTHER WILL (S Toolooa) – Raced four wide without cover, hampered passing the 1000 metres.

S Toolooa (BROTHER WILL) was issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when struck with the whip rounding the final turn near the 400 metres crowding TOO FERLAXED. Stewards took into account the contributing movement from inside runners.

TOO FERLAXED (K Chowdhoory) – Crowded and placed in restricted room passing the 400 metres and taken inwards onto BI YING.

BI YING (C Campbell) – Crowded and buffeted passing the 400 metres then being held up for a distance and was not persevered with from the 250 metres. C Campbell advised that the mare had been a beaten runner entering the final straight.

TANTALEE (R Mudhoo) – Had to be firmly restrained when improving onto heels near the 300 metres and continued to be held up until passing the 150 metres.

GRAND EXPRESS (D Prastiyou) – Lay out making contact with SABOTEUR which was shifting inwards near the 50 metres. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

SABOTEUR (J Laking) – Made contact with GRAND EXPRESS near the 50 metres.

C Johnson (STAR WARS PRINCESS) was spoken to regarding his lack of vigour over the concluding stages and after considering evidence was issued with a warning under Rule 636(1)(d) and advised he must ensure he rides his mount out fully to the finish.

Race 4 SWIMSENSE SWIMMINGLY FUN RUN RATING 72 (1400m)

STELLA DAZE (K Asano) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with the hind quarters of PINUP COUP and losing ground, made contact with LAKE CHALICE when attempting a marginal run to the outside of PINUP COUP which then shifted outwards passing the 200 metres.

PINUP COUP (K Chowdhoory) – Contacted leaving the barriers.

LAKE CHALICE (T Comignaghi) – Unbalanced when contacted passing the 200 metres.

Race 5 REMEMBERING ERROL SKELTON OPEN HANDICAP (1800m)

SHEZATOUCHA (T Comignaghi) – Held up early in the final straight.

MONZA CIRCUITO (R Mudhoo) – Rider reported that in his opinion the mare did not handle the step up in distance today.

Race 6 ULTIMATE DESIGN & RENOVATION MAIDEN (1600m)

MR FAHRENHEIT (T Moseley) – Jumped away awkwardly then having to be steadied when placed near heels.

BOGATYR (J Lowry) – Bounded at the start, over raced passing the 1400 metres getting its head up.

OCEANS AWAY (K Chowdhoory) – Hampered and forced inwards near the 1100 metres.

GRAB THE BAR (K Asano) – Had to be steadied near the 1100 metres. Underwent a post race veterinary inspection including an endoscopy after returning to the birdcage with blood present in the left nostril and was found not to have bled and most likely suffering external trauma in the barriers.

ATAAHUALUVTHEDREAM (L Callaway) – Raced three wide without cover.

L Callaway (ATAAHUALUVTHEDREAM) was issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards making contact with OCEANS AWAY which was forced inwards into the line of GRAB THE BAR which had to be steadied near the 1100 metres.

TAKE THE DEEL (J Laking) – Inclined to lay in throughout the run home and became awkwardly placed on heels of OCEANS AWAY passing the 50 metres and had to be steadied.

VIVACE LADY (T Comignaghi) – Underwent a post race veterinary inspection including an endoscopy after returning to the birdcage with blood present in the right nostril and was found not to have bled and most likely suffering external trauma in the barriers.

Race 7 DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS RATING 72 (1800m)

PREDICTION (R Mudhoo) – Got its head up when being steadied to take cover shortly after the start.

POP 'N' ROCK (K Williams) – Shifted outwards making contact with MISS DIORELLA near the 250 metres.

MISS DIORELLA (T Moseley) – Contacted near the 250 metres.

PICKUP (C Campbell) – Held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until the final 150 metres.

SELFIE (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised in his opinion the gelding had not seen out the distance of today's race and would appreciate tracks with more moisture in them.

Race 8 JOHN WHITE BLOODSTOCK OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)

ENZO'S LAD (K Chowdhoory) – Slow to begin.

DON CARLO (K Williams) – Lay out rounding the final turn.

T Comignaghi (PIPPI REA) was spoken to regarding her whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 PLACEMAKERS FRAME & TRUSS RATING 65 (1200m)

K Chowdhoory (DEVINE LOVE) was spoken to after being unable to claim down to his declared riding weight, with his explanation accepted on this occasion.

DEVINE LOVE (K Chowdhoory) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding SEDUTTORE, raced wide without cover throughout, bumped with ADMIRAL ROUS passing the 200 metres when both runners shifted ground becoming momentarily unbalanced.

SEDUTTORE (R Mudhoo) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

WHERE ANGELS WALK (C Campbell) – Shifted out on jumping crowding MISS CURIOUS. When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer C Spittles was at a loss to explain the turnaround in form however did advise that the mare had been aided by a very economical ride.

MISS CURIOUS (C Johnson) – Crowded at the start.

ADMIRAL ROUS (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages, bumped and momentarily unbalanced passing the 200 metres.

SUPERSTATIC (T Comignaghi) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the run home and went to the line not fully tested by its rider. Rider advised that the mare would appreciate tracks with more moisture.

K Chowdhoory (DIVINE LOVE) was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after admitting a charge in that he

changed his boots after weighing out.

Race 10 FASTTRACK INSURANCE ADDED STAKES RATING 65 (1600m)

PRODUCER (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, got its head up and raced ungenerously passing the 1400 metres, held up near the 400 metres and continued to have difficulty finding clear racing room for the remainder of the straight.

IFFIDA (S Toolooa) – Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up losing ground.

EPAE ROAD (Z Bholah) – Bumped shortly after the start.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover.

FEROCIOUS (R Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover.

SCOOBY (K Chowdhoory) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, made contact with FINE AND DANDEE passing the 400 metres.

FINE AND DANDEE (D Prastiyou) – Contacted passing the 400 metres.

D Prastiyou (FINE AND DANDEE) was observed to have relaxed his ride over the concluding stages and on return to the mounting yard was found to have dislocated his right shoulder. D Prastiyou was attended to by St John Ambulance personnel and transferred to Christchurch Hospital for treatment, with a medical clearance required prior to racing next.
