| Race 1 | JIMMY RURAL 2100 (2100 METRES) | |

MI JAKKY (T Allan) – Slow away.

GLORIOUS DREAM (L Allpress) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1700 metres.

L HEMI (VANNOSS) -Was issued with a warning under [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] with regards to her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 STELLA ARTOIS 3YO 1200 (1200 METRES)

LIKE A BOSS (D Danis) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing the rider and making contact with LAUREATE. Held up passing the 400 metres.

TAMAHINE (L Hemi) - Slow away.

LAUREATE (C Burdan) - Raced fiercely in the early stages shifting out bumping UNLACED near the 1000 metres, then restrained off heels near the 800 metres shifting three wide and continuing to over-race. Lay out under pressure in the home straight briefly inconveniencing O'CONNOR which lay in.

O'CONNOR (R Kozaki) - Lay in approaching the 200 metres, becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be straightened.

COPIAPINO (L Allpress) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight.

Race 3 GARTH BEST- BEST TRAVEL MEMORIAL SPRINT (1100 METRES)

ELLIOT POWER (D Danis) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

CHALLA (C Burdan) - Bucked for some distance in the early stages losing ground. When questioned rider could offer no tangible reason why the gelding would buck. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial prior to racing next.

MATT CAIN (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the nasal area. A subsequent veterinary inspection confirmed the gelding to have bled. Connections were advised that the gelding is subject to the mandatory stand down from track work for two months and from racing for three months. A veterinary clearance is required prior to racing or trialling.

Race 4 RUSSELL FAMILY CITY OF HASTINGS CUP/FASTTRACK 5K (1300 METRES)

MOTIVATION (L Allpress) – Slow away

STRADIVARIUS (L Hemi) – Awkwardly away.

LUCYINRIO (M Singh) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

Race 5 PHIL'S GARDEN MILE (1600 METRES)

WAR OF WORDS (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly.

DANCING QUEEN (R Goldsbury) - Raced ungenerously getting its head in the air when being restrained near the 1400 metres, then restrained off heels near the 800 metres.

ROX (L Allpress) - Was obliged to improve very wide from the 800 metres.

BLIZZING AWAY (T Allan) - When questioned into performance rider advised that after working from the wide draw had little left in the finish.

L HEMI (SHEER ELEGANCE) - Was spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 KAHUNGUNU KAPA (1600 METRES)

ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL (M Singh) – Slow away.

SAVANAH BELLE (L ALLPRESS) - Had a tendency to get its head in the air when being restrained passing the 1200 metres.

REAL BEACH (J Parkes) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare would in his opinion take natural improvement from the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1400 METRES)

SPIRIT OF GALWAY (C Burdan) – Slow away, then went off stride crossing onto the course proper losing significant ground.

IVORY MADONNA (L Hemi) - Tightened having to be steadied near the 250 metres when BALL GOWN was angled outwards simultaneously as VROOM lay in.

BALL GOWN (D Bradley) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Tightened and steadied over the final 100 metres.

ALEXANDRITE (L Allpress) – Tightened and steadied over the final 100 metres.

H ANDREW (VROOM) – Admitted a breach of [Rule 638 (1)(d)] in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards inside the final 100 metres when not clear of BALL GOWN and ALEXANDRITE which were both tightened and having to be steadied. The Judicial Committee suspended her licence to ride from the conclusion of racing on Monday 6th January up to and including Wednesday 15th January (7 days).

Prior to the authorisation of dividends the connections of BALL GOWN viewed footage of the home straight with a view to lodging a protest against VROOM but elected not to proceed.

Race 8 ROGER RUSSELL/CHARLIE KEENAN MEMORIAL (1400 METRES)

YOSSARIAN (M Singh) – Raced very keenly in the early stages having to be heavily restrained approaching the 800 metres.

ENRICHMENT (C Burdan)- Held up passing the 400 metres, disappointed for a run having to be steadied near the 250 metres and raced in restricted room near the 100 metres.

AMANO (J Parkes) - Lay in under pressure in the home straight.

QUANTUM (L Hemi) – Raced in restricted room over the final stages.
