Race 1	LANDMARK HOMES/NOEL EALES MEMORIAL (1400 Metres)			
SHE'S NOT BAD (R Myers) – Slow away.				
HYPNOS (V Colgan) – Slow away.				
SATU LAGI (L Allpress) – Shifted in shortly after the start, contacting HONNEUR NOIR.				

HONNEUR NOIR (L Hemi) – Contacted start. Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned into

performance rider advised the mare may prefer some easing of the track conditions.

Race 2 BROKERWEB RISK SERVICES 1200 (1200 Metres)

MR UNIVERSE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly, making contact with the hind quarters of ROCK 'N' AFFAIR. Held up early in the home straight, having to be angled across heels to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres. Lay inwards over the final stages having to be straightened.

ROCK 'N' AFFAIR (L Allpress) – Bumped start.

STRADIVARIUS (L Heemi) - Held up for a short distance early in the home straight.

R Hannam (ISLAND BAY) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regard to his whip use in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3 MCDONALDS MANAWATU 1200 (1200 Metres)

FIANO (H Andrew) – Underwent and passed pre-race veterinary inspection after rearing over prior to the start. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the mare's barriers manners.

OZIL (J Parkes) - Slow away. Held up near the 500 metres, continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight before being angled inwards to improve approaching the 100 metres.

AMANO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and was slow into stride. Ran up on to heels having to be steadied approaching the 100 metres, going to the finish not fully tested.

YES BOY (R Myers) - Steadied near the 1000 metres when CLASSY LANE crossed and was eased, and when being restrained shifted out tightening TARABEEBEE and inconveniencing WONDER NO MORE. After questioning riders, Stewards took into account the racing manners of YES BOY when assessing the interference. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding may appreciate some easing of the track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection, which was clear.

TARABEEBEE (B Ansell) – Tightened 1000 metres. Lay inwards early in the home straight becoming awkwardly placed and clipping the heels of FIANO and blundering.

WONDER NO MORE (M Singh) - Inconvenienced 1000 metres, then raced wide without cover for the remainder. Lay in under pressure early in the home straight having to be straightened.

CHALLA (V Colgan) – Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained near the 800 metres. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

CLASSY LANE (L Hemi) - Restrained off heels near the 200 metres.

Race 4 DUNSTAN FEEDS/STAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER 2200 (2200 Metres)

ALL IN STITCHES (M Singh) – Tightened at the start when ROSCHANA jumped inwards dictating FATTORE OTTO. Raced keenly when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

ROSCHANA (L Hemi) – Jumped inwards at the start.

FATTORE OTTO (R Hannam) – Dictated start.

SO IT WAS (M Hudson) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SPEED CALL (R Goldsbury) - Restrained from a wide draw. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

ROCK WITH CHOUX (B Ansell) - Raced three wide without cover before improving to sit outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

HE NO OPILIO (H Andrew) - Hung outwards in the home straight.

PRINCE TURBO (V Colgan) - Held up rounding the turn. Lay inwards early in the home straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ALL IN STITCHES near the 200 metres, having to be straightened.

VERMONT (L Allpress) – When questioned into performance rider noted the mare had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 5 CENTRAL HOUSE MOVERS HANDICAP (2000 Metres)

BEAUDEN (R Elliot) - Blundered badly at the start almost dislodging the rider. Restrained off heels near the 1200 metres.

JACKSSTAR (M Singh) - Restrained off heels near the 1800 metres then raced keenly through the middle stages. Badly checked 350 metres.

BRONSTEEL (R Goldsbury) – Held up rounding the turn. Angled wide in home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

R Kozaki (POLZEATH) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift out early in the home straight when not clear of JACKSSTAR, which was checked. After hearing submissions the JCA suspended the licence of R Kozaki from the close of racing on Wednesday, 18 December up to and including racing on Sunday, 29 December (8 days).

R Goldsbury (BRONSTEEL) –A charge under Rule 636(1)(b) of failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures to finish in the best possible placing was adjourned at the request of R Goldsbury, to be heard prior to racing at Awapuni on Saturday, 21 December.

Race 6 HIMATANGI TRANSPORT LTD 1600 (1600 Metres)

ABBEY ROAD (M Hudson) – Reared as the start was made, losing ground.

HOCICO BLANCO (R Elliot) – Slow away.

LINCOLN STAR (V Colgan) - Raced three wide without cover.

PLATINUM WILD CARD (R Hannam) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Held up rounding the turn.

Race 7 LAWNMASTER EULOGY STAKES (Group III) (1600 Metres)

The start of Race 7 was delayed approximately 10 minutes while **BELLE PLAISIR** and **SHOWBEEL** were removed from their respective barriers and underwent pre-race veterinary inspections after becoming fractious with both runners being cleared to start. SHOWBEEL required farrier attention, with the right hind plate being unable to be replaced due to the filly's tendency to kick out. All runners were removed from the barrier while veterinary attention was given to both runners.

BELLE PLAISIR (J Parkes) - Slow away. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear. Connections undertook to monitor the filly's progress over coming days and report any anomaly to the stewards

SHOWBEEL (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced without right hind plate.

AALAALUNE (R Elliot) - When questioned, rider advised the filly arrived behind the barrier in a fresh state and was further disadvantaged by the delayed start.

Race 8 CAPTURE SIGNS/DUNSTAN FEEDS 1500 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER (1500 Metres)

REAL BEACH (T Allan) – Was a late scratching at 4.38pm after failing to load. Connections were advised that REAL BEACH must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to starting next.

COTTONEVA (J Kam) – Tightened at start when THE BUZZ began awkwardly, losing ground.

THE BUZZ (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly. Restrained off heels near the 1200 metres.

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (M Singh) – Began awkwardly.

ARIDITY (L Hemi) -Held up rounding the final turn and for a short distance entering the home straight then raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

SKARLOEY (J Parkes) – Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

GERDA (R Myers) – When questioned into performance rider advised the mare may appreciate a further distance and some easing of the track.
