HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.					
BRIDGET TOWN (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.					
PINUP COUP (K Chowdhoory) – Raced three wide from the 1000 metres.					
PRODUCER (A Balloo) – Briefly held up passing the 500 metres.					
A Balloo (PRODUCER) – Issued a warning for his use of the whip on consecutive strides outside the 100 metres.					
K Chowdhoory (PINUP COUP) – Issued a warning for his striking his mount seven times prior to the 100 metres.					

C Campbell (BRIDGET TOWN) – Issued with a warning for the use of his whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 EAST OTAGO TRANSPORT, WAE AND GOLDEN FLEECE 0-1 1975m

VERSES (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

STOP MAKING SENSE (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages before progressing to the lead near the 1300 metres.

PREDICTION (R Mudhoo) – Over raced for a short distance entering the home straight.

EFFERVESCENT (J Laking) – When questioned regarding performance rider reporting the gelding had been lethargic throughout and a subsequent veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

SHAZ THE BANK (D Prastiyou) – Returned to the Birdcage with blood in its mouth. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a cut to the tongue.

Race 3 CARGILLS CONTRACTING, BLUESKIN NURSERY & PURE SERVICES 2&3YO 1150m

TOP GHIA (C Johnson) – Restrained to the rear on jumping. Reported to have lost both back racing plates during the race.

HE'S GANGSTER (L Callaway) – Got its head up when being restrained to take cover in the early stages. Raced ungenerously for a short distance passing the 700 metres.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1250m

WYNMOORE (A Balloo) – Slow to begin. Had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of ARNAGE.

TICKETS ON HER (R Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

MISS TILLY WINKS (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider advised that she had been trapped wide but also believed the mare had not handled the tight bend which led to a disappointing performance.

MISS MAXIPARK (A Bohorun) – When asked to comment on performance rider advised that in his opinion the mare had not handled today's track conditions.

OUR GIRL GILLY (K Chowdhoory) – Shifted ground outwards over the concluding stages.

Race 5 GLAMOUR HOOVES RACING STABLES R82 1250m

BARABAS (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

MR TYPHON (K Chowdhoory) – Reared as the start was affected and was reluctant to leave the barriers losing considerable ground. The connections were advised the gelding was on a barrier manners warning.

WINDSOR (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

HE'S MI BROTHER (A Bohorun) – Blundered briefly passing the 50 metres.

THE SWISS MAESTRO (S Wynne) – Lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 6 OTAGO TYRES, IRONIC & HOPE & SONS MDN 2YO&UP 1250m

ARE YOU CEREAL (L Callaway) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MAGNOLIA MAN (K Chowdhoory) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously racing into the bend at the 800 metres and shifted outwards to avoid heels passing the 700 metres racing three wide without cover for the remainder of the event. Lay out over the concluding stages having to be straightened.

EMMA'S CHANCE (R Mudhoo) – Crowded shortly after the start and had to be restrained away from heels losing ground. Had some trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home and raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 175 metres. **INDEX** (C Campbell) – Was inclined to lay in throughout the run home shifting in abruptly passing the 50 metres having to be straightened.

Race 7 DUNEDIN CASINO WAIKOUAITI CUP OPEN 1975m

ZENTESSA (D Prastiyou) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had not appreciated the tight nature of today's track.

POP 'N' ROCK (S Wynne) – Raced wide without cover through the early and middle stages and was under pressure passing the 500 metres and gave ground with the rider reporting the gelding had moved in the ground on the home turn and in her opinion had not handled the tight bends of this track.

Race 8 BRENT LUCAS BUILDERS AND SKEVINGTONS MDN 1975m

STAR WARS PRINCESS (R Mudhoo) – Bounded as the start was effected losing ground as a result.

SABOTEUR (L Callaway) – Crowded and had to be steadied passing the 1700 metres. Raced ungenerously and shifted up the track when negotiating the first turn then raced wide without cover thereafter.

MR FAHRENHEIT (T Moseley) – Had to be steadied briefly when crowded for room by SABOTEUR who was taken in by MELANITE (C Campbell) passing the 1700 metres. C Campbell was advised to exercise care. Held up through the middle part of the run home when laying inwards across the heels of JINGO. Bumped at the 150 metres.

SCANDALOUS (J Laking) – Held up early in the run home when denied a run to the inside of KANDHU then had to shift outwards passing the 175 metres to find clear racing room.

RED LIGHT DISTRICT (D Prastiyou) – Briefly crowded passing the 150 metres between SCANDALOUS and JINGO when both runners shifted ground marginally.

MELANITE (C Campbell) – Lay in the run home and then bumped with MR FAHRENHEIT passing the 150 metres when continuing to lay inwards.
