Apprentice rider M Hashizume was questioned regarding his riding tactics as to why he had elected to restrain HOLY LOCH to the rear of the field after beginning well, and why when in last position he had not attempted to maintain contact with the body of the field when there was an opportunity to do so. M Hashizume explained that his riding instructions had been to obtain cover and after beginning well he did not want to get caught wide and had elected to restrain the horse in an attempt to find cover, further explaining that he had been caught wide without cover in an earlier race when riding forward. M Hashizume went on to explain that after restraining to the rear of the field he had realized that he had not put his goggles on and was having difficulty seeing. M Hashizume's explanation was noted by Stewards and he was referred to Riding Master, N Harris, for further tuition.

Race 1	APPARELMASTER WAIKATO 1200
<p>ONE KOTUKUSTREET (M Hashizume) – Knuckled soon after leaving the barrier. Dictated wider final 150 metres.</p> <p>NABIAC (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and steadied off heels shortly after losing ground.</p> <p>HAMMER KING (T Yanagida) - Held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>NEW YORK JAZZ (J Waddell) - Shifted out under pressure from near the 150 metres inconveniencing ONE KOTUKUSTREET and APPELLANT which were dictated wider on the track. J Waddell was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>APPELLANT (D Johnson) - Dictated wider final 150 metres.</p>

<p>ANNIE'S SONG (C Lammas) – Slow away.</p> <p>CHECKERS (O Bosson) – Restrained away from heels approaching the 1100 metres. Briefly held up having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>C Grylls (LOVE STRUCK) – Issued with a warning after permitting LOVE STRUCK to shift in near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of CHECKERS which had to be restrained losing ground.</p> <p>OSAKA (J Waddell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 3	THE SPRAY RIG 1400
<p>TE AKAU CALIBURN (J Kamaruddin) – Slow to begin. After being slow away was ridden forward and then commenced to over-race when being restrained off heels passing the 1150 metres.</p> <p>MONEY TRAIL (M Hashizume) – Slow to begin. Crowded and steadied 1200 metres. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight, and shifted out passing the 75 metres to avoid heels.</p> <p>T Thornton (STACEY ANN) – Advised to exercise care in that she shifted in when not fully clear of DRAGON LIPS which had to be steadied near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>DRAGON LIPS (C Dell) – Slow away and then ridden forward, and then steadied for a distance when placed in restricted room to the inside of BYZANTINE (O Bosson) which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1000 metres. O Bosson was issued with a warning. DRAGON LIPS continued to over-race until near the 800 metres.</p> <p>BRUEGEL (S Spratt) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1150 metres shifting out, and then was obliged to race three wide for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>SWISSWATCH (T Yanagida) – Made contact with the running rail on two occasions becoming unbalanced passing the 75 metres and losing ground.</p> <p>STACEY ANN (T Thornton) – Held up for clear running early in the final straight.</p>

<p>THREE SIXTY (R Elliot) – Slow to begin (5L).</p>	

THE DOM (C Lammas) – Restrained leaving the barrier.	
POPOVA (T Thornton) – Restrained leaving the barrier.	
RIPPED (O Bosson) – Restrained leaving the barrier.	
VINO BELLA (D Johnson) – Made contact with SHIPSHAPE when attempting a marginal run passing the 400 metres.	
LOOKS LIKE (J Riddell) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.	
Race 5	JOSH SMITH @ BAYLEYS 1600
INSCRIPTION (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.	
WOODSMAN (M Kareem) – Began awkwardly.	
BLUE BREEZE (J Kamaruddin) – Dipped when leading on to the course proper near the 1400 metres.	
SCORPZ (D Johnson) – Was held up until shifting in across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.	
Race 6	RACING TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB 1600
SAGUNTO – Trainer P McKay replaced the declared rider J Waddell with S Collett as J Waddell was 0.5 kg over the gelding's handicapped weight.	
AMAZING AZ (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly then further crowded losing ground.	
JIP JIP ROCK (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.	
INCANTESIMO (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
CIVILISED (T Yanagida) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.	
LUCKY SWEEP (T Thornton) – Crowded near the 400 metres when SUNBURST (M Coleman) shifted out to attempt a marginal run to the inside of LUCKY SWEEP and contributing was inward movement from JIP JIP ROCK. SHEZATHINKA had to be steadied off the heels of LUCKY SWEEP. After questioning riders concerned it was felt there were contributing factors with rider M Coleman being issued with a warning.	
SHEZATHINKA (J Kamaruddin) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres. Held up early in the final straight shifting out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.	
Race 7	COUNTIES FUNCTION CENTRE 2200
JOE'S LEGACY (L Innes) – Began awkwardly shifting in.	
MONGOLIANCONQUEROR (J Kamaruddin) – Slow away. Commenced to over-race making the bend leaving the straight awkwardly.	
PAISLEY PARK (J Waddell) – Unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.	
SCAGLIONI (M Hashizume) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.	
LEADERBOARD (D Johnson) – When questioned into the performance of LEADERBOARD rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

<p>M Cameron (AMBITIOUS SHOWGIRL) – Admitted a breach under Rule 330(3)(c) in that he was unable to make the handicapped weight and was fined the sum of \$100.</p> <p>MOTUMAN (D Danis) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>UABASSO (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>LADY AZAMOUR (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>KISSINGER (L Innes) – Restrained from a wide barrier.</p> <p>CELESTIAL NYMPH (C Grylls) – Restrained from a wide barrier. Raced wide without cover.</p>
