GRAND MAYSON (S Collett) – Co-trainer J Benner advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of gelding and at this stage will likely go to the Foxton trials on Tuesday 11 February before racing again.

Race 4 Karaka Million 2YO (1200 metres)

HASSTOBEMAGIC (D Johnson) – Co-trainer R Wellwood advised that, although satisfied with the post-race condition of HASSTOBEMAGIC, a decision on the filly's current preparation will be made next week.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 COCA COLA 1400 (1400 Metres)

IRISH FLAME (T Harris) – Blundered at the start and got back.

SIR NATE (J Riddell) – Was held up for some distance in the early part of the home straight prior to being angled outwards near the 150 metres in order to improve.

STACEY ANN (S Collett) – Had to be steadied near the 100 metres mark when TAVI MAC shifted out simultaneously as CYBER ATTACK shifted in.

CYBER ATTACK (M McNab) – Shifted in near 100 metres. M McNab advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

TAVI MAC (M Hudson) – Over raced in early and middle stages and had to be continuously steadied for some distance. Shifted out near 100 metres. M Hudson advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

Ryan Elliott (ELATE) – Advised connections on race morning that he would be 0.5kg over the carded weight and was replaced by D Johnson.

Race 2 THRIFTY CAR RENTAL RTG 72 (1600 Metres)

CREATIVE GENIUS (T Harris) – Was late scratched at 12.58pm behind the barrier on veterinary advice.

ARIDITY (R Myers) – Slow away. Was held up for a short distance early in the home straight. Bumped with HOIST in the home straight.

HOIST (L Innes) – Was held up early in the home straight and bumped with ARIDITY for a short distance, gaining clear running over the final stages.

REMARX (M McNab) – Raced wide in the back straight prior to being taken forward near the 800 metres.

OUR HAIL MARY (C O'Beirne) – Improved on to heels near the 150 metres prior to being angled inwards to improve.

Race 3 ENERGY VETS TARANAKI 1200 RTG 72 (1200 Metres)

COVENTINA BAY (S Collett) – Slow away.

SUGAR RUSH (T Taiaroa) – Improved rapidly on to heels near the 700 metres and had to be steadied.

POKURU'S GIFT (O Bosson) – When questioned into the disappointing run of POKURU'S GIFT O Bosson had no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4 WOBURN FARM CLASSIC 2YO (1200 Metres)

PIAGGIO (L Allpress) – Contacted and forced wider passing the 1100 metres. Was then obliged to race three wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

BOOMER HILL (M McNab) – Raced greenly throughout and when being steadied near the 1100 metres to allow ALICE TINKER (R Elliott) to cross to the rail, over reacted and shifted out abruptly, bumping with PIAGGIO which was forced wide. Made the home bend awkwardly running wide on the point of the home turn and passing the 200 metres shifted out and away from ALICE TINKER, hampering PERFECT SCENARIO near the 150 metres.

TRIDENT (J Parkes) – Held up early in the home straight.

PERFECT SCENARIO (O Bosson) – Held up early in the final straight. Hampered passing the 150 metres. When

questioned into the run of PERFECT SCENARIO O Bosson advised that although the colt was held up in the early part of the home straight, still failed to finish the race off and was disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 PLATINUM HOMES SC MAIDEN MAAT (1400 Metres)

PIRIWAI (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly and was slow away. Rider D Johnson reported the mare felt indifferent in its action throughout. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

BARNEY RUBBLE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and was slow away. Held up early in the home straight.

BEAUDZ WELL (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DANZ I AM (L Allpress) – Held up early in the home straight.

SON OF BIELSKI (O Bosson) – Shifted in abruptly near the 200 metres and a short distance further had to be steadied when BEAUDZ WELL shifted inwards. After questioning riders M McNab was issued with a warning. When questioned into the run, O Bosson reported the gelding raced greenly throughout.

Race 6 FAST TRACK INSURANCE OAKS PRELUDE 3YOF SW LISTED (1800 Metres)

SEVEN SEAS (R Myers) – Tightened at the start and got back. Shifted in under hard riding in the home straight.

DARCEE QUE (R Elliott) – Had to be steadied going into the first turn when in restricted room.

TUPPENCE (L Innes) – Restrained from a wide draw, got back then commenced to over race badly and going into the back straight had to be steadied off heels abruptly for some distance shifting out hampering DIAMONDS GALORE, which was checked. Raced wide for the remainder. L Innes advised the filly raced greenly throughout and he was of the opinion TUPPENCE may be more tractable with the removal of side winkers.

ALOFT (D Johnson) – Steadied off the heels of HEART OF THE OCEAN shortly after straightening and checked inside the final 50 metres when SEVEN SEAS (R Myers) shifted in when not clear. R Myers subsequently admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Friday 7.2.20 to close of racing on 19.2.20 inclusive. (7 days)

HEART OF THE OCEAN (D Bradley) – Shifted out near the 200 metres dictating ALOFT (D Johnson) out which then shifted out bumping DARCEE QUE and KABU (O Bosson).

BERGAMOT (M McNab) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight, shifted in passing the 50 metres making contact with IN FASHION becoming unbalanced.

AQUILA STAR (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover.

DIAMONDS GALORE (J Riddell) – Was hampered going into the back straight by TUPPENCE and was checked.

KABU (O Bosson) – When questioned into the run of KABU rider could offer no excuse.

Race 7 POWERWORX TARANAKI CUP (G3) (1800 Metres)

SCOTT BASE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly and got back.

PLATINUM INVADOR (L Innes) – Was restrained from its wide draw and got back. Had to be angled wide to improve near the 100 metres.

SERGEANT BLAST (L Allpress) – Was inclined to get its head in the air when over racing in the early stages.

AIM SMART (R Myers) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

OVER THE RIVER (R Elliott) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MASTER PAINTON (C Lammas) – Had to be steadied when in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

HAY TIGER (J Fawcett) – Held up throughout the final straight.

Race 8 DEVON HOTEL 2000 RTG 65 & JUMPS (2000 Metres)

TORQUE TIME (C O'Beirne) – Steadied when on heels near the 600 metres.

ROSCHANA (S Collett) – Slow away then crowded shortly after. When questioned into the disappointing run of ROSCHANA S Collett advised the mare may be better suited to more rain affected going.

RIVER RUN (L Innes) – Held up throughout the home straight and went to the line untested, steadied over the final stages when in restricted room.
