#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

#### Race 1 MACALEA 2200 (2200 Metres)

**RUSALKA** (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground then commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained and was allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 1600 metres.

**ANNALONE** (T Yanagida) - Inconvenienced approaching the 500 metres.

**READY TO ROAR** (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider R Myers could offer no tangible excuses.

#### Race 2 PROFRUIT NEW ZEALAND 1400 (1400 Metres)

**RUSTY IN RONGOTEA** (D Turner) – After arriving at the start RUSTYT IN RONGOTEA was declared a late scratching at 1.27pm on veterinary advice after the mare was found to be grade 1/5 lame in the right foreleg.

**DUNDRUM** (R Myers) - Slow to begin.

**VROOM** (H Andrew) - Restrained from a wide barrier. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**IPATCH** (T Yanagida) - Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 800 metres.

**LANDRY** (D Johnson) - Raced greenly in the final straight shifting out making contact with TARGARIAN near the 100 metres.

#### Race 3 ISAAC'S PLUMBING, PUMPING & ELECTRICAL 3YO (1200 Metres)

**PAS DE GEANT** (T Yanagida) - Commenced racing ungenerously soon after leaving the barriers when being restrained. Restrained away from the heels of MAGIC MONKEY (R Myers) which shifted out passing the 900 metres. Rider R Myers was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

L Allpress (BELLESGIRL) - Issued with a warning for using her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

### Race 4 TUMU TIMBERS 1200 (1200 Metres)

**BABY SHARK** (M McNab) - Slow to begin (4L). Connections were advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.

**HOT SPRING PROJECT** (L Innes) - Shifted out passing the 600 metres making contact with PACKING ROCKSTAR which became briefly unbalanced. L Innes was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance and was further reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mount out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

PACKING ROCKSTAR (T Harris) - Contacted and briefly unbalanced 600 metres.

**SO GOLD** (L Allpress) - Became awkwardly placed approaching the 300 metres when laying in across the heels of ENDURING LOVE which shifted out slightly under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

**ENDURING LOVE** (R Myers) - Shifted out under pressure in the final straight.

#### Race 5 BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND 2000 (2000 Metres)

HANK MOODY (T Yanagida) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.

**VANNOSS** (S Collett) - Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied. When questioned regarding performance Rider S Collett could offer no excuse.

**ROYAL RUBY** (J Fawcett) - Shifted out under pressure in the final straight making brief contact with RIP EM UP over the final stages.

**RIP EM UP** (R Myers) - Briefly contacted when laying in over the final stages.

**FLOURISHING** (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

#### Race 6 WAIMEA NURSERIES 1300 (1300 Metres)

**RED JAKKAL** (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded and steadied 500 metres between SERENA (S Collett) and DAWN JESSIE (T Newman). S Collett and T Newman were both advised to exercise care. Crowded and steadied passing the 200 metres.

**T Newman** (DAWN JESSIE) - Issued with a warning after allowing DAWN JESSIE to shift in approaching the 200 metres when insufficiently clear of RED JAKKAL which was crowded and steadied.

YOSSARIAN (D Turner) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**DAWN JESSIE** (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**COPIAPINO** (L Allpress) - A post-race veterinary examination found the filly to have suffered from tachycardia and cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer S Ritchie was advised that an appropriate veterinary clearance would be required prior to COPIAPINO racing next.

### Race 7 ORORA KIWI PACKAGING MILE (1600 Metres)

MISS WRIGLEY (J Bassett) - Raced wide without cover.

# Race 8 EVERFRESH TRANSPORT MILE (1600 Metres)

IAGO (T Harris) - Began awkwardly. Held up until near the 300 metres.

CARIBBEAN ROSE (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

J Riddell (FRANKLIN) - Was reminded of his obligations regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.
