GENERAL:

Rider M Cameron did not attend today's meeting due to aggravating a knee injury earlier in the week.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1200 metres)
<p>REGAL DUCHESS (J Fawcett) – Reared and dislodged its rider soon after arriving at the barriers and cantered a distance. J Fawcett was uninjured. Underwent a veterinary examination after being recaptured and was passed fit to run. Raced three wide without cover.</p> <p>MADAM POMPOM (R Smyth) – Slow away and then further hampered.</p> <p>SUPER SWISH (L Innes) – Briefly steadied passing the 1100 metres when in restricted room.</p>	
Race 2	Vale David Reid (1600 metres)
<p>PATSY LAD (M Coleman) – Slow away. Lay in passing the 700 metres. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>ON THE RIVET (D Danis) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider D Danis was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his horses out to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so.</p> <p>HVAR (A Calder) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early and middle stages. Trainer R Collett reported that HVAR had bled on return to the tie-up stalls with the gelding receiving veterinary attention. HVAR is now subject to a three month stand down from trialling or racing and a two month stand down from training with an appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.</p> <p>ONE MISSILE (J Fawcett) – Steadied when in restricted room to the inside of PATSY LAD which lay in briefly passing the 700 metres. Eased down in the final straight. Rider J Fawcett reported that the filly had felt indifferent and underwent a subsequent veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer M Murdoch was advised that the filly will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again, with Mrs Murdoch indicating that she would experiment with gear changes.</p>	
Race 3	Fell Engineering (1400 metres)
<p>SASSEGO (J Fawcett) – Slow away. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>CASH ME OUSSIDE (D Danis) – Knuckled leaving the barrier.</p> <p>LORD POLONIUS (M Coleman) – Slow away. Shifted out to avoid heels passing the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Coleman could offer no tangible excuses other than the gelding may prefer some easing of the ground.</p> <p>O'SUSANA (T Newman) – Slow away. Shifted out abruptly approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running. Apprentice Rider T Newman was advised that she must exercise better judgement.</p>	
Race 4	Kamo Club (1400 metres)
<p>LINCOLN SPRINGS (L Innes) – Crowded on jumping away then ridden urgently to recover and raced keenly in the early stages. Lost the off hind plate during the running.</p> <p>QIJ OLYMPIA (S Collett) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	Trigg Construction (1400 metres)
<p>O'GUY (S Spratt) – Slow away.</p> <p>BRUEGEL (M Coleman) – Held up early in the final straight until shifting out passing the 300 metres. Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres by BOOGIE EASY which lay out under pressure.</p>	

Race 6	The Whangaripo Valley Free Range Egg Cup (2100 metres)
<p>ROC WHEELER (L Innes) – Slow away. Lost the off hind plate during the running.</p> <p>FINAL SUGGESTION (T Newman) – Slow away. Held up until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p>SINGLE MOMENT (S Spratt) – Crowded approaching the 200 metres when in restricted room to the inside of ROC WHEELER (L Innes) which ducked in when being struck with the whip. L Innes was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>RED DYNAMO (S Collett) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding had failed to stay.</p>	
Race 7	Hirepool (2100 metres)
<p>MANAVGAT (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>PORTUGAL (J Fawcett) – Raced wide in the early stages. Commenced to give ground passing the 400 metres and was not persevered with by its rider. PORTUGAL is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.</p> <p>MISS TAVI (D Danis) – Became tailed off in the early stages and then was eased down by its rider from near the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality. Co-trainer B Vance was advised that MISS TAVI would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>YING RESOLUTE (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>PRINCE SOLARI (R Oliver) – Made contact with the running rail near the 450 metres becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>R Oliver (PRINCE SOLARI) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively.</p> <p>T Newman (DANGERMAN) – Issued with a warning for using her whip excessively.</p>
