SUPPLEMENTARY:

Hawkes Bay Racing - 1 January 2020 Race 7 - NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race C O'Beirne (ROYAL CHARTER) - Admitted a breach of Rule 636(1)(d) in that she failed to ride her mount out fully to the finish, losing 5 th placing. The JCA imposed a fine of \$250.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WAIRARAPA TIMES AGE R72 (1000 Metres)
The race card was put back by one race due to a medical emergency which required the rescue helicopter to be deployed to transport a member of the public to hospital. Race 1 started at 1.53pm. GRAND MAYSON (C O'Beirne) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 400 metres.	
Race 2	VALLEY PLUMBING MAIDEN (1000 Metres)
The start of Race 2 was delayed 1 minute at the request of the TAB.	

INFRARED (R Hannam) - Blundered at the start briefly unbalancing the rider.

Race 3 | **THE HITS & LIFE MEMBERS R82 (2050 Metres)**

LINCOLN FURY (R Hannam) – Slow away.

COMMANDING PRINCE (M Hudson) - Raced keenly for a distance in the middle stages.

TRENDING (D Bradley) - Raced three wide without cover before improving to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.

LOOK OUT (H Andrew) - Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running entering the home straight.

Race 4 | **PUKEMANU BAR & EASTERY MAIDEN (1300 Metres)**

SILENT APPROACH - Late scratching at 2.06pm on veterinary advice.

HOROPITO (H Andrew) - Lost near front plate when knuckling at the start then settled back.

VINEYARD MCPHEE (R Myers) - Slow away.

BLARACK (D Bradley) - Awkwardly away.

STREAK OF POWER (L Hemi) - Shifted out abruptly when shying at the winning post over the concluding stages.

Race 5 | **COTTER & STEVENS MAIDEN 3YO (1400 Metres)**

VORALTO – Late scratching at 4.01pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in its barrier. Connections were advised that the filly must trial prior to racing next.

COLYTON SKY (M Hudson) – Began awkwardly.

SUNLIT LANE (L Hemi) - Jumped inwards at the start tightening GINGER JANE.

GINGER JANE (R Goldsbury) – Tightened start. Had to be angled outwards across heels on the home turn to improve.

COMING UP ROSES (S Macnab) - Slow away. Rider reported the filly had felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed the filly to be lame in the left forelimb. Connections were advised that COMING UP ROSES will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

AMOR AMOR (H Andrew) - Began awkwardly.

Race 6 | **BOULCOTT SUITES CHALLENGE MAIDEN (2050 Metres)**

EL TORRES (H Andrew) - Slow away. Ran up on to heels near the 1500 metres.

I AM A CRAFTSMAN (L Hemi) - Slow away.

TAKE THAT (J Parkes) – Made the bend near the 1650 metres awkwardly. When questioned rider J Parkes said after asking the horse to improve from near the 700 metres, failed to run on to any extent in the home straight and was disappointing. Trainer F Auret undertook to monitor the horse over coming days and report any anomaly to Stewards.

PICCOLO TORO (J Riddell) - Lay inwards becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of AMMONS near the 300 metres,

having to be straightened then raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

Race 7 | **SOUTH WAIRARAPA VET SERVICES MAIDEN (1600 Metres)**

ALL MIGHT (D Bradley) – Slow away.

DEN BOSCH (R Hannam) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

DOUBLE ACT (J Parkes) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight when in restricted room.

LOVE POTION (R Myers) - Lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 8 | **JACKSON ST BAR R65 (1600 Metres)**

MASTER LINCOLN (J Riddell) - Underwent and past a pre-raced veterinary examination after making contact with a gate on the way to the start.

SUPER GIRL (M Singh) - Blundered at the start settling back. When questioned into performance rider reported the mare may appreciate more rain affected going.

PUNTA MITA (C O'Beirne) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the middle stages. Briefly inconvenienced near the 400 metres when **MASTER LINCOLN** (J Riddell) improved quickly to its inside. J Riddell was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.
