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### SUPPLEMENTARY:

<b><u>Manawatu Racing Club, 14 December 2019, Central House Movers Handicap</u></b>
At a deferred hearing, <b>R Goldsbury</b> (BRONSTEEL), defended a breach of Rule 636(1)(b) in that she failed to take all reasonable and permissible measures to allow her mount, BRONSTEEL, the opportunity to obtain the best possible finishing placing. After hearing submissions the JCA found the charge proved and Miss Goldsbury had her licence to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on Thursday, 2 January up to and including racing on Thursday, 6 February 2020. (5 weeks)

### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MURRAYS IRISH BAR 3YO 1200 (1200 Metres)</b>
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**HAZELSGIRL** (D Turner) - Began awkwardly settling back.

**PAS DE GEANT** (M Singh) - Raced fiercely in the early stages, making contact with LINCOLN'S KRUZ for some distance when being restrained. Steadied into first turn when LINCOLN'S KRUZ which was racing greenly to its inside lay out simultaneously as PRINCESS ANI shifted in. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**LINCOLN'S KRUZ** (L Allpress) – Contacted then raced keenly for a distance approaching the 800 metres. When questioned L Allpress stated that after over-racing and being jostled in the back straight the gelding had little left at the finish.

**KICK START** (H Andrew) - Held up for some distance rounding the home turn.

**PRINCESS ANI** (J Parkes) - Lay in, becoming briefly inconvenienced over the final stages when FLICKERING SHADOW shifted out under pressure.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>POWER FARMING MAIDEN 1400 (1400 Metres)</b>
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**PORT LINCOLN** (Z Moki) - Dislodged the rider during the preliminary but was quickly recaptured, underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start. Rider Z Moki was uninjured and cleared by St John paramedics. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**PARSONS GLORY** (D Turner) - Awkwardly away settling back. When questioned into the run of PARSONS which was having its first start and finished some distance last, D Turner was of the opinion the gelding would be better suited to a wet track. A post-race veterinary examination was clear. Connections were advised the gelding must trial.

**MOZZIE** (M Singh) - Slow away. Got its head in the air when the pace eased near the 1000 metres.

**JESSIE'S ROCK** (H Andrew) - Raced keenly then restrained off heels approaching the 1000 metres.

**DANCING DELIGHT** (R Goldsbury) – Raced in restricted room passing the 800 metres.

**FLYING SURF** (L Hemi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**KHALFANI** (C O'Beirne) - Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Shifted out and away from HA'PENNY BRIDGE which improved quickly to its inside, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of DANCING DELIGHT, having to be steadied near the finish.

**HA'PENNY BRIDGE** (J Parkes) – Steadied off the heels of KHALFANI near the 150 metres then ran up on to the heels of RIO STAR, having to be steadied over the final stages.

**LINCOLN HANOVER** (R Hannam) - When questioned into performance rider could offer no excuse adding the gelding had been disappointing. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**CHOUXFORAPRINCESS** (B Ansell) - Gave ground quickly approaching the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the home straight when well out of contention. Connections will be advised a warning has been placed on the mare's racing manners.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>CELK DEVELOPMENTS LTD 1400 (1400 Metres)</b>
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**THE RIPPA** (R Hannam) - Restrained from a wide draw.

**LA SOEUR** (L Hemi) – Outpaced in the early stages.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MAD BUTCHER 1200 (1400 Metres)</b>
<p><b>HEART OF STONE</b> (L Allpress) – Underwent and passed a veterinary inspection prior to the race after charging its gate.</p> <p><b>SHANPARK</b> (S Macnab) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>COLORADO MISS</b> (T Allan) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>C O’Beirne</b> (DANA’S PROPHECY) – Defended a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) in that she allowed her mount to shift out on the point of the home turn when not fully clear of MEHRTENS (Z Moki) which clipped that runner’s heels, became unbalanced and dislodged rider Z Moki. After hearing all evidence and viewing all available films, the JCA dismissed the charge as they were of the view the available footage was inconclusive.</p> <p><b>T Allan</b> (COLORADO MISS) - Issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively on a runner out of contention.</p> <p><b>MEHRTENS</b> (Z Moki) – Unbalanced, dislodging rider near 350 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed a tendon injury to off foreleg and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next. Z Moki was stood down from her remaining ride and will require a clearance prior to racing next.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>INTER BUILDING LTD HANDICAP (1200 Metres)</b>
<p><b>STRADIVARIUS</b> (J Bassett) - Began awkwardly bumping CASAQUINMAN (D Turner), which settled back. Held up rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>CASAQUINMAN</b> (D Turner) - Bumped at start, settling back.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS AMELIE</b> (R Hannam) - Lay in under pressure having to be straightened approaching the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MANAWATU STANDARD SUMMER CAUP (1550 Metres)</b>
<p><b>ZORRALI</b> - Late scratching at 2.22pm on veterinary advice after the gelding was found to have swelling to a tendon in the off foreleg.</p> <p><b>MONRECOUR</b> (M Singh) - Slow away. Hung outwards rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>MISS CONTESSA</b> (R Hannam) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight having to be steadied.</p> <p><b>THE BANDITO</b> (H Andrew) - When questioned into performance, rider advised the gelding had travelled well into the home straight but after changing legs approaching the 200 metres had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed slight lameness to the off hind possibly caused by a stone bruise. Connections undertook to report the progress of the gelding in the coming days.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>INSPIRE NET 2100 (2100 Metres)</b>
<p><b>HUMBLE PIE</b> – D Hirini replaced Z Moki (injured).</p> <p><b>OBRIGADO</b> (S Macnab) – Slow away. Restrained off heels near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>REGAL ROCK</b> (L Hemi) - Restrained from a wide draw.</p> <p><b>TRENDING</b> (D Turner) - Began awkwardly then tightened when GERDA jumped outwards at the start.</p>	

**LORD TURBO** (M Hudson) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**KAMANDA LINCOLN** (L Allpress) - Went off stride on the crossing near the 1500 metres, getting its head in the air.

**PROLETARIAT** (H Andrew) - Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight, having to be straightened.

**GERDA** (T Taiaroa) - Held up for a distance entering the home straight.

**MYRTLE** (R Goldsbury) –Rider reported that the mare had lost the off hind plate during the running. R Goldsbury was spoken to regarding her whip use on a runner out of contention.

**M Singh** (AKELA BELLE) – Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift out near the 100 metres when not clear of REGAL ROCK (L Hemi) which was checked. After hearing submissions M Singh had his licence to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on Thursday, 2 January up to and including racing on Tuesday, 7 January (5 days).

**Race 8**

**MORE FM MANAWATU 1550 (1550 Metres)**

**ORIGINAL GANGSTER** (R Hannam) – Slow away. Held up rounding the home turn and early in the home straight.

**VELOCE** (L Hemi) - Slow away

**SATIN BELT** (T Taiaroa) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**LA LANDONNE** (H Andrew) - Raced ungenerously for a distance when being restrained near the 800 metres.

**HINEPARA** (D Bradley) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the home straight.

**PLATINUM WILD CARD** (M Singh) - When questioned into performance M Singh had no excuse.

**ROCK WITH CHOUX** (D Hirini) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 100 metres when LA LANDONNE shifted in and away from NUDGE BAR.
