Race 1	RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE RATING 82 (1400m)
DREAMING EASY (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin, raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	
MEARA MARY (S Wynne) – Bumped and unbalanced passing the 700 metres when NOWHERE MAN improved into a marginal run.	
J Fawcett (I AM A ROCK) was spoken to advisedly regarding her whip use outside the 100 metres.	
Race 2	PUNTERS CHALLENGE 4 APRIL – ENTER NOW RATING 72 (2000m)
POP 'N' ROCK (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.	
TOO FERLAXED (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner, the rider advised that the mare had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.	
TAKE THE DEEL (R Hannam) – Raced keenly through the early stages.	

PRODUCER (A Balloo) – Made the crossing near the 1850 metres awkwardly.

S Wynne (POP 'N' ROCK) was issued with a warning after striking her mount on seven occasions outside the 100 metres.

Race 3 | **KORU CARE CHARITY DINNER 20 MARCH OPEN HANDICAP (1800m)**

WHO DARES WINS (S Wynne) – Over raced in the early and middle stages due to the lack of tempo, then jostled with PINUP COUP for a distance passing the 700 metres, checked when crowded for room passing the 500 metres.

PINUP COUP (K Chowdhoo) – Jostled with WHO DARES WINS for a distance passing the 700 metres. K Chowdhoo was advised to exercise more care. Buffeted and unbalanced passing the 500 metres.

M Hashizume (OWEN PATRICK) with the assistance of Apprentice Mentor D Walsh admitted a breach of careless riding in that when angling his mount outwards passing the 500 metres he crowded and checked WHO DARES WINS which was taken out onto PINUP COUP which was buffeted and unbalanced. After viewing replays and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended M Hashizume's licence to ride at race meetings for 7 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 15 February up to and including 23 February.

OWEN PATRICK (M Hashizume) – Got its head up when racing keenly through the middle stages, briefly placed in restricted room for a distance passing the 700 metres when SHOWPIN (K Williams) improved forward to lead. K Williams was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

K Chowdhoo (PINUP COUP) was issued with a warning after striking his mount on seven occasions outside the 100 metres.

Race 4 | **SPEIGHT'S RATING 72 (1400m)**

DEVIUS (S Wynne) – Reared high as the start was effected losing ground, raced fiercely for a distance passing the 800 metres and had to be shifted wider on the track to avoid heels and then obliged to race wide for the remainder of the race. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

CLOONEY (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, lay inwards and had to be steadied near the 400 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of this favoured runner the rider could offer no tangible excuse, advising that the gelding had been very disappointing.

FLYTIME (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

QUINTUPLE TWINS (T Comignaghi) – Held up from early in the run home until inside the 250 metres having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear racing room, shifted outwards abruptly passing the 50 metres.

Race 5 | **CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 65 (1200m)**

ALONZO (L Allpress) – Slow to begin, had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home.

PARK RANGER (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin, had to be steadied when laying inwards across heels passing the 900 metres, raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

FINAL SAVINGS (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly shifting out and crowding SKAABOOM with both runners losing ground.

SKAABOOM (S Wynne) – Crowded at the start losing ground, held up rounding the final bend.

QUEEN SWEEP (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 | **NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE 17 APRIL OPEN HANDICAP (1000m)**

BLACK LABEL (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and then hung in having to be steadied, got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

PIPIANA (W Papier) – Slow to begin, lay in passing the 200 metres and made contact with SENSEI before being corrected by its rider.

MR TYPHON (M Hashizume) – Began awkwardly.

DON CARLO (K Williams) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

SENSEI (K Chowdhoo) – Awkwardly paced on the heels of PIPIANA passing the 400 metres and had to be steadied briefly and shift ground inwards to find clear racing room, briefly placed in restricted room making contact with PIPIANA which lay in before being corrected by its rider.

W Papier was shown a replay of his ride in the final straight in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor for educational purposes.

JOHNNY JONES (T Comignaghi) – Lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 7

RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1600m)

AUGUSTACE (S Toolooa) was declared a late scratching at 4.16 pm after refusing to load. The connections were advised that the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next.

MOREIRA (K Kwo) – Slow to begin

FRIDAY KNIGHT (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

SEVERINE (S Wynne) – Blundered at the start briefly unbalancing the rider.

EL CAMPEADOR (D Prastiyoo) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with JIN LU and losing ground as a result, over raced and clipped a heel blundering badly passing the 1400 metres.

JIN LU (B Murray) – Contacted at the start, raced three wide without cover throughout.

ALL BLACK MAGIC (R Hannam) – Raced wide in the early stages.

NATHAN DETROIT (B Morgenrood) – Lay inwards throughout the running contacting the rail on a number of occasions. When questioned the rider advised that the gelding had lay inwards throughout proving difficult at times.

REPO SUN (J Fawcett) – Over raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

HIGHLY UNLIKELY (K Chowdhoo) – Lay inwards early in the run home, briefly shifted away from heels passing the 300 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that after having to steady at the 300 metres the gelding had battled on fairly over the concluding stages and had not disappointed with today's effort.

SURE IS (K Mudhoo) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of SEVERINE passing the 300 metres having to shift ground outwards to avoid heels.

K Mudhoo (SURE IS) was issued with a warning after angling his mount off heels passing the 300 metres briefly crowding HIGHLY UNLIKELY which had to be steadied away from heels.
