Race 1 Ezgo/Platinum Rentals 1400

SPARKLING LADY (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

SANTORI (J Fawcett) – Raced ungenerously passing the 1200 metres when being steadied away from the heels of ALWAYS SACRED. Shifted out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

VOLITIVO (T Thornton) – Held up until approaching the 200 metres.

Race 2 Edwards Sound 1200

THREE SIXTY (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room passing the 600 metres to the inside of DESHI which was crowded by CASH ME OUSSIDE which lay in, making contact despite the efforts of its rider. Shifted in making contact passing the 50 metres and then lay in abruptly before being corrected by its rider.

EGO FAST (M Hashizume) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1000 metres to the inside of DESHI which was taken in slightly by SHAM ON TOAST.

DESHI (T Yanagida) – Raced ungenerously approaching the 800 metres when being restrained away from heels.

CASH ME OUSSIDE (D Danis) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

PATCH PRINCE (S Spratt) – Shifted out under pressure from near the 100 metres making contact with the hind quarters of THREE SIXTY (D Johnson) near the 50 metres which then lay in as a result, further crowding PATCH PRINCE which was checked. Riders S Spratt and D Johnson were shown footage of the incident and advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of PATCH PRINCE and THREE SIXTY at the time.

Race 3 Dunstan Feeds 1500 Championship Qualifier 1200

BIT LIPPY (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

HARLOW (L Innes) – Slow to begin. The rider reported that the filly had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

MUSSOLINI (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight but then was eased down by its rider inside the final 150 metres with V Colgan advising that the gelding had felt indifferent. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer J Surgenor reported that she intends to trial the gelding prior to racing next.

SHE'S A SMASH HIT (C Burdan) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Forced wider 600 metres.

LOOKSEASY (J Waddell) – Shifted out to avoid heels approaching the 600 metres forcing SHE'S A SMASH HIT wider on the track. Lost the off hind plate during the running.

MADAM HASS (R Elliot) – Held up until shifting outwards approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 4 DDB 1600

MISS TAVI (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

DAWON (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOT USUAL HEAVEN (D Johnson) – Restrained from a wide barrier. Raced ungenerously through the middle stages.

MATTER OF FACT (S Weatherley) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

GORGEOUS IN GOLD (E McCall) – Steadied away from heels passing the 1300 metres when in restricted room to the inside of MEGHAN (L Innes) which was dictated in slightly by STRATIUS (J Waddell) which was immediately corrected by its rider. Riders L Innes and J Waddell were advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

STRATIUS (J Waddell) – Steadied when crowded over the concluding stages by MEGHAN (L Innes) which shifted in under pressure. L Innes was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

FORREST RED (R Elliot) – Underwent a veterinary examination after the rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent which could find no abnormality.

Race 5 Celebrating Dylan & Nitisha's Engagement 1400

MIGHT (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly and shifted in crowding HEART OF THE OCEAN, AMUSEZ MOI and SUPER STRIKE. Raced ungenerously throughout, laying out when making the bend. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground appreciably in the final straight which could find no abnormality.

HEART OF THE OCEAN (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

AMUSEZ MOI (J Waddell) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SUPER STRIKE (A Calder) – Contacted shortly after the start becoming unbalanced.

SACROSANCT (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

KAIPAKI ROAD (L Innes) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

DIAMONDS GALORE (J Riddell) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight before shifting in approaching the 200 metres.

BLACKROCKSDETOX (V Colgan) – Eased down from near the 400 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and after undergoing a veterinary examination was declared a bleeder. BLACKROCKSDETOX is now required to have a 2 month stand down from track work and a 3 month stand down from racing with a veterinary clearance required prior to trialling or racing next.

Race 6 Dunstan Feeds 1500 Championship Qualifier 1300

SATRIANI (R Scott) - Slow to begin.

RUBY LOVE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced 150 metres when weakening.

TUSCAN WHISTLER (L Innes) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance, Rider L Innes advised that the gelding had been unable to quicken on a slow tempo.

MOLTO VELOCE (D Johnson) – Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the inside of PULLYOURSOCKSUP which shifted in under pressure.

STYLISH SUGGESTION (C Grylls) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out approaching the 150 metres inconveniencing RUBY LOVE which was weakening. C Grylls was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

Race 7 Hynds 3YO Salver (2100 metres)

BORDER LEICESTER (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded when weakening 300 metres.

RENDITION (L Innes) – Hampered when leaving the barriers.

CELESTIAL NYMPH (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

PLUCKY MISS (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. Severely hampered 500 metres and forced wide and losing ground.

SCORPZ (J Waddell) – Restrained from a wide barrier and then raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Raced wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

MONGOLIAN HEAVEN (J Riddell) – Went off stride passing the 500 metres and was quickly pulled up by its rider. Hampered as a result were CELESTIAL NYMPH and PLUCKY MISS which was forced wide on the track. MONGOLIAN HEAVEN was immediately attended to by the Veterinarian and the horse ambulance was deployed, with the colt being humanely euthanised after being found to have fractured its left shoulder.

BERGAMOT (D Johnson) – Improved in to a marginal run passing the 400 metres to the inside of LOCHWINNOCH which then raced in restricted room for a short distance. Contributing was SCORPZ which was racing tight to the outside of LOCHWINNOCH.

LOCHWINNOCH (T Thornton) - Crowded 400 metres for a short distance. Further crowded passing the 300 metres.

PELOTON (S Spratt) – Crowded near the 300 metres and steadied when in restricted room. PELOTON then shifted out abruptly when placed under pressure.

J Waddell (SCORPZ) – Issued with a warning after permitting SCORPZ to shift in approaching the 300 metres with LOCHWINNOCH shifting away from that runner crowding BERGAMOT on to PELOTON which was crowded and steadied.

V Colgan (TIBETAN) – Issued with a warning for using the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 Dunstan Feeds 1500 Championship Qualifier 1600

TRIOMPHE (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

EXPRESS CALL (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

SOCIALIGHTS (S Spratt) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Steadied when awkwardly placed approaching the 450 metres. Lost the near hind plate near the 350 metres.

DAM RELIABLE (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1200 metres shifting out to avoid heels.

RIP EM UP (J Waddell) – Steadied 1100 metres to avoid heels.

APELLIDO (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. Held up until approaching the 250 metres.

HOLY LOCH (A Calder) – Held up until approaching the 200 metres.
