Race 5 - BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND 2000
FLOURISHING (D Johnson) – Co-trainer J Ritchie advised the mare pulled up well and now will be freshened.

Race 2 - THRIFTY CAR RENTAL RTG 72 (1600 Metres)
CREATIVE GENIUS (T Harris) – Trainer S Cole advised Stewards that upon return to the stable the gelding underwent X-rays which could find no abnormalities. S Cole further advised it is his intention to continue on with CREATIVE GENIUS current preparation.

Race 6 - COMAG 1600
PENTEVEREST (T Harris) – Co-trainer K Kelso advised Stewards he is satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding and it is his intention to trial PENTEVEREST in the coming weeks.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 1200
<p>MINNALLINES (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider R Elliot could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>NEW DAWN (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages and lay out.</p> <p>CATWALK GIRL (C Lammas) – Slow away and then was ridden urgently to recover.</p> <p>BACKINTYME (A Goindasamy) – Shifted out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running dictating NITRATE wider on the track. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight, and then shifted out abruptly passing the 100 metres when struck with the whip inconveniencing NITRATE.</p> <p>NITRATE (T Newman) – Inconvenienced 100 metres.</p> <p>Following the race the connections of the third placed horse NITRATE viewed Stewards footage and elected not to proceed with a protest.</p>	
Race 2	LASER PLUMBING TAURANGA CENTRAL 2100
<p>SCAGLIONI (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.</p> <p>OCEAN BILLY (T Harris) – Slow away.</p> <p>HASABRO (S Spratt) – Steadied near the 1100 metres when in restricted room to the inside of OCEAN BILLY (T Harris). T Harris was advised to exercise care.</p>	
Race 3	TALL POPPY TAURANGA SOUTH 1400
<p>CASTLE BLACK (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly. Held up passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>WALK THE LINE (L Satherley) – Slow away.</p> <p>IRIDESSA (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SHOWCAT (A Goindasamy) – Slow away.</p> <p>GLOBAL DIAMOND (R Beemud) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SPRING TIDE (T Harris) – Became awkwardly placed when making the 900 metre bend shifting out off the heels of SHOWCAT (A Goindasamy) which steadied. MAC'S EXPRESS was forced wider as a result. Apprentice Rider A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Shifted out off heels near the 600 metres with MAC'S EXPRESS shifting away from that runner and running wide.</p> <p>MAC'S EXPRESS (M Kareem) – Forced wide 900 metres and raced wide without cover, and ran wider passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>BAD 'N' BOUJ (R Kozaki) – Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight. Shifted out abruptly over the final stages running wide on the track.</p>	

Race 4	LASER PLUMBING OMOKOROA 1600
<p>S & E Clotworthy (BULLY BOY) – Issued with a warning after presented BULLY BOY to the plate inspection without an item of notified gear (nasal strip).</p> <p>SASANOF’S HERO (O Helagi) – Began awkwardly. Improved into restricted room to the inside of CRAFTY JESS passing the 1300 metres when the pace steadied with SASANOF’S HERO then making contact with the running rail and racing ungenerously for a distance. Apprentice rider O Helagi was referred to the National Riding Master, N Harris.</p> <p>CRAFTY JESS (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>PASABAHCE (R Elliot) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Crowded and steadied over the concluding stages.</p> <p>NEESON (A Goindasamy) – Restrained off heels when becoming awkwardly placed passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>DONNA ANNE BILLY (M Kareem) – Raced in restricted room near the 200 metres when weakening.</p> <p>Following the race the connections of the fourth placed horse PASABAHCE lodged a protest against the first placed horse NEESON (A Goindasamy) alleging interference in the final 100 metres. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (NEESON) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards over the concluding stages crowding PASABAHCE which had to be steadied. Contributing was slight inward movement from CRAFTY JESS.</p>	
Race 5	MILLS REEF WINERY 1400
<p>EXCITONIC (O Bosson) – Crowded start. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to quicken once placed under pressure and had been disappointing, adding that it had not felt entirely comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SANTORI (M Coleman) – Crowded and hampered start losing ground.</p> <p>SELENELION (M McNab) – Shifted out to avoid heels approaching the 800 metres when racing keenly.</p> <p>BAHAMAS (S Spratt) – Lay out when making the final bend, and continued to do so when placed under pressure in the final straight. Inconvenienced final stages.</p> <p>LOOKS LIKE (V Colgan) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>ON DEMAND (C Lammas) – Raced greenly under pressure in the final straight shifting out abruptly over the concluding stages inconveniencing BAHAMAS which was forced wider on the track.</p>	
Race 6	LASER PLUMBING TE PUKE 1200
<p>MEMORIES ONLY (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MONACO (R Elliot) – Slow away. Could not obtain clear running in the final straight improving on to heels on several occasions.</p> <p>WILLPOWER (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Improved into restricted room near the 100 metres.</p>	

Race 7	LASER ELECTRICAL TAURANGA 1600
<p>NASHA RIVA (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>STEVEN JAMES (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>AMASECOYA (M McNab) – Slow away.</p> <p>LE SABLIER (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier. Had to steady off heels passing the 500 metres.</p> <p>TOMMYRA (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after rider J Fawcett reported that the gelding had felt indifferent – no obvious abnormality was found.</p> <p>CHECKERS (M Hashizume) – Angled out abruptly entering the final straight to obtain clear running finishing wide on the track.</p> <p>LOWPROFILE (V Colgan) – Raced keenly when leading through the middle stages. Crowded passing the 300 metres to the inside of SUNBURST (M Coleman) which shifted in when placed under pressure. M Coleman was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p>
